RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	The Precinct Realty 2100
HEREMON (J Bayliss) – Made the first bend awkwardly when racing greenly.	

Race 2 NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race (1200 metres)

RIVETING (C Grylls) – Slow to begin. Steadied and shifted out passing the 100 metres when improving on to the heels of MADAM POMPOM.

MADAM POMPOM (M McNab) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 900 metres.

MIRADELLO (L Innes) – Briefly steadied and shifted out when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ANNA CECELIA which lay in under pressure near the 150 metres.

ANNA CECELIA (S McKay) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1000 metres. Lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.

Due to a malfunction with the video finish the Judge's initial and provisional call of 3, 1, 6, 2, 4 was amended prior to the authorization of dividends to 3, 1, 6, 4, 2.

Race 3 The Avondale Sunday Markets 1200

LOOKS LIKE (J Bayliss) – Raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

SILENT TRUTH (L Innes) – Held up entering the final straight before improving into a tight run to the inside of KIMENDY near the 300 metres.

CHAPEAU (S Collett) – Held up near the 200 metres until shifting outwards across the heels of KIMENDY to obtain clear running.

FLYING FLAME (O Bosson) – Unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

HIGHLAND DANCER (G Cooksley) – Lay out under pressure for the majority of the final straight.

THE LAST WORD (M McNab) – When questioned into the mare's performance the rider advised that the mare may prefer some more easing of the track with a post race veterinary examination revealing no abnormality.

Race 4 The Anzac Day at Avondale 25th April 2019 1400

IF AT FIRST (E McCall) – Hampered when leaving the barriers when KYA KHOOB LAGTI HO jumped inwards. Steadied when improving into restricted room near the 1200 metres to the inside of MATTER OF FACT which got its head up and raced ungenerously when being steadied. Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

MATTER OF FACT (M McNab) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1200 metres and unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

Race 5 The Cato Bolam 1200

TOITOI (C Grylls) – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 11.57am with a veterinary certificate of fitness now being required prior to racing next.

PATSYS LASS (S Collett) – Slow away.

FAST AND FURIOUS (T Thornton) – Slow away. Lay out away from STARMAN then becoming unbalanced when making contact with POKURU WILD approaching the 100 metres.

SALT BAY (J Bayliss)- Held up early in the final straight before improving into a marginal run approaching the 200 metres making contact with STARMAN.

POKURU WILD (M McNab) – Came together with THE ICE KNIGHT on a number of occasions in the final straight when racing in restricted room then further crowded approaching the 100 metres between FAST AND FURIOUS which lay out away from STARMAN and PATSYS LASS which shifted inwards slightly.

THE ICE KNIGHT (A Calder) – Came together with POKURU WILD on a number of occasions in the final straight when racing in restricted room then further crowded approaching the 100 metres between FAST AND FURIOUS which lay out away from STARMAN and PATSYS LASS which shifted inwards slightly.

STARMAN (O Bosson) – When questioned into the performance of STARMAN the rider advised that the gelding had travelled well but was quickly beaten once placed under pressure and was unable to offer any other reason with the gelding undergoing a post race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

Race 6 The Jigsaw Building Solutions 1600

SAVAPAK (M McNab) – Lay in under pressure early in the final straight.

Race 7 The West Brook Winery 1600

Trainer R Kramer (CAPE CEILIDH) – Issued with a warning after presenting the gelding with incorrect gear.

BAYEUX (C Dell) - Slow away.

ALBERATION (T Thornton) – Shifted out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

ODD MAN OUT (A Goindasamy) – Lost the near fore plate during the running.
