RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	AJC Members 2200
<p>ODD MAN OUT (T Yanagida) – Made the first turn awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly approaching the crossing near the 1800 metres hampering SUPERSTITION. Continued to hang out rounding the first bend racing wide. Trainer D Waddell was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its racing manners.</p> <p>SUPERSTITION (M Coleman) – Hampered near the 1800 metres. Raced wide without cover until near the 900 metres.</p> <p>RUSALKA (S Spratt) – Steadied passing the 1000 metres after becoming awkwardly placed when improving to the inside of SUPERSTITION (M Coleman) which shifted inwards when steadying to obtain cover. M Coleman was advised that he must exercise care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>C Lammas (CLADDAGH) – Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 2	West Brook Winery 1200
<p>MIGHTY ASLAN (S Spratt) – Slow away.</p> <p>GOLD LACE (C Dell) – Slow away. Ran wide when making the bend near the 900 metres forcing OCEAN STAR wider on the track. Continued to race wide for the remainder of the race. Trainer K Knight was advised that a warning would be placed on the filly's racing manners.</p> <p>OCEAN STAR (S Rusof) – Forced wide 900 metres and then steadied in an attempt to obtain a position closer to the running rail. When questioned regarding the performance S Rusof advised that he got further back than intended and then was hampered after being forced wide passing the 900 metres and had to steady as a result.</p> <p>GOLDEN SUN (C Grylls) – Over-raced in the early stages making the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>SIX SCHILLINGS (K Cowan) – Placed in restricted room approaching the 900 metres to the inside of ZENVO (J Waddell) which shifted in and then further hampered by HONOVI which was forced out by SHINING SUN which shifted out when making the bend. Hampered as a result was POPPY O'NEILL.</p> <p>J Waddell (ZENVO) – Issued with a warning after shifting in passing the 900 metres when insufficiently clear of SIX SCHILLINGS which was placed in restricted room and then checked when HONOVI was dictated out by SHINING SUN which had shifted out when racing ungenerously.</p> <p>POPPY O'NEILL (C Lammas) – Hampered 900 metres losing ground then made the bend awkwardly. Lost the off fore plate during the running.</p> <p>ZENVO (J Waddell) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>PIMMS 'N' PEARLS (T Yanagida) – Ducked out passing the 75 metres with CONQUERING KELLY shifting away from that runner.</p>	
Race 3	NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race (1200 metres)
<p>LOWPROFILE (T Yanagida) – Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres when being steadied after improving into restricted room, then making the bend awkwardly. Obligated to race wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance Apprentice T Yanagida advised that the mare had over-raced when wide without cover and had failed to finish the race off as a consequence.</p> <p>WITCHERY (S Rusof) – Held up for clear running for the majority of the final straight.</p>	

CIN CIN (S Spratt) – Shifted out under pressure making contact with SISTABEEL passing the 100 metres.

SISTABEEL (L Innes) – Contacted 100 metres.

Race 4 | **www.westbrook.co.nz 1600**

INIGO MONTOYA (C Grylls) – Slow away.

MOIRAS TOWN (R Smyth) – Slow away.

MAN POWER (T Newman) – Commenced to over-race shortly after the start and then shifted out approaching the 1300 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels forcing VERSES wider on the track. Raced ungenerously for the remainder of the race when wide without cover proving difficult to ride. Lost the near hind plate during the running.

VERSES (T Yanagida) – Forced wide passing the 1300 metres and then eased in an attempt to obtain cover.

FELICITY ANNE (P Gallagher) – Hampered passing the 50 metres.

HIGHLAND DANCER (G Cooksley) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider G Cooksley advised that the gelding was feeling the effects of the firmer nature of the track.

Race 5 | **AJC on Facebook 1400**

GOLDEN AGE (S Rusof) – Made the bend awkwardly approaching the 800 metres and was hampered when running across heels. Hampered and forced wide 500 metres.

TROUBLE (J Waddell) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

VICTORIA (D Mansour) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of KEEP THE CASH which steadied approaching the 500 metres. As a result VICTORIA then had to steady and shifted out, clipping a heel and blundering, hampering SOFT HEARTED and GOLDEN AGE which were forced wide. Inconvenienced 300 metres. Shifted out abruptly over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

SOFT HEARTED (M Coleman) – Hampered and forced wide 500 metres.

KAYTURE (M McNab) – Held up entering the final straight and shifted out approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running inconveniencing VICTORIA, then again held up for a distance.

FORREST RED (R Elliot) – Held up entering the final straight before shifting in approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 6 | **Auckland Alarms 1600**

S Rusof – Fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee after failing to make the weight for TOKYO LIL, being replaced by A Calder.

ACUTUS (J Bayliss) – Slow away losing ground (4L).

SHADOWS (S Spratt) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

BAS DE SOIE (J Waddell) – Held up entering the final straight before shifting out passing the 300 metres.

NARVICK (J Riddell) – Attempted to improve into a marginal run approaching the 200 metres and then was held up for the remainder of the race.

Race 7

Avondale Sunday Markets 1400

FLYING TRAPEZE (J Waddell) – Lost its footing on jumping away and blundered badly dislodging Rider J Waddell who was uninjured. FLYING TRAPEZE required veterinary treatment after suffering lacerations down the inside of the left fore cannon with a veterinary certificate of fitness now required prior to racing again.

JET SET (S Rusof) – Hampered and unbalanced leaving the barrier. Hampered when placed in restricted room 900 metres losing ground. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.

RUSAVY (A Calder) – Began awkwardly making contact losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

D Mansour (CRESCENT) - Suspended from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 30 January until the conclusion of racing on Friday 8 February (5 national riding days) after admitting a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount CRESCENT to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of JET SET which was dictated inwards crowding OUR STAR which was checked near the 1200 metres.

OUR STAR (L Satherley) – Checked when crowded near the 1200 metres.

D Mansour (CRESCENT) - Issued with a warning after permitting CRESCENT to shift inwards near the 900 metres when insufficiently clear of JET SET which was placed in restricted room which was hampered losing ground.
