Race 1	HARCOURTS MAIDEN 820m
<p>MCLAUGHLIN (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Was briefly held up entering the home straight and lay in for the majority of the run home.</p> <p>DISCO DEEJAY (C Johnson) – Raced wide early stages and lay out rounding the bend.</p> <p>OUT OF ACES (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>POINT SCORE (J Fawcett) – Lay inwards in the run home and shifted in and away from INDULGENT passing the 175 metres inconveniencing LIVE IN HOPE.</p>	

LIVE IN HOPE (R Hannam) – Inconvenienced passing the 175 metres.	
Race 2	K B CONTRACTORS 1200m
EPIC DREAMER (A Bohorun) – Over raced in the early to middle stages. Lay in for the majority of the run home.	
Race 3	WINGATUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 1200m
There was a delay of approximately two minutes to the start of this event due to several runners proving difficult to load.	
LUGANO’S ACE (C Barnes) – Shifted in abruptly at the start making firm contact with INDEX.	
INDEX (L Hemi) – Hampered at the start.	
COLLETTE (B Murray) – Slow to begin.	
CHOOKIE’S GIRL (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly and was then crowded between runners losing ground.	
METAL GURU (J Laking) – Raced wide throughout.	
THANKYABROWNIE (BB Hong) – Raced wide throughout.	
OUTRAM (J Lowry) - Lay in throughout the run home and shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages and made contact with HOMBRE 20 metres from the winning post.	
HOMBRE (R Hannam) – Brushed in the shadows of the winning post.	
The connections of the second placed HOMBRE lodged a protest alleging interference by the winner OUTRAM and after hearing from all parties the JCA dismissed the protest.	
Race 4	LEITH LIQUOR 1200m
Trainer K Moore – Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting BLUEY’S CHANCE without a tongue tie which had been notified. As a result of this gear omission having to be rectified the race ran approximately four minutes late.	
BLUEY’S CHANCE (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.	
RIDING HIGH (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
PLOWSHARE (L Hemi) – Raced wide early stages.	
MIROSLAVA (R Hannam) – Raced keenly when leading through the middle stages.	
HAPPY HITTER (T Moseley) – Shifted outwards when laying out passing the 150 metres dictating KERANY and VERIFY wider on the track.	
VERIFY (B Murray) – Placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres when inside runners shifted out.	
KERANY (C Johnson) – Dictated wider on the track passing the 150 metres.	
NAPOLEON DYNAMITE (D Bothamley) – Gave ground over the concluding stages finishing in last placing. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.	
Race 5	DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS 1400m
KING PIN (K Asano) – Got its head up when being restrained to take cover shortly after the start.	
MOYRABELLA (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout.	
WILD JACK (A Bohorun) – When asked to comment on the performance of the runner which had finished last the rider advised in his opinion the gelding had not handled today’s track conditions.	

Race 6	SOUTHERN WIDE REALTY MAIDEN 1600m
<p>SHORT ROAD (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>EAGER BEAVER (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>JIMINY CRICKET (S Wynne) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>DOUGH BOY (T Jonker) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>JANGLES (R Hannam) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SHEZA HAZZARD (C Barnes) – Over raced through the early stages.</p> <p>RAINMAN (C Johnson) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.</p> <p>BARZELLAR (J Fawcett) – Held up early in the run home.</p> <p>SHOCK AND AWE (T Moseley) – Was inconvenienced passing the 100 metres when DANZI CREEK (J Lowry) shifted out under pressure. J Lowry was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>DANZI CREEK (J Lowry) – When spoken to regarding the apparent improved performance co-trainer S Anderton advised the mare had appreciated the wetter track conditions today.</p> <p>POILU (J Laking) – Returned to the Birdcage with blood in one nostril with a subsequent veterinary inspection revealing an internal injury in the nostril and therefore deemed not to be a bleeder. Was further treated for thumps with the connections advising they will have further tests done on return to the home stable and will advise Stewards of the outcome.</p>

<p>OLAF (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>JUST PUSH PLAY (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MANHATTAN FIRE (R Hannam) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>SLAMMER (D Prastiyou) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>COCEE (L Hemi) – Lay in under pressure and had to be straightened on a number of occasions throughout the run home.</p> <p>DANTE FIRE (C Barnes) – Reported by its rider to have lay in throughout the running.</p> <p>IT’S PANDEMONIUM (C Johnson) – Placed in restricted room for several strides passing the 125 metres.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1400m
<p>Trainer S Tyler (ABBEY KAY) – Fined \$50 after failing to declare an item of notifiable gear by the required time.</p> <p>CABERNET (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>NELLIE BLY (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Raced in restricted room rounding the bend for a distance passing the 500 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised the filly had not backed up from its outing on Saturday.</p> <p>VALETINA VITTORIA (BB Hong) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>GEMSTONE JEWELS (B Murray) – Forced wider on the track for several strides passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>K Chowdhoory (NELLIE BLY) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) for allowing his mount to shift out forcing GEMSTONE JEWELS over extra ground passing the 1200 metres.</p>	

Race 9	SEE YA AT WINGATUI 24TH MAY HANDICAP 2200m
<p>LIL MISS SWISS (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SURE HE CAN (C Johnson) – Held up passing the 600 metres. When spoken to rider advised that the gelding was not entirely happy in today's track conditions.</p> <p>ROAD TO REDEMPTION (J Laking) – Rider dropped his whip passing the 200 metres. Was inclined to shift ground throughout the run home.</p> <p>MADAM DE SOIR (C Barnes) – Clipped a heel and blundered passing the 500 metres losing momentum.</p> <p>MORENA ROC (L Hemi) – Steadied away from heels passing the 350 metres when tiring.</p> <p>J Laking (ROAD TO REDEMPTION) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards passing the 500 metres resulting in MADAM DE SOIR clipping a heel and blundering losing momentum with the JCA suspending his licence to ride from the conclusion of racing on 14th April until the conclusion of racing on 28th April (8 days).</p>
