SUPPLEMENTARY:

Beaumont Racing Club - 25 March 2019 Milton, Lawrence & Balclutha Night & Day Stores/Peter Lyons Shearing Maiden 1600m Co-Trainer S Anderton advised Stewards that following its disappointing performance NASHEETA has been retired as a racing proposition.
Southland Racing Club – 31 March 2019 Lone Star Café & Bar Handicap Rating 65 & Jumpers Benchmark 2130m After a resumed hearing into an admitted breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d), apprentice rider G Saejorhor (LIL MISS SWISS) had his rider's licence suspended by the Judicial Committee for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 6 April up to and including 17 April.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	3 VALLEYS MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>QUELLA RAGAZZA (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>RITA AURA (L Callaway) – Raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions, held up early in the home straight and passing the 200 metres had to be severely restrained off the heels of MISS ATOMIC BOMB which shifted out abruptly at this point hampering the trailing JEWEL HEIGHTS as a consequence.</p> <p>RAFF (S Toolooa) – Raced wide without cover in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>FEEL THE BREEZE (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>MISS ATOMIC BOMB (T Moseley) – Made contact with MIDSUMMER MAGIC approaching the 200 metres and shifted out abruptly having to be straightened.</p> <p>JEWEL HEIGHTS (BB Hong) – Hampered passing the 175 metres.</p> <p>OVERCOAT (C Johnson) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 2	WHITE ROBE LODGE SPRINT MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>NERO (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and got back, raced wide without cover throughout, lay in early in the run home and again over the concluding stages having to be straightened passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>VIVA LA BLUES (BB Hong) – Shifted outwards on jumping hampering OCEAN OF CHAMPAGNE , raced wide into the first bend.</p> <p>OCEAN OF CHAMPAGNE (D Bothamley) – Hampered at the start losing ground.</p> <p>JINGO (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin. Lay in passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>HIGHLAND LADY (S Collett) – Crowded shortly after the start when EXCLAIM shifted in. When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised that the mare would take natural benefit from today’s race and in her opinion would appreciate more distance and more moisture in the track.</p> <p>MISS TANIRA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1100 metres when HIGHLAND LADY was taken in by EXCLAIM, continued to race keenly through to the middle stages.</p> <p>LOUVRES (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>PUSHYALUCK (L Callaway) – Placed in restricted room passing the 900 metres when making the bend awkwardly, crowded passing the 50 metres when JINGO which was laying in shifted inwards marginally at this point.</p> <p>WANDERIN OVER (S Wynne) – Held up for the majority of the home straight and could not be ridden to full advantage.</p>	
Race 3	ONCEUPONATIME AT BELMONT PARK DASH (1200m)
<p>ELANA ROSE (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>AMOUR LA VIE (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BENEFICIAL (T Moseley) – Awkwardly placed on heels shortly after the start having to be steadied.</p> <p>CLARA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.</p>	
Race 4	PEAR TREE FARM 1200 (1200m)
<p>FROSTED (S Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SEDUTTORE (D Bothamley) – Hampered between runners shortly after the start and got back.</p>	

MIROSLAVA (T Jonker) – Briefly crowded passing the 1100 metres, raced wide without cover throughout.

TAKE ME THERE (J Laking) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

STARMAKER (T Comignaghi) – Held up by tiring runner rounding the final bend.

SAVELLE (J Morris) – Lay out for the majority of the race and weakened from the 400 metres.

FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) – Raced in restricted room in the shadows of the post.

Race 5 | **WILLOW GLEN STUD MILE MAIDEN (1600m)**

SENTITO (S Collett) – Dipped as the start was made.

LUNAR LADY (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.

TOO FERLAXED (C Campbell) – Slow into stride and raced wide in the early stages before being taken forward to lead.

DIPLOMAT (T Moseley) – Over raced in the early stages.

WHEREABOUTS (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.

FINE AND DANDEE (S Wynne) – Improved forward passing the 800 metres. Jostled with inside runner passing the 250 metres.

ZURAFAA (L Callaway) – Held up early in the run home and jostled with FINE AND DANDEE passing the 250 metres when attempting a run to the outside of SENTITO which shifted out marginally at this point.

