RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION HANDICAP
SOLOMON (L Allpress) - Reared in its barrier stall becoming cast kicking ISLAND BAY. Both runners were late scratched at 1.12 pm on veterinary advice. Connections of SOLOMON were advised that the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards before racing next.	
PINK GRAFFITI (M McNab) – Slow away. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.	
STAR TREASURE (T Yanagida) - Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly.	

Race 2	MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES 2YO
<p>HE'S A GOLD DIGGER (C Lammas) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Forced wider entering the final straight. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ELLIOT POWER which shifted out under pressure near the 100 metres.</p> <p>ELLIOT POWER (L Allpress) – Rider advised the gelding had hung throughout, forcing HE'S A GOLD DIGGER wider passing the 400 metres. ELLIOT POWER then continued to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>QIJJ SWORDSMAN (S Collett) – Placed in restricted room to the inside of PATCH PRINCE which shifted in slightly and SENZABEEL which shifted out to obtain clear running with QIJJ SWORDSMAN having to shift in across heels to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>PATCH PRINCE (J Bayliss) - Steadied for a short distance when in restricted room passing the 400 metres. When questioned rider advised that they elected to settle back from a wide barrier draw and had finished the race off well once obtaining clear running.</p>	
Race 3	WILLIE VERMEULEN AT CROCKFORDS OF GREERTON HANDICAP
<p>GOLD SPICE (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>T Yanagida - Admitted a breach of improper riding in that he forced a run to the inside of BEAUMARCHAIS where there was no room to do so making heavy contact with the hind quarters of BEAUCHMARCHAIS with that runner becoming severely hampered and unbalanced for a distance. T Yanagida's licence was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 23 January up to and including Thursday 21 February, 18 national days.</p>	
Race 4	ULTIMATE MAZDA AND FORD HANDICAP
<p>THE FAME GAME (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>FASTELLIE (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly and shifted in making contact with CIVILISED. Over raced in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>SHOW BIRD (S Spratt) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CIVILISED (D Danis) - Held up until near the 400 metres.</p> <p>T Newman (SHEEZALLMINE) - Was reminded of her obligations when riding her mounts out to the finish of the race.</p>	
Race 5	CROCKFORD REAL ESTATE OPEN HANDICAP
<p>HENI (D Hirini) – Slow away then commenced to over race when being steadied for a distance passing the 1000 metres, held up early in the final straight.</p>	
Race 6	MAGIC TALK WITH PETER WILLIAMS FROM FEBRUARY HANDICAP
<p>PODRAVINA (T Yanagida) - Raced three wide without cover throughout, steadied when awkwardly placed on heels concluding stages.</p> <p>SACRED DAY (M McNab) – Slow away.</p> <p>PAISLEY PARK (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground, over raced through the early to middle stages. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p>Rider S Collett was issued with a warning after permitting PAISLEY PARK to shift in under pressure over the concluding stages before being corrected inconveniencing PODRAVINA.</p>	

<p>LIGHT SHADOW (S McKay) - Over raced through the early to middle stages, held up till shifting out across heels passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>CONCERT HALL (R Elliot) – Held up for clear racing room for the majority of the straight.</p> <p>CLASSIC TOUCH (J Bayliss) – Held up till passing the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 7	JASON HYDE-HILLS AT CROCKFORDS OF CHERRYWOOD HANDICAP
<p>SEDUTTORE (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>EL COOLIO (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>THE REAL BEEL (D Danis) - Commenced to over race passing the 1200 metres shifting out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels forcing SEDUTTORE wider on the track passing the 1000 metres and continued to over race for a distance.</p> <p>RASPBERRY SWEET (C Lammas) - Commenced to over race for a distance near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>SHOW DOWN (K Cowan) - Raced wide without cover from the 1100 metres.</p>	
Race 8	SEL NEAL BUILDERS HANDICAP
<p>MASU (M Cameron) - Crowded shortly after the start</p> <p>NASHA RIVA (S Collett) - Crowded shortly after the start, then over raced in the early to middle stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of SCAGLIONI which shifted in slightly, contributing was outward movement from COURTMASER which was taken out by I SEE RED.</p> <p>ROC WHEELER (L Satherley) - Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>GUILLOCHARM (S McKay) - Over raced through the middle stages shifting out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 800 metres forcing PURSUED out across heels which had to be steadied.</p> <p>LAURAMIA (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SCAGLIONI (T Yanagida) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p>
