Race 1	PETER SOLE TRANSPORT SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST MAIDEN 2000M
BLUE RATA ANNA (D Hirini) – Slow away.	
HOUBOUCHOUX (B Murray) – Slow away.	
MR LIKEABLE (R Elliott) – Raced wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.	

LOOK WEST (W Pinn) – Commenced to over race near the 1300 metres continuing to do so through the middle stages.	
Race 2	TARANAKI DAILY NEWS SUPPORT 1100M
<p>WINNING SCREAM (B Murray) – Slow away then hung outwards rounding the turn and early part of the home straight placing the rider at a disadvantage.</p> <p>D Danis (SPRING BLOSSOM) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 900 metres when not sufficiently clear, resulting in crowding to CASCADE DE LA VIE MRS RUMBLE, MARBUZET and OUR HAIL MARY which was crowded and checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Jockey Danis licence to ride from 21.1.19 to 28.1.19 inclusive (6 days).</p> <p>CASCADE DE LA VIE (Z Yanagida) – Had to be steadied when crowded near the 900 metres.</p> <p>MRS RUMBLE (T Yanagida) – Had to be steadied when crowded near the 900 metres.</p> <p>MARBUZET (R Elliot) – Crowded near the 900 metres.</p> <p>OUR HAIL MARY (W Pinn) – Checked when crowded near the 900 metres losing ground.</p>	
Race 3	COMCAT SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION 1200M
<p>KELTIC ROCK STAR (R Elliot) – Slow away. Restrained after jumping from the outside barrier, shifted across behind runners to obtain cover.</p> <p>NO MORE MY LOVE (W Pinn) – Commenced to over race shortly after the start continuing to do so throughout the middle stages having to shift outwards abruptly near the 700 metres to avoid heels, hampering MEDITERRANEAN STAR.</p> <p>MEDITERRANEAN STAR (T Yanagida) – Hampered near the 700 metres losing ground. Lay in under pressure in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out by its rider.</p> <p>RUN LIKE BOO (Z Moki) – Slow away. Over raced in the back straight and when being steadied near the 800 metres shifted out hampering IRISH FLARE which was forced out over extra ground.</p> <p>IRISH FLARE (B Murray) – Forced outwards over extra ground near the 800 metres.</p>	
Race 4	LANDMARK HOMES SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION 1400M
<p>WASEEM (C O’Beirne) – Blundered leaving the barriers.</p> <p>RICH REVIEW (D Hirini) – Race keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>GOLDCHI (T Taiaroa) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>MONACO (D Danis) – Was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight having difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>VIVA LILLI (W Pinn) – Lay inwards under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	PENINSULAR BEACHFRONT RESORT MOOLOOLABA SUPPORTS LIFE TRUST 1400M
RED FOREST (K Cowan) – Was inclined to get its head up when racing keenly in the middle stages, making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly hampering CLEAVER . Lay out under pressure in the final straight.	

CLEAVER (Z Moki) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Hampered going into the bend near the 800 metres.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends Stewards lodged a protest on behalf of connections of the 2nd placed MIKJENE (D Hirini), against 1st placed MALO BIK (W Pinn) alleging interference inside the final 100 metres. During the course of the protest hearing after viewing relevant films Trainer A Sharrock indicated that he did not wish to contest the protest. The objection was then upheld by the Judicial Committee relegating MALO BIK to 2ND placing. Final placings now reading 5-MIKJENE 1st, 1-MALO BIK 2nd, 4-CLEAVER 3rd, 3-SMOKEN HOT 4TH.

W Pinn (MALO BIK) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount MALO BIK to shift outwards inside the final 100 metres when not sufficiently clear, causing interference to MIKJENE (D Hirini). After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended apprentice jockey W Pinn's licence to ride in races from 20.1.19 - 28.1.19 incl. (6 days)

MASTER COURTSMAN (S O'Malley) – Very slow to begin losing significant ground. A warning will be placed against the gelding.

Z Moki (MCHALE) – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards near the 850 metres when not fully clear of SISTER MONICA which had to be steadied.

OCEAN RULER– Held up in the final straight near the 350 metres and did not obtain clear running until the 100 metres.

HI I'M NIKKITA (K Cowan) – Held up rounding the final turn until the final 100 metres.

TAKE A GAMBLE (D Hirini) – Held up approaching the 200 metres.

SAVASAVA (C O'Beirne) – Over raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages shifting outwards to avoid heels near the 1100 metres, then being allowed to improve forward to dispute the pace.

VALENTIA (W Pinn) – Held up near the 300 metres and shifted outwards then clipping a heel of REMARX.

MISTER GERONIMO (D Hirini) – Was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight and was not persevered with over the final stages.

Z Moki (VALENTIA) – Was spoken to regarding the use of her whip prior to the 100 metres when marginally outside the guidelines.
