Race 1	SIM'S BAKERY RATING 72 1200
<p>THEONLYWAY Late scratched on veterinary advice at 12.29 pm after being injured on route to the course.</p> <p>BARABAS (T Comignaghi) - Jumped away awkwardly, lay inwards passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>MR TYPHON (K Chowdhooory) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>T Comignaghi (BARABAS) admitted a charge in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 14 March up to and including 25 March.</p>	
Race 2	NORM AND LEANNE STEWART RATING 65 1200
<p>ULTRA CHIC (K Cowan) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>LET HER RIP RILEY (S Wynne) – Over raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>FLY TO THE SKY (T Moseley) – Bumped with FROSTED passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>FROSTED (C Johnson) – Bumped with FLY TO THE SKY passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>CELTIC WONDER (T Comignaghi) – Not afforded complete clear running early in the home straight.</p>	
Race 3	MORRISON'S SADDLERY MAIDEN 1200
<p>THREE SHOTS (S Toolooa) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with VAN HALEN with both riders becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>VAN HALEN (C Barnes) – Bumped at the start unbalancing the rider.</p> <p>CAILIN (B Murray) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ARNAGE (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly, made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres having to be restrained off heels and getting its head up on a number of occasions, got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 500 metres. Underwent a post race veterinary inspection after returning to the enclosure with blood in the mouth which was found to be from a lost incisor cap.</p> <p>CHAMPAGNE ON ICE (B Morgenrood) – Crowded leaving the barriers when ROAD TO DIAMONDS jumped inwards.</p> <p>ROAD TO DIAMONDS (G Jogoo) –Steadied passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>DANNY GREEN (R Mudhoo) – Held up passing the 400 metres, shifted ground outwards passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>ALONZO (K Chowdhooory) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 250 metres having to steady and shifted ground outwards passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>WHALE SONG (K Gundowry) – Over raced when awkwardly placed on the heels of VAN HALEN(C Barnes) which shifted inwards passing the 900 metres. Denied a clear run passing the 200 metres and found clear running passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>C Barnes was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.</p>	

Race 4	METHVEN EQUINE CENTRE MAIDEN 2100
<p>Trainer J Blackadder (I AM A ROCK) admitted a breach of presenting a runner with leather reins which are not permitted, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$100</p> <p>LATASSO (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BAHHGOOFY (G Saejorhor) – Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start, raced in restricted room for some distance passing the 1800 metres having to be steadied off heels on a number of occasions.</p> <p>DIPLOMAT (T Moseley) – Got its head up when racing in tight quarters passing the 1800 metres.</p> <p>ROULETTE (R Mudhoo) – Over raced and got its head up when steadied off the heels of the leader passing the 1800 metres when the tempo of the race eased and continued to over race for some distance thereafter.</p> <p>CINTO BAY (BB Hong) – Raced wide throughout. Lay in through out the home straight. Underwent a post race veterinary inspection after returning to the enclosure with blood in the mouth which was found to be from a lost incisor cap.</p> <p>GRANT (T Comignaghi) – Improved wide and raced forward from the 1300 metres, lay inwards passing the 300 metres and had to be straightened, placed in restricted room and checked passing the 200 metres when CINTO BAY (BB Hong) shifted inwards.</p> <p>BB Hong admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 9 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 14 March up to and including 29 March.</p> <p>PRODUCER (B Murray) – Held up on entering the home straight.</p> <p>HARD BUT FAIR (S Wynne) - Held up on entering the home straight.</p> <p>LETZPARTYON (C Johnson) – Tightened between runners passing the 250 metres having to steady. When questioned about his ride in the early stages of the home straight, rider C Johnson advised that the mare was under pressure and not travelling well turning for home and prior to running out of room near the 250 metres. C Johnson was advised he was not to leave his rides open to query and is expected to show more vigour in similar circumstances. Co-trainer K Parsons reported that the mare had struck itself during the running and they would be giving consideration to its racing future. A post race veterinary inspection revealed superficial skin wounds/lacerations to the left hind leg.</p> <p>G Jogoo (DOUBT THAT) was reminded of his obligations when attempting to ease the tempo of the race.</p>	
Race 5	ECOLAB RATING 82 2200
<p>BAL HARBOUR (T Jonker) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection after making contact with a gate leaving the birdcage and cleared to race. Shifted in abruptly at the start and then over raced for a short distance passing the 1800 metres, raced wide for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>TAXIHOME (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>C Campbell (LADY BEALEY) was warned regarding use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400m)
<p>THUNDER BAY (K Chowdhoo) – Permission was granted to race in blinkers which were missing from publications due to an administrative error. Got its head up when over racing passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SHE'S A BEAUTY (R Mudhoo) – Stumbled badly as the start was effected. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>RELIABLE GLOW (K Gundowry) -Slow to begin.</p>	

SPACE CADET (D Turner) – Began awkwardly, steadied momentarily when LLOVIZNA lay outwards passing the 300 metres.

G Jogoo (Llovizna) was warned for shifting ground passing the 300 metres.

NORMA JEAN (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SHOCK PROSPECT (D Prastiyou) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

ZURAFAA (L Callaway) – Raced wide throughout.

SUCCOSO SEGRETO (C Campbell) – Raced wide for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

LANGBEIN (S Wynne) – Heavily restrained passing the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

SHOW CLOUD (B Morgenrood) – Not afforded clear running early in the home straight having to shift ground outwards passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.

VOLVIK (J Laking) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 250 metres.

Race 7	ECOLAB RATING 82 1400
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STROWAN (D Prastiyou) – Commenced to buck shortly after the start dislodging the rider who was transferred to hospital for further evaluation of an ankle injury. Stewards informed the connections that given STROWAN's previous history of similar incidents, they would give consideration to requirements that will need to be met before the gelding is permitted to race again.

XCUSES XCUSES (C Johnson) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained shortly after leaving the barriers before being further hampered by the riderless STROWAN which ducked outwards when dislodging its rider. Held up for a short distance passing the 450 metres.

MAMMA SANS (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly when in the lead.

KOXINGA (T Jonker) – Had to be steadied passing the 350 metres to avoid the heels of the riderless runner.

BALLYBAY (B Murray) – Inclined to lay outwards throughout the final straight.

Race 8	THE BRAND FAMILY RATING 65 1600
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IRISH EXPRESS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, after improving quickly onto heels heavily restrained for some distance passing the 1100 metres, steadied passing the 350 metres when awkwardly placed on heels, continued to race in restricted room until passing the 200 metres.

RIDE THE STORM (S Wynne) – Raced wide in the early stages, steadied momentarily passing the 200 metres when attempting a marginal run.

BABY MENAKA (G Jogoo) – Raced wide in the early stages.

THAILAND (C Johnson) – Raced keenly for a distance after being restrained passing the 1000 metres, raced keenly for a distance passing the 800 metres.

MUSEE D'ORSAY (K Mudhoo) – Steadied and checked approaching the 200 metres when MOREIRA (K Cowan) shifted inwards.

MOREIRA (K Cowan) – Had to steady momentarily when awkwardly placed on heels of tiring runner passing the 250 metres.

K Cowan (MOREIRA) admitted a breach of careless riding approaching the 200 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 10 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 14 March up to and including 30 March.

JIN LU (J Laking) – Came together with EL CAMPEADOR and brushed passing the 50 metres.

EL CAMPEADOR (K Asano) – Came together with JIN LU and brushed passing the 50 metres.

T Moseley (IRISH EXPRESS) was issued with a warning for his whip use with his arm being raised above shoulder height.
