RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 LYNDSAY MOYLE MEMORIAL 2200m

P Ellis trainer (SURE HE CAN) – Admitted a breach of Rule 614(2) for omitting to affix a breast plate to the gelding's gear which was added prior to the start with the JCA imposing a fine of \$50.

HE AIN'T HEAVY (A Bohorun) – Slow through the early stages.

C Johnson (SURE HE CAN) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively on his mount prior to the 100 metres with the JCA imposing a fine of \$300.

BABAN (R Hannam) – When asked to comment on the performance today the rider reported the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 2 EDINBURGH REALTY MAIDEN 1200m

FINAL SAVINGS (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly shifting out and crowding MUSTARD and OUT OF ACES. Made contact with OUT OF ACES when both runners shifted ground near the 200 metres.

ROSIE MARIE (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly shifting out crowding RAINMAN.

RAINMAN (C Johnson) – Crowded at the start.

MUSTARD (J Laking) – Crowded at the start. Raced keenly early.

OUT OF ACES (R Mudhoo) – Crowded at the start. Raced ungenerously early and wide throughout. Shifted in passing the 200 metres making contact with FINAL SAVINGS and had to be steadied.

METAL GURU (J Anderson) – Raced wide throughout.

BEESLASTSTING (L Callaway) – Lay inwards in the early stages of the home straight and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

INDEX (C Campbell) – Placed in restricted room early in the home straight when BEESLASTSTING lay inwards.

Race 3 TEMUKA TRANSPORT HANDICAP 1200m

T Moseley (BELLE HOPE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the JCA imposing a fine of \$500.

THE CZAR (G Saejorhor) – Rider reported the gelding felt indifferent over the concluding stages with a post-race veterinary inspection revealing no abnormalities.

HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) – Rider reported the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 4

HELENSVALE PROPERTIES/WALTER PARKER MEMORIAL HANDICAP 1200m

T Kennedy Trainer (KERANY) – Admitted a breach of Rule 616(2) in that he was late to notify the addition of a tongue tie to KERANY prior to the required time with the JCA imposing a fine of \$50.

CABERNET (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Bumped by inside runners passing the 50 metres.

PLOWSHARE (D Turner) – Restrained to the rear on jumping to obtain cover.

THE GROWLER (J Laking) – Raced wide throughout. Placed in restricted room over the concluding stages.

KERANY (C Johnson) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

C Johnson (KERANY) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) for allowing his mount to shift outwards placing THE GROWLER in restricted room who was then dictated outwards onto and making contact with CABERNET in the concluding stages.

Race 5MILTON, LAWRENCE & BALCLUTHA NIGHT N' DAY STORES/PETER LYON SHEARING MAIDEN 1600mJ Dalton – Warned under Rule 616(4) for presenting MORE JOOLS without notified gear.

JANDLES (C Johnson) – Scrambled at the start losing ground.

MORENA ROC (L Hemi) – Slow to begin. Awkwardly placed on heels of a tiring runner entering the home straight and had to be straightened.

EAGER BEAVER (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin. Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres.

MANHATTAN FIRE (R Hannam) – Raced keenly early stages. Raced wide throughout.

MORE JOOLS (C Barnes) – Hampered 300 metres when outside runner shifted in.

D Turner (SCANDALOUS) – Was warned under Rule 638(1)(d) for shifting ground near the 300 metres crowding MORE JOOLS which had to steady.

NASHEETA (C Campbell) – Gave ground from the 500 metres with the rider advising the mare had been less than genuine in its efforts today. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no obvious abnormalities. Stewards will follow up with connections in coming days.

DANELYN (S Wynne) – Held up early in the run home. When spoken to regarding the performance rider advised she had not had all favours during the running however the filly had still been disappointing and could offer no tangible excuses.

SCANDALOUS (D Turner) – Lay in throughout the run home with the rider using the whip in the left hand over the concluding stages.

Race 6 RMG PUBLICAN'S CUP 1600m

WHAT'S UP ALF (G Saejorhor) – Knuckled at the start losing ground.

TOMM JONES (R Hannam) – Lay in rounding the final bend and throughout the run home with the rider reporting the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE (J Fawcett) – When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised the gelding did not handle today's track conditions.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600m

The majority of the field over raced in the early stages due to the lack of tempo in the early stages.

IT'S PANDEMONIUM (C Johnson) - Slow to begin. Raced fiercely early stages.

LUVABATTLE (L Callaway) – Raced greenly in the early stages.

GEMSTONE JEWELS (B Murray) – Over raced badly early stages and was reported by its rider to have hung throughout.

LARIPPA (T Moseley) – Over raced early and was hampered near the 1300 metres when crowded between runners which were over racing.

MONTSERRAT (J Lowry) – Lay inwards in the run home with the rider swapping the whip to the left hand passing the 100 metres.
