<u>Racing Te Aroha - 15th March 2019</u>
Race 2 THE BGP FOUNDATION BEAT THE CLOCK AT TE AROHA 1600
HENLEY ROAD (S Collett) – Trainer L Laing advised Stewards that upon return to her stable the mare was showing signs of lameness in the near hind leg which has now been treated, adding that HENLEY ROAD would now be freshened prior to racing next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	FORMPRO/BGP FOUNDATION BEAT THE CLOCK 1200
THE REVENANT (T Thornton) – Slow away. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.	

PALAMEDES (V Colgan) – Had to be steadied after being denied a marginal run to the inside of ALL PAID UP which shifted in slightly passing the 200 metres, then was held up for a distance.

ALL PAID UP (D Mansour) – Commenced to shift out under pressure approaching the 100 metres inconveniencing SHIPSHAPE.

SHIPSHAPE (L Satherley) – Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres.

Race 2 | **ALL FROCKED UP GIRLS 1200**

BELLA PRONTO (D Mansour) – Slow away.

CENGHAR (T Thornton) – Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing BOTHERED.

LADY LIRA (L Satherley) – Contacted and forced wider near the 600 metres by ERIDANI (T Yanagida) which shifted out.

T Yanagida (ERIDANI) – Issued with a warning for angling his mount out passing the 600 metres making contact with LADY LIRA which was forced wider.

BOTHERED (A Calder) – Inconvenienced in the final straight when CENGHAR (T Thornton) lay out when placed under pressure. T Thornton was advised to exercise care.

The connections of the fifth placed BOTHERED viewed Stewards footage of the final straight before electing not to proceed with a protest against the third placed CENGHAR.

Race 3 | **MILLS REEF WINERY AND RESTAURANT 1200**

ITS DESTINY'S CHILD (D Danis) – Began awkwardly and when being corrected shifted out bumping CINEMATIC which became briefly unbalanced losing ground. Returned to the birdcage with blood present in its left nostril. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration inside the nostril.

CINEMATIC (A Calder) – Contacted and unbalanced at the start losing ground.

Race 4 | **GRACE TEAM ACCOUNTING 1400**

LIBRETTI (D Danis) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Co-trainer S Ramsay advised Stewards that the connections would be considering the mare's racing future in the coming days.

POKER FACE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly, then was crowded shortly after having to steady.

AILEEN GRACE (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of STAND TALL (K McCulloch) which shifted in when not fully clear passing the 650 metres.

STAND TALL (K McCulloch) – Raced three wide without cover in the early stages. Contacted and forced wider near the 300 metres.

K McCulloch (STAND TALL) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in when not fully clear of AILEEN GRACE which had to be steadied near the 650 metres.

STACEY ANN (T Thornton) – Held up entering the final straight having to shift ground outwards near the 300 metres making contact with STAND TALL.

Race 5	MAURICE TRAPP GROUP 1400
<p>LALA LAND (C Dell) – Slow away. Improved on to heels passing the 800 metres having to be firmly restrained.</p> <p>RAPOSA RAPIDA (T Yanagida) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.</p> <p>FIRODEN (D Danis) – Crowded shortly after the start when WHITE SHIELD (D Mansour) shifted in when not fully clear.</p> <p>D Mansour (WHITE SHIELD) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear of FIRODEN which had to be steadied shortly after the start.</p> <p>BRUEGEL (A Calder) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages having to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>PIMMS 'N' PEARLS (A Goindasamy) – Steadied near the 800 metres when awkwardly placed on heels. Held up until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (PIMMS 'N' PEARLS) – Was spoken to for the manner in which he steadied the pace approaching the 800 metres to allow WHITE SHIELD to improve to the lead.</p>	
Race 6	TAURANGA VETS 1400
<p>ALL ROADS (K McCulloch) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>AZABOY (K Chowdhooory) - Slow away. Held up for clear running over the final 75 metres.</p> <p>RONCHI (D Danis) – Slow away.</p> <p>RANGIPO (V Colgan) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had not travelled comfortably throughout and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>SULTON OF SWING (D Mansour) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CAMINO ROCOSO (L Satherley) – Rider dropped her whip near the 50 metres.</p> <p>Team Rogerson (PASABAHCE) – Issued with a warning for presenting PASABAHCE to race in blinkers which were not notified.</p>	
Race 7	PACIFIC STONE KITCHEN AND VANITY BENCHTOPS 1600
<p>CUTTING UP ROUGH (N Alam) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 850 metres and shifted out. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.</p>	
Race 8	WORLDS END BAR AND RESTAURANT FREE BUS 2100
<p>ITSABIRD (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground (5L).</p> <p>OHTHOSERUSSIANS (D Mansour) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>GABRIEL (C Dell) – Crowded and steadied shortly after jumping away.</p> <p>PURSUED (T Yanagida) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages before being allowed to improve forward, making the crossing near the 1600 metres awkwardly.</p>	

JIMMY ROCKET (D Danis) – Held up rounding the final bend, then early in the final straight when becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to shift in to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

DIAMONDSANDBUBBLES (K McCulloch) – Bumped and unbalanced entering the final straight when JIMMY ROCKET shifted out in an attempt to obtain clear running.

PRIOR ENGAGEMENT (A Goindasamy) – Shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres making contact with OHTHOSERUSSIANS and as a result was momentarily unbalanced.
