RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 2050 (2050 Metres)

CHARRED (D Bradley) – Reared as the start was effected, losing ground. Briefly held up rounding the final turn. When questioned into performance rider reported that after being slow away the gelding had been unable to made ground in the run home.

HEINEKEN HANK (H Andrew) - Jumped outwards at the start tightening LA SOEUR, which also began awkwardly. Briefly inconvenienced near the 1700 metres when QUATROMOSA (R Hannam) shifted in. Jockey R Hannam was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

LA SOEUR (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.

MASTER COURTSMAN (Z Moki) - Slow away.

SASERELLO (S McKay) - When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

NAMEOFGAME (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the early stages, then raced three wide without cover before being allowed to improve to sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres.

BELLA NERO (C O'Beirne) - Held up rounding the home turn.

UNIQUEBOTIQUE (L Hemi) - Lay inwards entering the home straight.

Race 2 GUTHRIE BOWRON MAIDEN 1200 (1200 Metres)

ENRICHMENT (D Turner) – Slow away. Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres

ANOTHER SECRET (J Baillie) - Slow away.

SHAKESPEARE (C Johnson) – Restrained off heels near the 700 metres.

MEDIA (R Myers) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

IN FASHION (L Allpress) - Lay inwards early in the home straight.

CHECKERS (J Riddell) – Raced greenly over the final stages.

HASLER LAD (J Parkes) – When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may not have appreciated today's Good 3 track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear. Connections advised that the gelding would now be sent for a spell.

Race 3 WANGANUI STEELFORMERS MAIDEN 1200 (1200 Metres)

HEIRLOOM (H Andrew) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

Race 4 STEVO'S DISTRIBUTORS MAIDEN 1200 (1200 Metres)

WAASEEM (H Andrew) - Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection after being kicked prior to the start.

ALPHA KILO (D Turner) - Slow away. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

THATZ DAISY (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ROAD TO REIGN (D Hirini) – Hung rounding the home turn.

DEERFIELD (S O'Malley) - Lay inwards in the home straight making contact with the running rail passing the 100 metres.

TENNESSEE ROSE (L Allpress) – Rider reported the mare may benefit with the addition of blinkers.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1350 (1350 Metres)

The start of Race 5 was delayed by approximately 6 minutes when HERMES became fractious in its barrier stall, dislodging its bridle and was late-scratched at 2.56pm.

HERMES (J Parkes) – Late scratching at 2.56pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious and getting down in its barrier stall. Connections were advised that the filly must trial prior to racing next.

ENDURING LOVE (R Myers) - Jumped sideways at the start.

LADY VERAWOOD (H Andrew) - Began awkwardly, settling back.

KELTIC ROCKSTAR (D Turner) - Slow away.

Race 6 LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES 1350 (1350 Metres)

WONDER NO MORE (L Allpress) – Very reluctant to load. Connections were advised the mare must trial prior to starting next.

BEAUTIFUL MAN (C Johnson) - Tightened at the start, settling back.

HARLEM 'N' CO (Z Moki) – Briefly held up early in the home straight.

VIVA LILLI (J Parkes) – Raced wide throughout then lay inwards under pressure early in the home straight. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

Race 7 WANGANUI GREYHOUND CLUB RACING TONIGHT MAIDEN 1350 (1350 Metres)

NADERCA (S O'Malley) – Awkwardly away, settling back. Bumped with TE AKAU DRAGON (D Turner) several times in the back straight and rounding the turn. Both riders were shown footage of their rides and advised that they were expected to show greater care. Lay inwards under pressure early in the home straight having to be straightened.

TE AKAU DRAGON (D Turner) – Awkwardly away. Bumped with NADERCA several times back straight and rounding the turn.

VINCENZO LORENZO (S McKay) – Awkwardly away. Returned to the enclosure with a small amount of blood present in the nasal area. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a small laceration consistent with coming into contact with the starting gate.

Race 8 RAY WHITE REAL ESTATE MAIDEN 1600 (1600 Metres)

FIERY DRAGON (J Riddell) - Underwent a veterinary inspection after becoming fractious in its barrier stall and was cleared to start. Made the turn awkwardly near the 1400 metres.

SWIFT SAOIRSE (L Allpress) – Tightened shortly after the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CALLING US HOME (R Myers) - Bumped and dictated wider on the track entering the home straight when LINCOLN FURY (C Johnson) improved into a marginal run to its inside. In explanation rider C Johnson reported that the gelding had shifted out further than intended entering the home straight, however he was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

LINCOLN FURY (C Johnson) - Bumped entering the home straight.