C Campbell (TOO FERLAXED) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

Race 6 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600m)**

SUPATWISTA (R Beeharry) – Race keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

PINUP COUP (S Wynne) – Restrained to the rear after jumping away to obtain cover, held up in the early part of the home straight having to shift ground outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 170 metres.

Race 7 | **INGLEWOOD STUD MAIDEN 1600 (1600m)**

SMART GARDEN (T Moseley) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

RELIABLE GLOW (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.

KING OF THE DANCE (J Fawcett) – Raced wide in the early stages.

ELIZA LONG (S Toolooa) – Raced wide in the early stages.

ROCKWITHME (K Mudhoo) – Crowded and checked passing the 1000 metres having to be restrained.

Apprentice rider **S Toolooa** (ELIZA LONG) in the presence of his employer K Hughes admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount to shift ground inwards passing the 1000 metres causing ROCKWITHME to be checked and steadied. After hearing evidence the Judicial Committee suspended S Toolooa's licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 6 April up to and including 13 April.

SHOCK PROSPECT (D Prastiyou) – Raced wide throughout.

SUCCOSO SEGRETO (C Campbell) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

LIVELY INTEREST underwent a post-race veterinary inspection after returning to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils, which revealed the gelding to be a bleeder and accordingly it is stood down from all race and trial meetings for 3 months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

Race 8	BEAUFORT DOWNS HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>SO NATURAL (B Morgenrood) – Slow to begin, held up on entering the home straight and was not afforded clear running until near the 100 metres.</p> <p>SEBRING’S DELIGHT (S Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>RIDE THE STORM (K Chowdhooey) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>DOWRY DUTY (T Jonker) – Restrained to the rear after jumping.</p> <p>MISS DIORELLA (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>SPLENDIOR (C Campbell) – Raced wide from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>S Collett (SEBRING’S DELIGHT) was warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 9	PARK HILL STABLES AND MORE FM MAIDEN (2100m)
<p>HARD BUT FAIR (S Collett) – Stood flat footed as the start was effected losing considerable ground (6L), improved forward passing the 1400 metres to race outside the leader passing the 1000 metres, crowded at the 250 metres when CINTO BAY lay in at this point, had to steady again at the 175 metres when placed in restricted room between NIFTY which lay out and CINTO BAY which continued to lay in.</p> <p>NIFTY (T Comignaghi) – Raced keenly into the first bend getting its head up and continued racing keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>LATASSO (S Toolooa) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p>TACKTHEFLAG (K Chowdhooey) – Steadied passing the 450 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>CINTO BAY (J Laking) – Lay inwards early in the straight and had to be straightened passing the 250 metres when shifting in abruptly. Continued to lay in through the straight despite the efforts of the rider.</p>	
Race 10	CLEARVIEW PARK STUD STAYERS (2100m)
<p>PRODUCER (B Murray) – Restrained to the rear on jumping to obtain cover.</p> <p>THAILAND (S Collett) – Raced wide rounding the first bend, crowded and had to steady passing the 75 metres when VEE TWELVE shifted out and away from BABAN. Rider reported the mare to be making abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate, with Stewards undertaking to follow up with the connections in coming days.</p> <p>LADY EM (J Fawcett) – Raced wide throughout, crowded and had to check passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>IRISH DUDE (L Callaway) – Became detached from the body of the field passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>RUN FORREST RUN (T Moseley) – Improved wide rounding the final bend, placed in restricted room and had to steady passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>SITARIST (C Campbell) – Held up on entering the home straight obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p>VEE TWELVE (T Jonker) – Raced in restricted room early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 200 metres.</p> <p>ADVENTURESS (T Comignaghi) – Crowded and had to check passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>C Campbell (SITARIST) admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in under riding passing the 50 metres, crowding LAY EM and ADVENTURESS which both had to be checked and steadied. After hearing evidence the Judicial Committee suspended C Campbell’s licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the</p>	

conclusion of racing on 6 April up to and including 13 April.
