Rider D Turner did not attend today's meeting and was replaced on his three rides yesterday morning at 6.20 am. Replacements as per schedule below. D Turner admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(a), breaking riding engagements, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$200.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PUNTERS CHALLENGE 6 APRIL – ENTER NOW RATING 72 (1400m)
WHY ME (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.	
BALLYBAY (Z Moki) – When racing keenly shifted outwards to avoid the heels of ABRAHAMS (C Johnson) which shifted	

inwards near the 1100 metres when not fully clear, raced three wide without cover and continued to over race through the middle stages. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.

ABRAHAMS (C Johnson) – Raced keenly outside the leaders in the early stages, had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 2	KORU CARE CHARITY DINNER – 22 MARCH RATING 65 (2000m)
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MISS CURIOUS (C Johnson) – Over raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages on a slow tempo, unable to obtain clear running over the final 150 metres.

TE QUIERA (C Campbell) – Lay inwards in the final straight shifting ground in. When spoken to regarding the improved performance, co-trainer K Parsons advised they could only put the last disappointing performance down to a wet track.

LETSBRINGITON (J Lowry) – Held up in the final straight and when attempting to angle outwards across heels near the 350 metres struck a heel and blundered badly.

COUP DREAMWOOD (K Chowdhoo) – Rider reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

Race 3	WALKER DAVEY SEARELLS CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS & BUSINESS ADVISORS MAIDEN (1800m)
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K Moore (PRODUCER) was issued with a warning after presenting the gelding with incorrect gear namely a tongue tie.

PRODUCER (T Jonker) – Dropped its head as the gates opened being slow away as a result and then got its head up in the early stages when being restrained losing further ground, improved forward wide from the 800 metres. When questioned regarding her ride T Jonker advised that the gelding races better when left to settle in the early stages which she was attempting to do. She added that the horse had not responded when ridden handier on other occasions. Her explanation was noted and she was advised she is expected to ride with better judgement in future.

UNHINGED (G Saejorhor) – Over raced in the early stages and was heavily restrained passing the 1600 metres to take a trailing position.

CEE SHARP (K Chowdhoo) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, over raced on a slow tempo and had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of UNHINGED when that runner was being heavily restrained by its rider, continued to over race making contact with the running rail and was again restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres, heavily restrained again passing the 800 metres, held up for some distance passing the 100 metres.

DOUBT THAT (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

NATHAN DETROIT (B Morgenrood) – Finished in last placing with the rider advising that the gelding had been awkward in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

T Jonker (PRODUCER) was issued with a warning for her whip use, with her arm being raised above shoulder height.

Race 4	CLARE YARDLEY BARRISTER RATING 65 (1600m)
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MUSEE D'ORSAY (R Mudhoo) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers when QUAINTELLE shifted inwards causing MUSEE D'ORSAY to have to steady losing ground, had to steady and shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

GLOSS (K Chowdhoo) – Rider lost the use of his outside stirrup passing the 100 metres.

OPIHI RANGER (T Comignaghi) – Lost contact with the body of the field over the concluding stages with the rider reporting the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

BABY MENAKA (C Campbell) – Rider reported the mare raced greenly throughout.

Race 5	NZB BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200m)
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SHE'S A BEAUTY (R Mudhoo) – Jumped away awkwardly, raced wide throughout.

SUNNY LADY (S Toolooa) – Hampered leaving the barriers when LANGBEIN jumped outwards, raced wide without cover throughout.

ROSIE MARIE (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

LANGBEIN (BB Hong) – Jumped outwards at the start. Raced very wide rounding the final bend and in the run home.

NELLIE BLY (K Chowdhoo) – Inclined to shift ground when under pressure in the final straight.

SPACE CADET (Z Moki) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight until the 250 metres.

Race 6	NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE 29 APRIL RATING 65 (1200m)
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CINDERELLA (S Collett) was a late scratching at 3.15 pm at the barriers on veterinary advice as it was 3/5 lame in the right foreleg with a suspected flexor tendon injury. A veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to CINDERELLA racing again, with the connections to be spoken to at a later date.

ZAKYNTHOS (K Gundowry) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with LET HER RIP RILEY which was forced onto FRANKIE THE FOX. Crowded 300 metres having to steady.

CLARA (C Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly.

LET HER RIP RILEY (M Kareem) – Hampered when bumped at the start, shifted out passing the 300 metres forcing ZAKYNTHOS to be crowded and steadied.

M Kareem (LET HER RIP RILEY) was issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift out forcing ZAKYNTHOS to be crowded and steadied passing the 300 metres.

FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) – Hampered when bumped at the start.

SWISS EIRE (K Chowdhoo) – Held up for a short distance near the 200 metres.

STARMAKER (T Comignaghi) – When questioned regarding the improved performance, trainer S Woodsford advised that the mare had appreciated the claim and a change in gear today.

Race 7	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE MAIDEN (1400m)
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The start of this race was delayed due to **HILLERSDEN** proving difficult to load, with a barrier warning placed against the gelding's record.

MONASH (G Saejorhor) – Slow to begin.

TOO FERLAXED (C Campbell) – Slow to begin, held up entering the final straight having to shift outwards to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

CHORISTER (B Morgenrood) – Knuckled leaving the barriers making contact with ROTHACKER.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (T Jonker) – Commenced to over race near the 1000 metres and then continued to race fiercely through the middle stages getting its head up.

STIRLING LADY (T Comignaghi) – Raced three wide without cover.

ROTHACKER (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.
