Race 1	WAIROA STUD BREEDERS 1200		
SAN SIRO (C Grylls) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after rearing its the barrier stall and was cleared			
to start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.			

MADAM ACE (S Johnson) - Was a late scratching at 1:04pm after refusing to load. Connections were advised that the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

POKURU'S GIFT (R Myers) - Shifted out abruptly at the start hampering SARAH SARAH which got back.

SARAH SARAH (C O'Beirne) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after losing ground.

UP 'N' GONE (J Fawcett) - Raced in restricted room just prior to the winning post.

TINDER HIT (J Parkes) - When questioned into the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

Race 2 PADDY KENNEDY MEMORIAL 1300

VIRTUOSO LAD (J Parkes) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 3 SUNSET POINT BAR & BISTRO 1200

MISS SCANDINAVIA (C Burdan) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the turn awkwardly when hanging outwards. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

EXPEDITION (S Collett) - Slow away.

Race 4 KENILWORTH PLUMBING 1900

TRUMPET (C Grylls) - Bounded at the start and lost ground then raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

LOUBOUTIN (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

INVIGORATE (C Johnson) – Made the first bend awkwardly when over racing then continued to over race in the middle stages.

MAKABAR (S Johnson) – Lay out rounding the first bend running wide then commenced to over race in the middle stages.

Race 5WAIROA BUSINESS SUPPORTERS CUP TRIAL 1900

FRANCIS DRAKE (S Johnson) – Began awkwardly and was slow away. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1400 metres.

HUNTA PENCE (S Collett) – Made the first bend awkwardly and shifted out placing FLAG THE GROOM in restricted room which had to steady.

FLAG THE GROOM (R Myers) – Steadied when placed in restricted room entering the bend near the 1650 metres.

SAINT KITT (H Durrant) - Had to shift out entering the final straight to obtain clear running room.

Race 6 RUSSELL ROADS 1900

EM KAY POPS (C O'Beirne) – Slow away.

SUFFICE TO STAY (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PIERIAN SPRING (C Dell) – Had to be firmly restrained after improving onto heels near the 900 metres.

EN SUITE (S MacNab) - Held up throughout the final straight.

Race 7 K9 PETFOODS 1400

SENOR MOSS (C Johnson) - Shifted out abruptly at the start hampering COME DANCE WITH ME (S Collett) which was tightened and lost ground.

AFTER FIVE (C O'Beirne) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

COME DANCE WITH ME (S Collett) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up until near the 150 metres before having to shift ground outwards approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

ALBARON (S MacNab) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 150 metres.

GIZZY GOLD (C Dell) - Steadied when weakening passing the 150 metres when CHE GUEVARA (J Parkes) shifted out slightly. J Parkes was advised to exercise care.

Race 8 VISTA MOTOR LODGE 1400

MADAM MAKFI (C O'Beirne) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching at 5:12pm. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to next racing.

GARADOS (A Jones) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider A Jones advised stewards that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. Lost the left front plate during the running. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed lameness in the right front leg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

POWERBALL (S MacNab) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres forcing QUEEN SWEEP (J Fawcett) and LORD HIGH SPIRIT (C Grylls) wider on the track with those two runners making contact.

QUEEN SWEEP (J Fawcett) – Forced wider near the 400 metres then bumped.

LORD HIGH SPIRIT (C Grylls) – Forced wider near the 400 metres then bumped.

QUICK CHOICE (J Parkes) – When questioned regarding the performance of the horse J Parkes could offer no excuse. Trainer J Bary undertook to monitor the mares progress over coming days and to report any abnormality to the Stewards.
