RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Gisborne Herald 2000
AQUARIUM (S Collett) - Raced wide around the first turn improving forward to lead near the 1400 metres.	
INVIGORATE (C Johnson) - Over-raced through the middle stages having to be checked to avoid heels near the 1100 metres. Had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of the weakening LENA near the 500 metres.	
RESURGENCE (C Grylls) - Raced wide throughout.	
SCOMADI (A Goindasamy) - Shifted inwards under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened passing the 100 metres.	
LENA (A Jones) - Following its poor performance a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
Race 2	Bronwyn Kay Country Homes 1200

MADAM ACE - Reluctant to load then became fractious in the barriers before jumping away awkwardly losing ground (5L). Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare for its barrier manners.

SO GOLD (H Durrant) - Slow to begin. Held up when disappointed for a run to the inside of SARAH SARAH (S MacNab) which shifted inwards near the 300 metres with SO GOLD then having to steady and shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running before again being held up over the concluding stages. S MacNab was advised to exercise greater care.

BELLE SOUTH (D Hirini) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering SARAH SARAH and SIMOGRAMOR. Briefly crowded passing the 300 metres when ONE WAY STREET lay in under pressure before being corrected by its rider.

SARAH SARAH (S MacNab) - Hampered start losing ground.

SIMOGRAMOR (S Johnson) - Hampered start.

GIZZY GOLD (J Fawcett) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

HEAVY NOVA (D Danis) - Ran wide going into the bend near the 800 metres.

Race 3	Gisborne Fisheries 1200
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ESBEEDEE (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

DESERT STORM (D Danis) - Jumped away awkwardly.

CARILLION (A Jones) - Raced three wide without cover.

LALA LAND (A Goindasamy) - Held up rounding the final turn continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

PRODIGAL SON (S Johnson) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

Race 4	Gisborne Scaffolding 1400
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ALBARON (S MacNab) - Slow to begin.

PENNY ROYAL (H Durrant) - Jumped away awkwardly.

WAIWETU LASS (C Grylls) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned regarding the poor performance rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the mare had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection found the mare to be mildly lame (1/5) in the right hind limb.

RUSTICANA (J Kam) - Raced wide without cover.

BRAWLER (A Jones) - Unable to obtain clear running over the final 250 metres going to the line without being able to be fully tested.

Race 5	Gisborne Refrigeration Mile
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MOFARA (D Danis) - Reared start losing ground. Had to be restrained when improving onto heels near the 1000 metres. Held up rounding the final turn then having to shift outwards to the extreme outside to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

<p>CAPELLANI (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages then having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of SWEET TREAT which shifted inwards near the 1000 metres when not fully clear.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (SWEET TREAT) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of CAPELLANI near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>POWERBALL (S MacNab) - Held up early in the final having to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 6	Ben Holden Fencing Poverty Bay Cup
<p>CHIC (R Myers) - Raced ungenerously passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p>SCAPOLO (S MacNab) - Steadied off heels for a distance near the 1200 metres when racing keenly.</p> <p>WIDE AWAKE (C Burdan) - Made contact with the running rail near the 900 metres after improving and becoming awkwardly placed on heels when racing keenly.</p> <p>PASABAHCE (C Johnson) - Raced in restricted room for a distance near the 300 metres.</p> <p>MONARCH CHIMES (J Fawcett) - Required veterinary attention post-race for a small puncture wound to the right hind from being galloped on during the running.</p>	
Race 7	Baty Plumbing & Drainage Mile
<p>This race ran two minutes late due to PADDINGTON being late to the start after requiring farrier attention.</p> <p>FORREST RED (S Johnson) - Raced keenly early on a slow tempo having to shift outwards to avoid heels near the 1400 metres.</p> <p>COME DANCE WITH ME (D Hirini) - Was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight.</p> <p>REFLECTION (A Goindasamy) - Steadied passing the 200 metres to avoid the heels of FORREST RED (S Johnson) which shifted inwards. S Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.</p>	
Race 8	Craigs Investment Partners 2000
<p>EM KAY POPS (D Hirini) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>TROUP ROAD (H Durrant) - Slow away. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>SUFFICE TO SAY (S Johnson) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>STRAIGHT FURROW (J Fawcett) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>IFFRAAJINATOR (A Jones) - Held up rounding the final turn before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.</p>
