Race 1	CALOUNDRA CUP TOUR 2019 – BOOK NOW MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>CEE SHARP (A Comignaghi) – Slow to begin, had difficulty obtaining clear running inside the final 250 metres.</p> <p>LONESOME LADY (J Lowry) – Shifted inwards after the start hampering RIVALDO, raced wide throughout, made contact with CALLING US HOME passing the 1000 metres when laying inwards.</p> <p>J Lowry was warned for the manner in which he shifted ground shortly after the start.</p> <p>RIVALDO (L Callaway) – Dictated inwards shortly after the start having to steady.</p> <p>BON GENRE (G Saejorhor) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1200 metres and then commenced to over race for some distance thereafter.</p> <p>CLOONEY (J Laking) – Checked passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside runners, raced in restricted room passing the 130 metres.</p> <p>LINCOLN ZEPHYR (C Johnson) – Over raced when placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres, held up momentarily entering the home straight.</p> <p>CALLING US HOME (D Hirini) – Placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when LONESOME LADY lay inwards, held up passing the 500 metres, attempted to make a run passing the 400 metres when in restricted room buffeting LONESOME LADY.</p> <p>D Hirini admitted a breach of careless riding approaching the 400 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national race days effective from the conclusion of racing on 2 February up to and including 14 February.</p> <p>VOUCH (D Prastiyoo) – Buffeted with SHE'S FOXY approaching the 400 metres when attempting a marginal run to the outside of VAN HALEN, not afforded clear running over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 2	PUNTERS CHALLENGE 6 APRIL – ENTER NOW MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>FIRESTARTER (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>UNHINGED (G Saejorhor) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MR TOOL (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>JIMINY CRICKET (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, made firm contact with LOUVRES passing the 500 metres on more than one occasion. Bumped 250 metres and again 150 metres</p> <p>RITA AURA (L Callaway) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>BELLAROSINA (T Jonker) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	

SHARP 'N' SILVER (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout.

SICHUAN DRAGON (R Mudhoo) – Held up in the early stages of the home straight shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

LOUVRES (C Barnes) – Contacted from the inside by JIMINY CRICKET and unbalanced passing the 500 metres, shifted in passing the 250 metres and again at the 150 metres making contact with JIMINY CRICKET.

EL BEE JACK (C Johnson) – Held up momentarily passing the 200 metres shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running.

TAKE A RISK (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and shifted inwards shortly after the start, lay in throughout.

MY EXCUSE (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

OUR ROSETTE (A Calder) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off heels for some distance.

EMMA'S CHANCE (T Comignaghi) – Not afforded clear running in the early stages of the home straight.

VINO BELLA (J Laking) – Made contact with EMMA'S CHANCE passing the 500 metres becoming unbalanced, bumped near the 150 metres.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (D Hirini) – Shifted outwards and bumped with VINO BELLA near the 150 metres, shifted inwards passing the 40 metres and bumped with MISS SWEET PEE.

MISS SWEET PEE (C Johnson) – Bumped passing the 40 metres.

MILK IT (G Saejorhor) – Slow to begin.

STROWAN (D Prastiyu) – Blundered at the start.

ENZEDJEWEL (BB Hong) – Raced wide throughout.

PIPIANA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider was of the opinion that the mare would take benefit from today's run.

VICE MARSHALL (T Comignaghi) – Steadied momentarily entering the home straight when awkwardly placed to the inside of LAKE CHALICE which shifted inwards.

WHY ME (D Hirini) – Held up passing the 300 metres shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running.

ODISHA (A Calder) – The rider could offer no tangible excuse for the mare's performance.

HOT FUSS (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

ROCKONEVE (D Hirini) – Slow to begin, held up passing the 500 metres and shifted ground outwards at the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

PINUP COUP (C Johnson) – The rider could offer no tangible excuse for the performance.

