# Race 5 CAVALLO FARM & CHRIS RUTTEN BLOODSTOCK 1600

**TIRO** (C Johnson) – Trainer R Bergerson advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with the current preparation.

#### Auckland Racing Club - 9 March 2019

#### Race 9 Barfoot & Thompson Auckland Cup (3200 metres)

**CHARLES ROAD** (C Grylls) – Trainer A Scott advised Stewards that in the days following this race a stone bruise became apparent in the gelding's off front foot, further advising that CHARLES ROAD had undergone blood tests which revealed the gelding to be suffering from low grade signs of infection. Mr Scott added that the gelding had now been treated and it is their intention to continue on with its current preparation.

### **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1	TIRAU VETERINARY SERVICES 1600
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**SALTIRE** (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**CLEARLY NOW** (B R Jones) – Had to be firmly restrained when placed in restricted room between KRAKADEEL which lay out and LOVE OVER GOLD which shifted in passing the 500 metres.

**KRAKADEEL** (M Cameron) – Was not persevered with over the final 100 metres. Rider M Cameron was questioned into the gelding's performance and was unable to offer any reason. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

**SEEMAX** (D Mansour) – Rider dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

## Race 2 TOKOROA COSMOPOLITAN CLUB 1400

ON THE NIGHTTRAIN (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

FIVE STARS (D Mansour) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HARBOURSIDE (T Harris) – Over-raced in the early stages making the 800 metre bend awkwardly.

**NOT USUAL DREAM** (O Bosson) – Hung throughout, and then was briefly held up early in the final straight shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

## Race 3 TREES TAVERN 1200

MOERAKI (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly shifting in crowding CHECKERS which had to be steadied losing ground.

**EARLY MORNING RISE** (L Satherley) Crowded and checked 100 metres.

**SELENELION** (M Cameron) – Commenced to over-race for a distance when being steadied passing the 1000 metres.

**GUS THE MAVERICK** (J Bayliss) – Commenced to over-race near the 800 metres making the bend awkwardly.

**C Lammas** MOERAKI – C Lammas admitted a breach of careless riding in that he angled his mount MOERAKI in when not the required distance clear of EARLY MORNING RISE which was steadied and checked near the 100 metres. After hearing all relevant evidence, the Judicial Committee suspended C Lammas' license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 20 March up to and including racing on 25 March, 5 national riding days.

### Race 4 MATLEY FINANCIAL SERVICES 1200

MARY GOLD (M McNab) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

THE GREEN DRAGON (J Bayliss) – Slow to begin.

**NOTHING COMPARES** (S Collett) – Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of MARY GOLD (M McNab) which had to be steadied after attempting a marginal run passing the 200 metres. M McNab was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

## Race 5 TOKOROA CLUB (INC) 1200

**HELENA BABY** (D Mansour) – Commenced to lay out passing the 50 metres having to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SPEEDY MEADY.

#### Race 6 RETOX BAR 1200

**ROSA FIORE** (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after having to be steadied. Briefly held up until shifting in across heels passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.

**SLINKY LINKY** (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**IMA DANDY DUDE** (D Mansour) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

**THE FAITH** (M McNab) – Commenced to lay in under pressure crowding IMA DANDY DUDE which had to steady and shift out passing the 200 metres.

CHEERS (A Goindasamy) – Steadied over the concluding stages when placed in restricted room.

**UPSET** (S Collett) – When questioned into the performance of UPSET the favourite rider S Collett was unable to offer any tangible excuse.

## Race 7 HOLSTER ENGINEERING LALLY AND SYMES SOUTH WAIKATO CUP

VOLER POUR MOI (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly.

**TAMING THE SHREW** (D Danis) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

**FABULOUS FLIGHT** (N Bakar) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**KONSTANTINA** (M Cameron) – Rider M Cameron was spoken to regarding the way he eased the pace near the 1500 metres.

**SHE'S A RIPPER** (C Lammas) – Raced keenly in the early stages and shifted out improving forward to lead passing the 1400 metres when the pace eased.

## Race 8 TEAM WEALLEANS 1400

**RASPBERRY SWEET** (T Thornton) – Knuckled shortly after jumping away losing ground. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**SCAGLIONI** (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin.

**SLOW HANDS** (T Yanagida) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**THE CHASER** (M McNab) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**SOLOMON** (J Fawcett) – Not persevered with over the concluding stages with the rider reporting the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have suffered from an atrial fibrillation with the connections advised a veterinary clearance being required prior to trialing or racing again.

**A Goindasamy** SCAGLIONI – Was questioned as to the reason he had elected to shift out to a four wide position to improve forward from the 700 metres – he advised that he had been instructed to start improving forward early and also accepted that he had erred in his judgement on this occasion.

### Race 9 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

AWAY CRUISING (T Harris) - Began awkwardly.

IF AT FIRST (J Bayliss) - Slow to begin.

**AFTER FIVE** (J Kam) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of TRIP TO FREEDOM after attempting to improve into a marginal run near the 100 metres.
