Race 1	SOUTHERN INSULATION MAIDEN (1200m)

LORD ZACFORD (J Lowry) - Slow to begin. Lay in throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

DELARU (R Hannam) – Crowded at the start and lost ground. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

MISSING HAZARD (K Chowdhoory) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding DELARU who lost ground. Reported to have been galloped on during the running and lost the right hind racing plate.

SHOCK AND AWE (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages and had to be restrained off heels passing the 900 metres. Crowded and checked at the 300 metres.

D Prastiyou (PESHAWAR) admitted a breach of Careless Riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards at the 300 metres crowding and checking SHOCK AND AWE who was dictated inwards on to BETTY MAY who was hampered. After viewing replays and hearing submissions on penalty the JCA suspended Mr Prastiyou's riding licence from the 18th February up to and including 24th February (5 days.)

CHOWDER (D Bradley) – Improved wide from the 800 metres.

MUSTARD (D Turner) – Steadied passing the 450 metres when held up for clear racing room. Crowded passing the 200 metres between PORT STEPHENS who shifted in under pressure and PESHAWAR which shifted out after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MISSING HAZARD at this point.

MARMADUKE (K Selvan) – Crowded and checked at the 300 metres, making contact with the running rail and becoming unbalanced. Reported by its rider to have got its tongue over the bit during the running.

D Bradley (CHOWDER) defended a charge of Careless Riding in that he allowed his runner to shift inwards at the 300 metres dictating TAP TAP inwards on to MARMADUKE who was crowded and checked. After viewing replays and hearing evidence from all parties the JCA found the charge proved and suspended Mr Bradley's riding licence from the 18th February up to and including 6th March (6 days).

BETTY MAY (L Callaway) – Hampered at the 300 metres.

PESHAWAR (D Prastiyou) – Not afforded clear racing room throughout the home straight and went to the line untested by its rider. Trainer reported that the gelding had been galloped on during the running.

Race 2 SPEIGHT'S HANDICAP (1200m)

SON OF SURF (T Jonker) – Shifted out abruptly at the start losing ground and then lost contact with the body of the field despite the efforts of its rider.

THE LIKELY LAD (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and got back. Raced wide from the 900 metres. Weakened over the concluding stages finishing in a distant last placing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

GET RYTHM (T Moseley) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 300 metres.

K Selvan (JIM'S GIFT) was issued a warning under the Careless Riding Rule in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards passing the 350 metres crowding GET RHYTHM.

JIM'S GIFT (K Selvan) – Held up rounding the final bend.

SUPATWISTA (R Beeharry) – When questioned regarding the seemingly improved performance trainer B Tapper advised that the mare had appreciated the easing of the track conditions.

Race 3 SHEET METALCRAFT HANDICAP (1200m)

TICKETS ON HER (R Hannam) – Late scratching at 1.18pm after becoming cast in the barrier. Connections were advised the mare must barrier trial prior to racing next.

NOPELE (K Selvan) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages. Had to be steadied off heels when over racing passing the 600 metres. Held up passing the 300 metres, having to shift ground outwards near the 150 metres to find clear running.

HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) – Improved very wide from the 800 metres.

BELLE HOPE (D Turner) – Placed in restricted room passing the 500 metres, having to be steadied momentarily.

PROMISING (G Saejorhor) – Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

Race 4 ROBERT DENNIS RACING STABLES MAIDEN (1600m)

REMARKABLE KATE (K Selvan) – Began awkwardly and got back.

OUR BOY BAZ (K Chowdhoory) – Slow through the early stages. Shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

POILU (T Jonker) – Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

THE FLAGON (T Moseley) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

SCANDALOUS (D Turner) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

EAGER BEAVER (G Saejorhor) – Held up rounding the final bend and shifted out passing the 275 metres to find clear racing room.

G Saejorhor was issued a warning under the Careless Riding Rule in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards near the 275 metres crowding and dictating HIGHLY ROYAL wider resulting in that runner having to steady.

HIGHLY ROYAL (J Morris) – Inconvenienced and forced wider near the 275 metres having to steady.

Race 5 WHITE ROBE LODGE (2115m)

ROCK SOLID (K Selvan) – Slow to begin.

FRIDAY KNIGHT (R Beeharry) – Crowded at the start and lost ground. Raced wide in the early and middle stages.

NESTA (L Callaway) – Over-raced and made the first bend awkwardly. Improved wide from the 900 metres.

KAURI COVE (T Moseley) – Momentarily crowded and had to steady near the 1700 metres when RIVERA ROCK lay inwards.

QUEEN EL JAY (J Morris) – Got its head up when being restrained to take cover through the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported in her opinion the mare had failed to back up from its previous start at Invercargill on the 7th February.

TE QUIERA (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide from the 1400 metres. Weakened over the concluding stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities other than the mare to have a slow recovery. Stewards will follow up with trainers J & K Parsons in the coming days.

