RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RYAN BRADLEY BAYLEYS COMMERCIAL MAIDEN (1600 metres)
WESTERN GIRL (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.	

POPPA'S SHOCK (J Bayliss) – Steadied entering the final straight after improving on to heels before shifting out to obtain clear running.

ON THE NIGHTTRAIN (M McNab) – When questioned regarding performance rider M McNab advised the gelding had never felt comfortable throughout the run. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

G Swann (BINGWA) – Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively on a horse that was out of contention.

Race 2 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1300 metres)**

KHORABELLA (S McKay) – Began awkwardly. Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly losing ground, then continued to lay out.

WALKIN' BY (D Mansour) – Slow to begin after being restless in the barrier.

HASAHALO (L Innes) – Held up throughout the final straight.

Race 3 | **TEAM WEALLEANS HANDICAP (1600 metres)**

STACEY ANN (T Thornton) – Held up rounding the final bend.

SINARAHMA (L Innes) – Inconvenienced 150 metres when shifting out under pressure on to the hind quarters of TIGHTLIGN. L Innes advised that the mare may now be suited to more ground.

Race 4 | **TRITON PACIFIC OWENS PLATE (1200 metres)**

SANTA CATARINA (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

VIRTUOSO LAD (S McKay) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

FULLINBLOOM (S Collett) – Hung outwards entering the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

Race 5 | **SNOW WILLIAMS BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE HANDICAP (2100 metres)**

NOCTURNAL (J Bayliss) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination when arriving at the barriers at the request of the rider and was cleared fit to start. Slow to begin becoming tailed off in the early stages. Underwent a veterinary examination following the race which revealed the mare to have bilateral forelimb stiffness. Trainer L Anderson was questioned regarding the condition of NOCTURNAL leading into today's race advising that the mare had trialed well on Tuesday 19 March and had hit out freely, further advising that she was happy with the condition of NOCTURNAL. NOCTURNAL is now required to have a veterinary clearance prior to racing next with trainer L Anderson advising that the mare would now be sent for a lengthy spell.

Race 6 | **DRYMIX CEMENT BAY OF PLENTY CUP (2100 metres)**

LADY SHABEEL (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly then crowded by FARM BOY which shifted in despite the efforts of its rider. Raced in restricted room passing the 700 metres.

FARM BOY (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

ROGER THAT (N Bakar) – Made contact with the running rail passing the 900 metres becoming unbalanced. Crowded approaching the 600 metres having to steady and shift in. ROGER THAT then had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until near the 150 metres.

N Bakar ROGER THAT - Issued with a warning for the manner in which he used the whip in the final straight.

CHA SIU BAO (C Grylls) – Had to steady when in restricted room approaching the 600 metres, and then was held up for a distance before shifting in to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres.

Race 7 | **WINDSOR PARK STUD JAPAN NZ INTERNATIONAL TROPHY (1600 metres)**

VINEVALE (B R Jones) – Slow to begin.

HE'S CAVALIER (T Thornton) – Slow to begin then crowded.

TIPTRONIC (L Innes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance L Innes explained that racing wide without cover had been detrimental to the gelding.

WATCH THIS SPACE (V Colgan) - Held up entering the final straight before shifting in passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running. Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres to the inside of **ENDLESS DRAMA** which lay in under pressure.

TRUE ENOUGH (C Grylls) – Crowded and checked near the 250 metres between **NICOLETTA** which lay out slightly and **VOLPE VELOCE** which shifted in under pressure.

M McNab **VOLPE VELOCE** – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted **VOLPE VELOCE** to shift in under pressure near the 250 metres crowding **TRUE ENOUGH** which was checked. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today up to and including racing on Friday April, 7 national riding days and in addition fined \$750.

ENDLESS DRAMA (D Mansour) – Rider D Mansour weighed in 0.4 kg lighter than the weight he weighed out. D Mansour was reprimanded after advising that he had changed an under-garment further advising that the girth sleeve being left off during the saddling process.

C McNab (**ENDLESS DRAMA**) – C McNab the stable representative for Trainer T Pike was reprimanded after the girth sleeve was left off when saddling **ENDLESS DRAMA**.

D Mansour (**ENDLESS DRAMA**) – Admitted a breach in that he used his whip excessively when riding **ENDLESS DRAMA** with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$600.

HIFLYER (S Collett) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after rider S Collett reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action when pulling up, which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 | **CRAIGS INVESTMENT PARTNERS HANDICAP (1600 metres)**

DRAGON STORM (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

SCAGLIONI (T Yanagida) – Slow to begin.

STACCATO (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CIVILISED (L Innes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance L Innes advised that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

O'SAM (T Thornton) – Over-raced passing the 900 metres when being steadied away from the heels of **LIGHT SHADOW**.
