SUPPLEMENTARY:

<u>Canterbury Racing 22 February 2019</u> Race 3 WALKER DAVEY SEARELLS CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS & BUSINESS ADVISORS MAIDEN (1800m) Trainer P Robson advised Stewards that NATHAN DETROIT is being treated for a bacterial infection and will be freshened before resuming.

GENERAL:

RACE 5 – The starter, Russell McAra, was questioned in relation to the positioning of the starting gates at the 1200 metres. After hearing from the starter, R McAra, and the Course Manager, Mr Wayne Stevens it was found that the gates had been positioned approximately 30 metres from the surveyed mark for the rail being in the true position today. This being rectified for the remaining 1200 metre races. Acting under NZTR Starters Manual Sub Section 4.4 the starting position of the gates - Mr McAra was spoken to advisedly and advised that at all times prior to a meeting he had to consult with the Course Manager to identify the correct survey marks. Stewards when assessing penalty took into account that Mr McAra's assistant starter had been injured and taken to hospital earlier in the day.

Race 1	WINGATUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 1600m
<p>I AM A ROCK (D Bothamley) – Proved difficult to load. Barrier manners warning placed on the gelding’s record.</p> <p>EAGER BEAVER (B Murray) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start.</p> <p>MANHATTEN FIRE (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly early stages.</p> <p>RAISE YA CARDS (C Campbell) – Raced wide early stages.</p> <p>DANZI CREEK (T Comignaghi) – Raced in restricted room for some distance passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>BLUEY’S CHANCE (T Jonker) – When questioned , about the performance of favoured runner ,rider reported that the gelding in her opinion would be better on a track with more moisture in it adding the gelding may benefit from being ridden with cover when racing over this distance in future.</p> <p>LUNAR LADY (K Chowdhoo) – When questioned about the performance the rider reported that the mare had been flat from the start and failed to run on when placed under full pressure.</p>	
Race 2	OTAGO FARM MACHINERY 820m
<p>D Crozier (ROSARITO) – Warned for presenting runner without notified gear.</p> <p>SPEIGHTS (J Lowry) – Attempted to buck passing the 750 metres and was restrained taking no further competitive part. The connections were advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>SANDY COOL (B Murray) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>TOUCHABEEL (T Comignaghi) – Blundered on jumping getting back as a result and getting its head up on a number of occasions through the early stages. Hampered passing the 200 metres when dictated wider by inside runner.</p> <p>VIVACE LADY (L Allpress) – Lay out in the home straight.</p> <p>ROSARITO (C Barnes) – Shifted outwards abruptly in the shadows of the post.</p>	
Race 3	SPEIGHT’S 2200m
<p>The start of this event was delayed firstly when SWEET TIME became fractious in its barrier and starter’s assistant B Small ,being kicked ,and attended to by the St John ambulance staff.</p> <p>SWEET TIME (R Hannam) –Fractious in the barrier prior to the start kicking out and was late scratched at 1.07 pm. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.</p>	

THE LUSTRE (B Murray) – Bounded, reared and bucked as the start was effected losing considerable ground. Retired from the event passing the 1200 metres. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.

TE QUIERA (C Campbell) – Over raced into the first bend. Lay inwards passing the 150 metres having to be straightened.

PAMIR (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide early stages.

SMOKE HOUSE BAY (T Comignaghi) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1900 metres due to the lack of tempo early in the race. Hung inwards in the early stages of the home straight.

ROCK SOLID (K Mudhoo) – Awkwardly placed between runners passing the 1900 metres having to steady due to the lack of tempo. K Mudhoo was questioned regarding his ride passing the 1400 metres when Pamir was able to improve inwards to obtain cover he advised that he was reluctant to trail up SMOKE HOUSE BAY at this point of the race when the tempo increased believing it was better to keep his mount settled, K Mudhoo was severely reprimanded by the Stewards and advised that he must not leave his rides open to query in future.

MAJIC EL (L Allpress) – Wide for a short distance passing the 1400 metres. Lost its right fore plate during the running and after the rider reported it felt indifferent in its action during the running underwent a veterinary inspection which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

LIL MISS SWISS (G Saejorhor) – Blundered when in restricted room near the 1400 metres.

Race 4	SOUTHERN WIDE REALITY 1600m

SHAKTI (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

RESIDENTIAL (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide early stages.

TOMM JONES (R Hannam) – Raced keenly early stages.

FLYING SARDINE (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide throughout. Inconvenienced when bumped from the inside passing the 350 metres.

BLOODSTREAM (L Allpress) – Bumped and unbalanced passing the 350 metres when TOMMY TUCKER (J Lowry) attempted to improve to its inside.

J Lowry was warned and reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE (J Fawcett) – Lay outwards and bumped with RESIDENTIAL near the 200 metres.

TOMMY TUCKER (J Lowry) – Hampered passing the 200 metres when MACY shifted ground outwards.

Race 5	KB CONTRACTORS 1200m

ABBEY KAY (G Jogoo) – Late scratched on veterinary advice after being fractious in its barrier at 2.15 pm. The connections were advised that the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to starting again.

PLUTONIUM (K Mudhoo) – Made contact with JESSIE JANET shortly after the start and became unbalanced.

