<p>Wellington Racing Club – Saturday 19 January 2019</p> <p>Race 6 – Gazely Mercedes Benz Premier</p> <p>An appeal lodged by rider L Innes (EFFERVESCENT) against the severity of penalty imposed for an admitted breach of careless riding was heard at 10.30 this morning prior to today's race meeting. After hearing all relevant submissions the Appeals Tribunal dismissed the appeal with the original suspension dates of 27 January to 2 March inclusive being confirmed with no order as to costs being imposed.</p> <p>Racing Tauranga – 2 January 2019</p> <p>Race 1 – Interislander Summer Festival 1300</p> <p>TONADILLAS (M Cameron) - Co-trainer S Ramsey reported that TONADILLAS had a significant burst abscess from the brisket 8 days post-race, further advising that TONADILLAS will continue to be spelled and will trial prior to racing next.</p>

DARCI PALMER (J Waddell) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that the gelding has been sent for a spell.

Race 5 HARCOURTS THORNDONE MILE, Group 1 (1600 Metres)

AUTHENTIC PADDY (R Hannam) – Trainer L Latta advised Stewards that the gelding underwent a veterinary examination in the days following this race which did not reveal any abnormality, adding that AUTHENTIC PADDY would now be freshened prior to racing next.

ON THE ROCKS (J Bayliss) – Trainer P Gerard advised Stewards that she was satisfied with the recovery of the entire and it is their intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 7 JR & N BERKETT TELEGRAPH, Group I (1200 Metres)

SWEET LEADER (C Grylls) – Trainer A Scott advised Stewards that in the days following this race the entire had been showing signs of being jarred up, adding that SWEET LEADER would now be freshen prior to racing next.

MELODY BELLE (J Waddell) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that the mare underwent blood tests in the days following this race which did not reveal any abnormality, further advising that it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

ATOMIC BLAST (J Waddell) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that the gelding has been sent for a spell.

Race 1	JOHN COSTELLO MEMORIAL 2100
<p>BLUE BREEZE (K Cowan) – Shifted out passing the 1200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels forcing EL FERNANDO wider on the track, with EL FERNANDO then being obliged to race wide without cover for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>BEAUMARCHAIS (O Bosson) – Had to be firmly restrained passing the 1000 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels. When questioned regarding performance rider O Bosson was unable to offer any reason. The connections would give consideration to the gelding's racing future.</p> <p>CHA SIU BAO (C Grylls) – Had to steady passing the 400 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of EL FERNANDO which shifted in. Was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>D Mansour (EL FERNANDO) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in passing the 350 metres.</p>	
Race 2	MOUNT SHOP 2100
<p>LUCETTA (J Waddell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>NOCTURNAL (J Bayliss) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>FAZIOLI (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>UABASSO (R Smyth) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being steadied.</p>	

ALTERNATIVE FACT (A Calder) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

THE MIDNIGHT SHIFT (S Collett) – Placed in restricted room for a short distance passing the 600 metres.

MISS RIPPY (M McNab) – Held up for the majority of the final straight, and went to the line untested.

Race 3	SSANGYONG 1200
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FULL OF TALENT (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ITS ALL FAKE NEWS (R Norvall) – Began awkwardly.

RAPOSA RAPIDA (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly.

BELLINSKY (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly.

ALMARIE (T Newman) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SPINDLE (S Spratt) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight having to be steadied off heels on two occasions.

ITS DESTINY'S CHILD (J Riddell) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the mouth/nasal area. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a burst blood vessel in the left nostril.

Race 4	RACE IMAGES 1200
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BRAVISSIMO (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly.

JEWEL OF PATCH (C Grylls) – Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 5	SPLICE CONSTRUCTION 1400
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TIGER SILK (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

THE CHOSEN ONE (M Cameron) – Raced keenly for a distance when being restrained approaching the 1000 metres.

Race 6	HAUNUI FARM 1400
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DEMONETIZATION (J Waddell) – Slow to begin.

VEINE D'OR (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BACK IN A FLASH (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

IFFINDOUBT (S Collett) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres then had to be steadied when being placed in restricted room to the inside of IWANNADANCELIKEHIM which shifted in slightly.

S Rusof (IWANNADANCELIKEHIM) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in near the 900 metres when not fully clear.

J Waddell (DEMONETIZATION) – Issued with a warning in that he shifted out passing the 400 metres dictating VEINE D'OR wider on the track.

IWANNADANCELIKEHIM (S Rusof) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 7	DUNSTAN FEEDS 1600
<p>CHARLES ROAD (K Cowan) – Held up until passing the 400 metres shifting out to obtain clear running.</p> <p>The connections of the second placed runner TRUE ENOUGH instigated a protest against the winner SHADOW FOX alleging interference over the final 100 metres. After viewing all relevant videos and hearing submissions from the connections of both runners the protest was upheld by the Judicial Committee with the placings now reading 5 TRUE ENOUGH first, 3 SHADOW FOX second, 4 CAMINO ROCOSO third and 1 CHARLES ROAD fourth.</p>	
Race 8	ROGERS RACING STABLES 1600
<p>LUCKY SWEEP (S Spratt) – Crowded shortly after start losing ground. Had to be firmly restrained after improving on to heels passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>INCANTESIMO (M McNab) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 950 metres having to be steadied when the pace eased hampering MERCY HILL and DELEGATE which were forced wider.</p> <p>MERCY HILL (A Calder) – Hampered and forced wider near the 950 metres. Steadied over the concluding stages when placed in restricted room.</p> <p>DELEGATE (D Mansour) – Hampered and forced wider near the 950 metres.</p> <p>M McNab (INCANTESIMO) – Reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out to the finish when circumstances permit.</p>
