## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>GREGORY EQUINE 2000</b>
<b>RUSSIAN ROULETTE</b> (T Thornton) – Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied. Raced wide throughout.	
<b>SWAY MOON</b> (R Smyth) – Crowded leaving the barriers.	
<b>CLEARLY NOW</b> (S Spratt) – Shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers crowding SWAY MOON and RUSSIAN ROULETTE.	

<b>MAGNOLIA LANE</b> (S McKay) – Contacted leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced.	
<b>ACACIA</b> (D Mansour) – Raced wide without cover until near the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider D Mansour advised that racing wide had been detrimental to the mare’s chances.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE</b>
<b>THE FAITH</b> (D Mansour) – Slow to begin.	
<b>QIJI CRYSTAL</b> (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly.	
<b>OCTANE JANE</b> (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.	
<b>AMARED ROSE</b> (T Yanagida) – Steadied approaching the 200 metres when attempting a tight run to the inside of SLINKY LINKY, which shifted in slightly, shifting out across that runner’s heels to obtain clear running.	
<b>HONFLEUR</b> (L Innes) – Returned to the enclosure with a minor laceration to the near hind fetlock.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>AA AUTO SERVICES MATAMATA 1400</b>
<b>MAGNIFY</b> (L Innes) – Slow to begin.	
<b>IRON EAGLE</b> (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.	
<b>KOOLASCUZ</b> (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced and forced wider approaching the 800 metres.	
<b>FIVE STARS</b> (D Mansour) – Commenced to over-race and shifted away from heels approaching the 800 metres when the pace eased. Held up briefly entering the final straight.	
<b>BLANCO CANYON</b> (J Bayliss) – Over-raced approaching the 800 metres when the pace eased.	
<b>DON’T LIE TO ME</b> (M Hashizume) – Held up early in the final straight, and had to be steadied near the 150 metres when attempting a marginal run.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PEARSON ENGINEERING 1200</b>
<b>MARY GOLD</b> (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly then contacted.	
<b>FOOGAYZEE</b> (T Harris) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider T Harris advised that the gelding had either led or sat outside the leader when winning two trials, and today had been obliged to race amongst other runners and was inclined to be field shy.	
<b>CURVE</b> (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with MARY GOLD. Was not persevered with over the final 150 metres. When questioned regarding performance R Elliot advised that the gelding had raced keenly early, and was also inclined to race greenly throughout.	
<b>CHECKERS</b> (C Grylls) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>THE BOLTHOLDER 1200</b>
<b>DON’T DOUBT ME</b> (C Lammas) – Slow to begin. Briefly held up rounding the final bend.	
<b>QUATTRO KATIE</b> (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly. Commenced to lay in under pressure passing the 250 metres inconveniencing OHIYESA.	

<p><b>IMA DANDY DUDE</b> (D Mansour) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages. Rider D Mansour was spoken to regarding his whip use in the final straight.</p> <p><b>OHIYESA</b> (B R Jones) – Shifted out leaving the barrier crowding IMA DANDY DUDE and became unbalanced. Inconvenienced 250 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>O'REILLY'S MOTEL 1200</b>
<p><b>KONTACT</b> (E McCall) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SHINING SUN</b> (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>D Mansour</b> (HELENA BABY) – Issued with a warning for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>CHALLENGE MATAMATA 1600</b>
<p><b>CLADDAGH</b> (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>EXPEDITION</b> (T Newman) – Began awkwardly, and then raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p><b>MISS SCANDINAVIA</b> (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly. Shifted in under pressure over the final 150 metres making brief contact with DAM RELIABLE passing the 75 metres.</p> <p><b>DAM RELIABLE</b> (D Mansour) – Raced keenly for a distance near the 1200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>HAPPY 80TH WALLY HENDERSON</b>
<p><b>INIGO MONTOYA</b> (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>KRAKADEEL</b> (D Mansour) – Steadied shortly after the start when placed in restricted room losing ground.</p> <p><b>AMBITIOUS SHOWGIRL</b> (T Thornton) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>SACRED FORM</b> (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>TE AKAU DRAGON</b> (O Bosson) – Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DANCE CARD</b> (L Innes) – Briefly held up prior to entering the final straight.</p> <p><b>T Harris</b> (HARBOURSIDE) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount HARBOURSIDE to shift in near the 100 metres when insufficiently clear of AMBITIOUS SHOWGIRL which was hampered losing ground. After hearing all relevant evidence, the Judicial Committee suspended T Harris' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 30 March up to and including racing on 11 April, 7 national riding days.</p> <p><b>L Satherley</b> (CANZAC) – Issued with a warning for using her whip unnecessarily on a horse that was out of contention.</p> <p><b>DANCE CARD</b> and <b>HARBOURSIDE</b> came together over the concluding stages when both runners shifted ground.</p>
