RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	REMEMBERING RAY & NOREEN LEE 800
KING MIDAS (T Yanagida) – Was declared a late scratching at 12:05pm after dislodging its rider and galloping a distance before being recaptured. Apprentice T Yanagida was uninjured.	

SUPER PURSUIT (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

COINTREAU (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly making contact.

SONORITY (L Innes) – Began awkwardly making contact. Commenced to lay in when placed under pressure passing the 400 metres.

BLITZABEEL (C Grylls) – Reared at the start dislodging rider C Grylls. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination before being cleared to start. Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 2	MOUNT SHOP 2100
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ETCH (T Thornton) – Made contact with the front of the barrier as the start was being effected with the gates opening slightly early as a result with Stewards being satisfied that ETCH had gained no advantage. Began awkwardly losing ground.

SIR AGLOVALE (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

GOLDEN AGE (C Grylls) – Raced wide throughout. Contacted and unbalanced near the 100 metres by SIR AGLOVALE (L Innes) which shifted in under pressure. L Innes was advised to exercise care.

MONT VENTOUX (S Mckay) – Held up until passing the 300 metres.

INTRIGUE (R Elliot) - Held up until passing the 300 metres.

CHARRED (A Calder) – Was attended to post-race by veterinarian personal after the gelding was displaying signs of colic.

Race 3	SSANGYONG 1200
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DONNA IMELDA (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up until shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

QWERTY (S Spratt) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers losing ground.

LOOKSEASY (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

HOT SHOT BABE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover.

SHIPSHAPE (L Satherley) – Held up entering the final straight then had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight being held up over the final 200 metres.

HONОВI (M McNab) – Shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres inconveniencing ROCINTHEMYST. M McNab was advised to exercise care.

ROCINTHEMYST (C Grylls) – Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres.

FLYING FLAME (A Goindasamy) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which confirmed the gelding to have bled. Connections were advised that FLYING FLAME was now subject to a two month stand down from training, a three month stand down from racing or trialing and would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

M Coleman (DONNA IMELDA) – Fined \$150 by the Judicial Committee after making a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.	
Race 4	RACINGTHOUGHTS DOT BLOG 1200
<p>ROUGH CONDUCT (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>FORSEEABLE (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly then restrained from a wide barrier.</p> <p>SUPAGILI (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>MARIJA (C Grylls) – Crowded near the 400 metres and briefly steadied then shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres.</p> <p>BELLA PRONTO (R Elliot) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.</p> <p>M Cameron – Issued with a warning after permitting WAY ABOVE to shift out when insufficiently clear of MARIJA which had to be briefly steadied near the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 5	MAUREEN PARKINSON 1200
<p>LILLY THUNDER (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early stages and got its head up when making the bend near the 900 metres. Hampered near the 800 metres then continued to race ungenerously in the middle stages.</p> <p>AMUN RA (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>HAMMER KING (C Lammas) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>FULLINBLOOM (M McNab) – Raced three wide without cover from near the 900 metres.</p> <p>PACIFIC COAST (C Grylls) – Held up for clear running for a distance passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>PITCH AND SWITCH (V Colgan) – When shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres made contact with RITANI with both runners then being held up for a short distance.</p> <p>RITANI (T Yanagida) – Bumped and forced wider passing the 400 metres and then was held up for clear running between the 200 metres and 100 metres when in restricted room to the inside of CAMPARI which shifted in slightly under pressure.</p> <p>L Innes – Issued with a warning for allowing CAMPARI to shift in when not sufficiently clear of LILLY THUNDER which was hampered near the 800 metres with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of LILLY THUNDER.</p>	
Race 6	PAPAKURA CLUB OPEN DAY 14TH APRIL 1400
<p>SCHERZO (L Innes) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. An enquiry was opened into the riding tactics adopted aboard SCHERZO.</p> <p>SUPERTRAMP (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>BLADE (M McNab) – Began awkwardly. Shifted out abruptly off the heels of the weakening SUPERTRAMP passing the 200 metres.</p>	

HVAR (A Calder) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 1300 metres to the inside of OPERATOR which was being steadied away from the heels of HIGHLAND DANCER (G Cooksley) which shifted in when marginally clear. G Cooksley was advised to exercise greater care.

JOHNNIE REDMOND (C Grylls) – Commenced to race fiercely for a distance passing the 1000 metres making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly. Was not persevered with from near the 700 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Grylls advised Stewards that the gelding had lay in badly throughout and was unable to be ridden competitively. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

Race 7	TUAKAU COSSIE RACING SECTION 1600
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POKER FACE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground with the rider losing the use of his right stirrup iron for a distance.

EN SOIE (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

AZABOY (T Newman) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CHILL (S Collett) – Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

LUEN YAT MIRACLE (S Spratt) – Commenced to over race when being steadied near the 1000 metres and then made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

FLOURISHING (R Elliot) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

MASU (J Bayliss) – Held up over the final 200 metres.

LIGHT SHADOW (D Danis) – Steadied when placed in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 8	HAUNUI FARM 1600
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DAWON (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

EAGLE FIFTY (M McNab) – Slow to begin.

CRESCENT (R Elliot) – Restrained soon after leaving the barrier.

IRIDESSA (J Bayliss) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres to the inside of VEDO ROSSO which was dictated in slightly by FAST AND SINGLE which was in restricted room when steadying away from NICHE (M Coleman) which had shifted in. M Coleman was advised to exercise greater care.

FAST AND SINGLE (K McCulloch) – Raced in restricted room and steadied passing the 1000 metres. Held up until approaching the 200 metres.

TORQUE STRAIGHT (S Collett) – Hung outwards throughout making the bend awkwardly.

ALBERATION (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

POWER TYCOON (T Yanagida) – Briefly held up near the 200 metres.

VEDO ROSSO (S Spratt) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

Race 9	SPLICE CONSTRUCTION 1600
<p>MIDNIGHT DUKE (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TRUMPET (M McNab) – Crowded leaving the barriers.</p> <p>INIGO MONTOYA (T Yanagida) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>MIGHTY ASLAN (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>MAV (S Collett) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>JUST TREASURE (A Goindasamy) – Over raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>MICHIKO (R Smyth) – Made the bend awkwardly approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>VISCONTI (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding the performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.</p> <p>FOODIE KING (L Innes) – Held up for the majority of the final straight.</p> <p>SODA (C Lammas) – Held up for clear running until passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>NOT USUAL HEAVEN (C Grylls) – Held up rounding the bend and early in the final straight.</p> <p>HIGH PRIORITY (L Satherley) – Held up early in the final straight and then steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of FOODIE KING which shifted in looking to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.</p>