Race 6 DUNEDIN CASINO SOUTHLAND STAKES (1400m)

NIGHTCAP (T Moseley) – Bounded at the start.

SHAARA (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Crowded and had to steady passing the 650 metres when KOXINGA (T Jonker) shifted inwards when only marginally clear. **T Jonker** was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Rider accidentally dropped his whip passing the 40 metres.

KING PIN (K Chowdhoory) – Bounded at the start and lost ground. Raced wide throughout. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 350 metres when held up for clear racing room. Steadied passing the 180 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of FINBARR (L Callaway) which shifted in at this point. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

SECRET POWER (J Morris) – Raced wide in the early stages.

KIWI IDA (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide from the 800 metres. Lay in passing the 175 metres and had to be straightened.

ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE (D Prastiyou) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported carrying the top weight had been detrimental to the gelding's effort today.

Race 7 ILT ASCOT PARK HOTEL SOUTHLAND GUINEAS (1600m)

MORE JOOLS (C Barnes) – Proved difficult to load. A warning was placed on the barrier record of the filly. Restrained passing the 500 metres and lost momentum when the runner in front was checked.

AIR MAX (T Moseley) – Raced wide in the early stages.

DECEPTIO VISUS (J Lowry) – Obliged to improve wide from the 700 metres.

FOX IN SOCKS (R Hannam) – Steadled when racing in restricted room passing the 600 metres. Made contact with SULU SEA near the 550 metres.

SULU SEA (L Callaway) – Raced wide for the majority of the event. Hampered passing the 500 metres.

FIRE SHOW (T Comignaghi) – Crowded and checked passing the 500 metres with the trailing MORE JOOLS also having to be steadied at this point, losing ground. Shifted in when struck with the whip passing the 200 metres, making firm contact with the running rail. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

D Bradley (UPSCALE) admitted a breach of Careless Riding in that he allowed his runner to shift inwards passing the 500 metres dictating AIR MAX inwards on to FIRE SHOW who was crowded and checked. After viewing replays the JCA suspended Mr Bradley's riding licence from the 7th March up to and including 14th March (6 days.)

CITY SLICKER (BB Hong) – Lay out early in the run home, shifting wider on the track near the 200 metres and having to be straightened.

Race 8 BAILLIE & LEWIS PHARMACY INVERCARGILL GOLD CUP (2600m)

FRANCONI (D Bradley) - Slow to begin.

THE QUIET MAN (A Bohorun) – Raced wide in the early stages.

TANIWHA (J Morris) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

MADAM DE SOIR (R Hannam) – Improved wide passing the 1000 metres.

SHANTAV (T Jonker) – Shifted outwards off the heels of a tiring runner in front near the 300 metres. Returned to the birdcage with some blood on the leg. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a minor abrasion.

D Turner (OREPUKI LAD) was reminded of his obligations in regards to his use of the whip on a runner winning by a clear margin.

Race 9 CASTLEDALE @ TE RUNGA SUMMER CUP (1600m)

AULYN STAR (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

FIVE KINGS (R Beeharry) – Raced wide in the early stages and made the bend by the 1400 metres awkwardly, shifting wider on the track, then obliged to race wide for the remainder of the event.

TIMY TYLER (G Saejorhor) – Saddle slipped forward passing the 1200 metres placing the rider in some difficulty, shifting out and inconveniencing ZABAY. Continued to race wide thereafter with the saddle repositioning passing the 800 metres.

ZABAY (C Campbell) – Inconvenienced 1200 metres.

HOOFBEAT (R Hannam) – Under pressure from the 500 metres finishing in a distant last placing with the rider advising the gelding had blown hard on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild lameness in the left hind leg. The connections were advised a Veterinary Clearance is required prior to racing next.

Race 10 SEAN & BECKY BELLEW @ HARCOURTS HANDICAP (1600m)

SMOKEM UP (D Prastiyou) – Slow to begin.

MAJIC EL (G Saejorhor) – Made the first bend awkwardly, shifting wider on the track and was obliged to race wide without cover thereafter.

TANTELLA (R Hannam) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 1400 metres when MAJIC EL (G Saejorhor) shifted inwards under pressure. G Saejorhor was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

PICTURE ME ROLLIN (R Mudhoo) – Got its head up when racing keenly for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 800 metres. Rider reported that the saddle had slipped backwards passing the 500 metres.

MORRELLMAC (T Moseley) – Obliged to race wide from the 800 metres when attempting to improve.

THE SPARKLE (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

FULLTOTHEBRIM (D Bothamley) – Rider reported the gelding had lay in throughout the running and had to be straightened on a number of occasions during the run home.

CAIRNSVILLE (L Callaway) — Rider reported the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an injury to a front left tendon. The connections were advised the gelding would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.
