## SUPPLEMENTARY:

Hawkes Bay RI – Wednesday 30 January 2019 Race 2 – Profruit 1200 An appeal lodged by T Harris against a careless riding suspension incurred in the above race was held today at 10.15 am. After hearing submissions the Appeals Tribunal dismissed the appeal with the amended dates of suspension now being from the conclusion of racing today, Wednesday 13 February, until the conclusion of racing on Friday 22 February, 5 national riding days, with costs of \$200 awarded to the JCA and \$100 to the RIU.

## RACE COMMENTS:

## Race 1 SUNLINE LODGE 1400

RUSAVY (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Held up until near the 100 metres.

**QUINTOS** (J Bayliss) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Had to be steadied for a distance near the 1100 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of RUSAVY (A Calder) which shifted in when not fully clear. A Calder was advised to exercise care.

**ELEANOR RIGBY** (M Cameron) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

YES M'LADY (A Jones) – Began awkwardly shifting out.

HOLY LOCH (D Danis) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

NITRO (S Spratt) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**IRON EAGLE** (S McKay) – Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres when YES M'LADY (A Jones) shifted out under pressure. A Jones was advised to exercise care.

Race 2 STEPHEN RALPH RACING 1400

**HONFLEUR** (A Goindasamy) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when THE WHITE QUEEN shifted in.

**VICTORIA** (C Grylls) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when THE WHITE QUEEN (J Riddell) shifted in.

ORATIA (M Cameron) – Held up until near the 200 metres then had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

**J Riddell** – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount THE WHITE QUEEN to shift in when not sufficiently clear of VICTORIA which had to be steadied and HONFLEUR which had to be firmly restrained passing the 1000 metres.

Race 3 ASCOT FARM 1000

**STARRING ROLE** (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly.

EARLY MORNING RISE (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

**FIRST ROCK** (A Calder) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a slow recovery rate.

**GUS THE MAVERICK** (J Bayliss) – Shifted out and away from EARLY MORNING RISE which shifted out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres, then was forced wider passing the 200 metres when EARLY MORNING RISE ducked out.

**LILIKOI** (C Grylls) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses other than the filly raced greenly in its race day debut after only having one trial.

Following the race the connections of the fifth placed GUS THE MAVERICK viewed Stewards video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

<b>ENSEMBLE</b> (M Cameron) – Jumped away awkwardly shifting out making contact with SWEET DREAMS.					
<b>PUDDLES</b> (S McKay) – Lay out throughout with the rider unable to ride it out fully over the concluding stages.

SIR AGLOVALE (C	Lammas) – Slow to begin.				
<b>TRIOMPHE</b> (J Riddell) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Hampered near the 500 metres. Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 350 metres.					
<b>BARZELLAR</b> (J Bayliss) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Made the bend awkwardly near the 1700 metres forcing ELIZA LONG over extra ground. Steadied and shifted out to avoid heels near the 500 metres. Rider dropped his whip near the 250 metres.					
<b>ELIZA LONG</b> (S McKay) – Forced over extra ground near the 1700 metres when racing keenly. Forced over extra ground near the 800 metres.					
<b>DESIRABULL</b> (N Bakar) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages making the crossing near the 1750 metres awkwardly unbalancing its rider, then continued to over-race through the middle stages.					
MR LIKEABLE (T Harris) – Raced three wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1100 metres.					
<b>AKABA</b> (M Cameron) – Commenced to give ground approaching the 600 metres with BARZELLAR improving on to its heels near the 500 metres and shifting out hampering TRIOMPHE.					
V Colgan – Issued with a warning for angling his mount GEHRIG outwards when not sufficiently clear of ELIZA LONG which was forced over extra ground near the 800 metres.

<b>KINSHASA</b> (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Held up entering the final straight having to shift ground outwards near the 250 metres to obtain clear running.					
FABULOUS FLIGHT (N Bakar) – Held up until near the 350 metres.					
DIAMONDSANDBUBBLES (J Fawcett) – Held up until near the 150 metres.					
EN SOIE (C Lammas) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 350 metres.

ALFRED GEORGE (D Danis) – Slow to begin.					
BATTLE MAN (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.					
<b>ANHEDONIA</b> (P Gallagher) – Made contact with the hind quarters of BOTHERED near the 450 metres in an attempt to improve when there was insufficient room, and as a result clipped a heel and blundered. Lay out under pressure					
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improve when there was insufficient room, and as a result clipped a heel and blundered. Lay out under pressure clipping the heels of BOTHERED near the 250 metres and fell bringing down the trailing ATOM ANT with both riders

being dislodged, hampered as a result was BRUZO. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a small laceration left nasal passage, medial canthus left eye, small wound right fore medial radius, abrasion and swelling to the right fore shoulder. Rider P Gallagher was attended to by on course ambulance personnel before being transferred to Waikato Hospital for further evaluation.

**ATOM ANT** (S Collett) – Brought down near the 250 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a small laceration on the right lateral carpus. S Collett was attended to by on course ambulance personnel and cleared to ride her remaining mount.

**BRUZO** (J Riddell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Badly hampered near 250 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**VENDELLA** (V Colgan) – Steadied when placed in restricted room between CONQUERING KELLY (C Lammas) which shifted out and BOTHERED (A Calder) which shifted in near the 50 metres. Both C Lammas and A Calder were advised to exercise care.

CALL ME EVIE (A Goindasamy) – Steadied when placed in restricted room just prior to the winning post.

# Race 8 STEPHEN MARSH RACING STABLES 1600

BINGWA (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly.

**SAVASTEP** (L Satherley) – Shifted out near the 500 metres making contact with QIJI CRYSTAL which was forced wider. Crowded and checked near the 400 metres when HATTIE BEE shifted out when insufficiently clear.

**QIJI CRYSTAL** (M Cameron) – Contacted and forced wider near the 500 metres.

A Goindasamy – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount HATTIE BEE to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of SAVASTEP which was checked near the 400 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended A Goindasamy's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 17 February up to and including racing on 6 March, 10 national riding days.

## Race 9 RACE A HORSE WITH MARSH RACING 1600

**CLEVERCONVERSATION** (J Bayliss) – Slow away. Held up entering the final straight then shifted out near the 300 metres to obtain clear running making contact with JET SET. Rider dropped his whip near the 250 metres.

**POP 'N' ROCK** (A Calder) – Restrained after jumping away from the outside barrier to shift closer to the running rail and obtain cover.

KANDARI (M Cameron) – Slow to begin then further hampered when SCIACCA shifted outwards.

JET SET (J Riddell) - Contacted passing the 300 metres.

**SCIACCA** (T Harris) – Steadied when placed in restricted room just prior to the winning post.
