### RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	COCA COLA 1400
<b>MALO BIK</b> (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly settling back, then raced keenly in the early stages. Had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.	
<b>LA BELLA ROSA</b> (L Allpress) - Restrained off heels near the 800 metres. Shifted out under pressure passing the 100 metres.	
<b>MAGIC OF THE SUN</b> (S Spratt) - Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres when MALO BIK lay in under pressure. W Pinn was advised to exercise care	

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>THRIFTY CAR RENTAL 1600</b>
<p><b>T Furness</b> - Issued with a warning after failing to present STAROSSA in the official saddling/tie-up area by the required time.</p> <p><b>WHENHARRYMETSADDLE</b> (J Waddell) - Slow away. When questioned into performance rider advised that the gelding's big weight combined with the firm track conditions and the effects of recent racing may not have been beneficial.</p> <p><b>SINARAHMA</b> (J Parkes) - Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after being slow away from its wide barrier draw the mare had then got back, but in his opinion had finished the race off in a satisfactory manner given the fast run race.</p> <p><b>PORTLAND JIMMY</b> (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>STAROSSA</b> (W Pinn) - Over raced in the back straight. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and following a veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination was confirmed as a bleeder. STAROSSA is now subject to the mandatory two month stand down from training and three months from racing or trialling with a veterinary clearance required prior to doing so.</p> <p><b>NEESON</b> (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the home turn before being angled inwards to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>ENERGY VETS TARANAKI 1200</b>
<p><b>ALL IN MANA</b> (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly settling back. Commenced to over-race when being restrained going into the bend near the 800 metres having to be firmly restrained for a distance when improving onto heels. Lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>SCO MO EAGLE</b> (V Colgan) - Slow away. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 650 metres. Briefly lost the use of his whip near the 200 metres when regathering his right reign. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had every chance and was unable to offer any excuse other than possibly feeling the effects of recent racing.</p> <p><b>SAINTED PEARL</b> (R Hannam) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages having to be restrained off the heels of OTTAVIO near the 750 metres.</p> <p><b>POWNCE</b> (W Pinn) - Raced keenly in the middle stages having to shift outwards to avoid heels near the 800 metres then racing wide without cover. Briefly hampered near the 50 metres when ALL IN MANA lay in despite the efforts of its rider.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>WOBURN FARM 2YO CLASSIC 1200</b>
<p><b>LAST SIGHT</b> (C Lammas) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of SCOTCH losing ground. Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight, then continuing to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until near 100 metres.</p> <p><b>MISS FEDERER</b> (L Allpress) - Crowded and forced inward shortly after leaving the barriers then raced wide without cover on the pace.</p> <p><b>SCOTCH</b> (J Waddell) - Bumped leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced and shifting inwards crowding MISS FEDERER. Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.</p>	

**HASSTOBEGOOD** (M Coleman) - Crowded shortly after the start due to movement from runners to either side losing ground. Had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

**FOLK DRESS** (C Grylls) - Crowded shortly after the start due to movement from runners to either side.

**TUMBLEWEED** - Hampered shortly after the start when AMAZING TEAM lay out with TUMBLEWEED having to be checked losing ground.

**AMAZING TEAM** (R Myers) - Lay out shortly after the start making contact with TUMBLEWEED becoming unbalanced. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

**Race 5**

**PLATINUM HOMES TARANAKI SUMMER CHALLENGE 1400**

**OFA ORSOME** (W Pinn) - Slow away then being ridden with urgency to recover before improving onto the heels of BETHANY near the 1100 metres commencing to over-race badly when being restrained continuing to do so for some distance. Apprentice Pinn subsequently reported that his saddle had shifted as a result placing him at a disadvantage.

**RAZ** (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly making solid contact with RUSAVY.

**RUSAVY** (C Grylls) - Jumped away awkwardly making solid contact with RAZ. When attempting to improve to the inside of OFA ORSOME had to be checked near the 450 metres when crowded. Improving to the outside of OFA ORSOME was RAZ with VIGOR WINNER ahead and to the outside of that runner. After questioning riders along with extensive viewing of video footage the incident proved to be inconclusive. When being checked RUSAVY hampered VIVA LILLI.

**VIVA LILLI** (J Parkes) - Hampered near the 450 metres.

**KIWI ACE** (J Waddell) - Commenced to over race when being crossed by DUCK ROAD (J Riddell) which shifted inwards when not fully clear approaching the 1000 metres. J Riddell was advised to exercise care. KIWI ACE then shifted outwards to avoid the heels of DUCK ROAD hampering SALT BAY. Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 150 metres.

**SALT BAY** (C Lammas) - Hampered near the 1000 metres.

**RUN LIKE BOO** (L Satherley) - Raced wide without cover. Hampered passing the 600 metres when VIGOR WINNER lay out.

**Race 6**

**FASTTRACK INSURANCE OAKS PRELUDE 1800**

**SCHIST** (L Allpress) - Restrained from a wide barrier to shift inwards to a position closer to the running rail settling back. Held up near the 150 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

**CLEMENTINA** (J Waddell) - Slow away.

**SURE BET** (S Spratt) - Raced keenly then made the bend near the 1600 metres awkwardly having to be restrained.

**W Pinn** (MISHA'S STAR) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount outwards near the 1000 metres when not the required distance clear of JAKKALBOMB. After submissions the Judicial Committee suspended apprentice jockey W Pinn's licence to ride in races from the close of racing today Saturday 2 February until the close of racing on Thursday 28 February (16 national riding days).

**JAKKALBOMB** (R Myers) - Hampered near the 1000 metres.

**ELATE** (C Lammas) - Raced wide without cover around the first bend, before improving forward to lead near the 1000 metres.

**WILD SEAS** (M Coleman) - Underwent a veterinary inspection and was found to be mildly lame in the right fore. Connections were advised the filly will require a veterinary clearance prior to next racing.

**ALL IN VOGUE** (D Bradley) - Jumped away awkwardly. Was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. Underwent a veterinary examination which was clear.

**DOLCETTO** (R Myers) - Lay in over the final stages.

**SAINT EMILION** (J Riddell) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

**S MacNab** (OVERTHERIVER) - Was issued with a warning after angling her mount outwards near 250 metres when not sufficiently clear of IRISH FAME which was hampered.

**IRISH FLAME** (C Lammas) - Hampered near the 250 metres.

<b>RACE 8</b>	<b>DEVON HOTEL 2000</b>

**HOIST** (J Waddell) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**ALL IN STITCHES** (L Allpress) - Raced keenly for a distance near the 1200 metres.

**REMARX** (R Myers) - Raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained in the early stages.

**NARVICK** (J Riddell) - Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward rounding the first turn to sit outside the leader near the 1300 metres. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may be better ridden off the pace with cover.

**KONSTANTINA** (M Cameron) - Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

**COLLINSTREET** (J Parkes) - Held up rounding the home turn gaining clear running early in the straight.

**VALMUR** (C Johnson) - Held up rounding the home turn.
