<u>Levin Racing Club - 20 December 2018</u> Race 3 LEVIN TAB & SPORTS BAR 1200 (1200 Metres) SWISH AZ (J Parkes) – Trainer G Lowry advised Stewards that the mare was showing signs of shin soreness following this race and it is his intention to freshen SWISH AZ prior to racing next.
<u>Waikato Racing Club - 22 December 2018</u> Race 2 PRINT HOUSE 1600 THE BUZZ (O Bosson) – Trainer M Murdoch advised Stewards that the gelding underwent further veterinary examination including blood tests in the days following this race which did not reveal any abnormality, adding that it is now their intention to freshen THE BUZZ prior to racing next.
<u>Manawatu Racing Club - 22 December 2018</u>

Race 2 GOODWOOD STUD 2YO PREMIER (1100 Metres)

LAURENTIUM (S Rusof) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that LAURENTIUM has now been gelded and would be sent for brief spell prior to racing next.

Race 4 THE PAVEMASTERS PREMIER (1400 Metres)

LA LANDONNE (S Collett) – Trainer S Brown advised Stewards that in the days following this race the mare had a stone bruise become apparent in the left front foot which it has now received treatment for. Further advising that LA LANDONNE would now be sent for a spell.

Race 7 KAMADA PARK MANAWATU CHALLENGE STAKES (Group II) (1400 Metres)

OCEAN EMPEROR (R Myers) – Trainer G Hennessy advised Stewards that OCEAN EMPEROR underwent further veterinary examination on return to her stable which did not reveal any abnormality, adding that the entire will now be sent for brief spell.

Race 1	MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 2200
<p>MR LIKEABLE (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1900 metres.</p> <p>KIPLING (S Collett) – Was inclined to lay in throughout, and when doing so near the 700 metres made contact with UNACCEPTABLE which was hampered when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of OUR BEESKEES.</p> <p>UNACCEPTABLE (M Coleman) – Hampered when becoming awkwardly placed near heels after being bumped passing the 700 metres. Lost the left front plate during the running.</p> <p>FLYING FANTASIA (A Calder) – Held up early in the final straight having to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 2	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>M Faber – Stable representative M Faber admitted a breach of Rule 614(2) in that he presented the two S McKee stable runners SPINDLE and O'PRINCESS with incorrect saddles and was fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee.</p> <p>SAVY YONG BLONK (O Bosson) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>STYLE BY DESIGN (M Cameron) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.</p>	
Race 3	RYDGES 1560
<p>MR TRUMP (M Cameron) – Slow away.</p> <p>SHADOWS (D Danis) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 4	INTERISLANDER SUMMER FESTIVAL 1560
<p>TUPS (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>FIERY DRAGON (J Riddell) – Slow to begin. Held up near the 250 metres having to steady and shift outwards across the heels of MESOPIC to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p>THE GYPSY KING (S Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p>	

OPERATOR (S McKay) – Lay out rounding the first bend.	
ALADINA (M Coleman) – Steadied to avoid heels near the 850 metres.	
Race 5	HOUSE OF ELLIOTT HAIRDRESSING 1560
<p>CUTTING UP ROUGH (D Danis) – Slow away, then raced keenly in the middle stages. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.</p> <p>Immediately following this race, the Starter reported that when he initially attempted to deploy the start button it had failed to activate correctly but after being reset had functioned properly, and had been further tested following the race.</p>	
Race 6	LIME CAFÉ 3YO
<p>ROMANOV GIRL (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly shifting away from QUALITY PREVAILS making heavy contact with VEE CECE which was forced on to SAINTLY WAY which was hampered having to check to avoid the heels of LUCK OF WANTED. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages, continuing to do so for some distance before running off around the bend and not being persevered with. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer E Shattock was advised that ROMANOV GIRL must trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward before racing again.</p> <p>VEE CECE (L Satherley) – Received heavy contact when crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>SAINTLY WAY (S Collett) – Hampered start losing ground. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>MISHA’S STAR (J Bayliss) – Hung outwards throughout the running and was unable to be ridden out fully over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. A warning was placed on the filly’s racing manners.</p>	
Race 7	LASER ELECTRICAL 1215
<p>BATTLE SKY (T Thornton) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with RUMOUR HAS IT. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after beginning awkwardly the gelding had been unable to hit out freely. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>RUMOUR HAS IT (S Collett) – Bumped start losing ground settling back as a result.</p> <p>STAGE HIT (M McNab) – Had to be steadied after improving on to heels near the 500 metres.</p> <p>FULL SERVICE (L Satherley) – Lay out rounding the final bend.</p> <p>MISS ANONYMOUS (J Bayliss) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p>	
Race 8	BARCODE 1400
<p>LORD ARTHUR (J Riddell) – Slow away.</p> <p>POKER QUEEN (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover, and hung outwards rounding the bend.</p> <p>PATCH MAN (T Yanagida) – Crowded having to be firmly restrained near the 450 metres. Held up rounding the final turn and did not obtain clear running until near the 150 metres.</p> <p>M Hashizume (FLYING TRAPEZE) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out near the 450 metres when not sufficiently clear of PATCH MAN and PUSHMEE which were both crowded having to be firmly restrained.</p>	

PUSHMEE (D Danis) – Crowded having to be firmly restrained near the 450 metres.