<p>YAMATO NADESHIKO (T Jonker) – Rider reported the mare to be indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>SHANZINO (A Calder) – Held up in the early stages of the run home.</p>	
Race 6	NZB NATIONAL YEARLING SALES SERIES STARTS 27 JANUARY RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>ATTIMO (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>TANTELLA (K Mudhoo) – Knuckled on jumping becoming unbalanced and making firm contact with QUEEN JETSUN getting back as a result.</p> <p>QUEEN JETSUN (T Comignaghi) – Contacted after jumping.</p> <p>STELLA DAZE (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and shifted outwards, raced fiercely for a distance passing the 1200 metres when being restrained.</p> <p>ULTRA CHIC (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and further hampered when tightened between runners shortly thereafter.</p> <p>KING KANE (D Hirini) – Over raced throughout, held up for a distance passing the 600 metres, and shifted out making firm contact with JIN LU near the 450 metres, not afforded clear running throughout the final straight.</p> <p>D Hirini was warned for shifting ground near the 450 metres.</p> <p>JIN LU (J Laking) – Raced wide throughout, hampered passing the 450 metres when contacted from the inside by KING KANE.</p> <p>RIDE THE STORM (A Calder) – Placed in restricted room approaching the 400 metres and had to steady when PINSHARP (BB Hong) shifted outwards when not sufficiently clear.</p> <p>BB Hong admitted a breach of careless riding approaching the 400 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national race days effective from the conclusion of racing on 26 January up to and including 8 February.</p>	
Race 7	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO DUNEDIN GOLD CUP TRIAL (2000m)
<p>SMOKE HOUSE BAY (T Jonker) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection after rearing in the birdcage and was cleared to race.</p> <p>TAXIHOME (K Mudhoo) – Began very awkwardly and made the crossing near the 1900 metres awkwardly when restrained off the heels of ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN which shifted outwards, eased down over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>PICKUP (L Callaway) – Crowded and steadied passing the 300 metres when placed in restricted room by FIVE KINGS (R Beeharry) which shifted outwards.</p> <p>R Beeharry admitted a breach of careless riding approaching the 300 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national race days effective from the conclusion of racing on 2 February up to and including 13 February.</p>	
Race 8	HELSTON & ASSOCIATES RATING 65 (1100m)
<p>This race was delayed due to SARONIC MISS proving difficult to get to the barriers.</p>	

FASCINO LASS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin and further hampered shortly after the start when awkwardly placed on heels, held up in the early stages of the run home.

SARONIC MISS (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly.

SMILE (J Morris) – Hampered shortly after the start, lay outwards throughout. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to Stewards' satisfaction prior to racing next.

CELTIC WONDER (T Jonker) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages, shifted outwards passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running hampering **WAY TOO EASY** and **MIROSLAVA**.

T Jonker was warned for the manner in which she shifted ground passing the 250 metres.

RED TIARA (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.

HAPI ELLA (L Callaway) – Steadied passing the 100 metres when **DEVIL'S STAIRCASE** (K Mudhoo) shifted outwards. Rider accidentally dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.

K Mudhoo (**DEVIL'S STAIRCASE**) was warned for shifting ground passing the 100 metres.

DEVIL'S STAIRCASE (K Mudhoo) – Held up until inside the final 100 metres.

Race 9	SPEIGHT'S TIMARU STAKES (1400m)

EL BEE DARCI (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.

THE PRECIOUS ONE (L Callaway) – Raced wide from the 600 metres.

FEELIN THE LOVE (T Jonker) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

GET SCHROEDER (C Johnson) – Rider reported that the gelding may have been feeling the firm nature of today's track. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up in subsequent days.

Race 10	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1800m)

PRODUCER (T Jonker) – Slow to begin, got its head up when being restrained in the middle stages.

SHAZ THE BANK (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin, held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

BAL HARBOUR (T Moseley) – Over raced in the early stages.

O'KIWI (J Laking) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

DIORISSIMO (G Saejorhor) – Raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.

BLANCO BAY (L Callaway) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

LEULUAI (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide throughout.

QUAINTRELLE (M Kareem) – Raced wide throughout.

COUP DREAMWOOD (A Calder) – Held up in the early stages of the home straight and then became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres only obtaining clear running at the 100 metres.

J Laking (O'KIWI) admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

G Saejorhor (DIORISSIMO) was warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.