CABERNET (C Campbell) – Got its head up when in restricted room when DREAMING EASY was taken inwards by TOUCH THE SKY passing the 1100 metres. Continued to over race for some distance. Lay inwards early in home straight and had to be straightened.

JESSIE JANET (L Callaway) – Contacted shortly after the start. Wide early stages.

DREAMING EASY (R Mudhoo) – Over raced in the early stages .Placed in restricted room near the 1100 metres and had to check. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

MAGIC NOTE (T Comignaghi) – Steadied passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of TOUCH THEY SKY.

PROMISING (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide throughout. Returned to the Birdcage with blood present in one nostril. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be a bleeder. The connections were advised the mare is now required to have a three month stand down.

JIM'S GIFT (T Moseley) – Held up early stages of the run home having to shift outwards to obtain clear racing room inside the 150 metres.

B Murray (TOUCH THE SKY) – Defended a breach of careless riding with the assistance of Mr D Walsh, when shifting ground inwards passing the 1100 metres. After hearing relevant evidence from Stewards and the initial evidence from B Murray, the JCA adjourned the matter due to Mr Walsh having to leave the course. The matter is set down for the Gore Racing Club's meeting on 10th March.

Race 6 'gavelhouse.com auction online now' 1200m

The start was delayed when the barriers had to be moved to the correct surveyed mark.

THE MAN (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

SHAARA (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

FEELIN THE LOVE (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly.

KING PIN (C Campbell)- Restrained after the start to obtain cover.

BARABAS (J Morris) – Keen for a distance early .

NOWHERE MAN (L Allpress) – Raced keenly early stages.

MR TYPHON (K Chowdhoory) – Raced keenly early stages.

FINBARR (L Callaway) – Held up passing the 200 metres and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

Race 7 POSITIVE SIGNS LTD 1200m

NOPELE (B Murray) – Slow to begin losing considerable ground (5 lengths).Connections advised they will give consideration to gear changes prior to the geldings next start.

FLY TO THE SKY (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly.

TICKETS ON HER (G Jogoo) – Fractious in the barriers.

VICE MARSHALL (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide throughout. Rider reported that the gelding felt indifferent in its action and had given ground passing the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

ALWAYS ON CALL (BB Hong) – Raced wide throughout. Contacted passing 250 metres. Lay inwards over the concluding stages and made contact with **THE SWISS MAESTRO**.

THE SWISS MAESTRO (K Chowdhoo) – Bumped by **HEBERITE** (C Campbell) passing the 250 metres. Steadied when contacted between runners passing the 100 metres.

HEBERITE (C Campbell) – Shifted ground passing the 250 metres dictating **THE SWISS MAESTRO** outwards which made contact with **ALWAYS ON CALL**.

C Campbell was warned for the manner in which shifting ground.

Race 8	NZB INSURANCE STAKES 1400m

TIMES TIME (B Murray) – Began awkwardly.

DEVIL'S STAIRCASE (K Mudhoo) – Shifted in on jumping crowding the running of **SEVERINE**, **TEE CEE COUP**, **SENTITO** and **DRUMSPIRIT**. Steadied momentarily passing the 1250 metres when **EMILY MARGARET** (R Hannam) shifted inwards.

R Hannam warned for shifting ground

SEVERINE (L Allpress) - Crowded on jumping.

TEE CEE COUP (K Chowdhoo) – Hampered on jumping. Lay inwards away from outside runner near the 1200 metres making firm contact with inside runner.

SENTITO (D Bothamley) - Crowded on jumping. Steadied and lost position when contacted passing the 1200 metres when outside runners shifted inwards.

DRUMSPIRIT (C Campbell) - Hampered on jumping

SUPERSTATIC (G Jogoo) – Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

DREAMTESTA (BB Hong) – Raced wide early.

EXEMPLAR (T Moseley) – Lay inwards in the early part of the home straight with the rider using the whip in the left hand.

Race 9	ANDY BAY LIQUORLAND 1600m

LONDONDERRY AIR (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

THE BUMPER (T Jonker) – Raced wide throughout.

TAIERI GEM (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout.

FINAL SAY (B B Hong) – Raced in restricted room passing the 800 metres contacting a heel and blundering momentarily.

TEDDYTWINKLETOES (K Cowan) – Wide early stages. Held up for some distance on entering the home straight until near the 200 metres and had to shift outwards to obtain clear running.

PICTURE ME ROLLIN (R Mudhoo) – Inclined to lay inwards in the final straight.

Race 10

WHITE ROBE LODGE 1600m

COCEE (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

GLOSS (K Chowdhoo) – Raced wide early stages when ridden forward to lead .Gave ground quickly from the 400 metres. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Stewards will follow up with trainers in coming days.

VALENTINA VITTORIA (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide throughout.

THE SPARKLE (B Murray) – Raced wide throughout.

TONY TWO CHIPS (J Lowry) – Held up early and middle stages of the home straight.

MONTSERRAT (K Cowan) –Badly held up by a tiring runner near the 400 metres.

MOSSY CREEK (C Campbell) – Held up in the early stages of the run home having to shift wider to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.

JUST PUSH PLAY (K Mudhoo) – Placed in restricted room near the 500 metres when MAJOR ISH CHOUX (L Allpress) shifted outwards .L Allpress reminded of her obligations when shifting ground .Inclined to lay inwards in the early part of the home straight having to be straightened when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres.
