RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	EAST COAST RURAL SUPPPORT TRUST 1300 (1300 Metres)
CASTANI (L Innes) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had been disappointing. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormality.	

STELLA NOIRE (D Mansour) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Connections advised the filly would be spelled.
HAPPY TAV (H Andrew) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SKAABOOM (T Harris) - Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled inwards to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

YOSSARIAN (R Myers) – Bumped and briefly unbalanced near the 350 metres when MR UNIVERSE attempted a narrow run to the inside.

MR UNIVERSE (C Grylls) – Lay in under pressure over the final stages.

Race 2	FARMLANDS 2YO (1300 Metres)

PRINCESS ANI (R Myers) – Slow away

ELEVENTHOUR (J Parkes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced near the 350 metres.

MONGOLIAN HEAVEN (M Cameron) – Rider lost whip approaching the 200 metres.

PUYSEGUR (C Grylls) - Hung outwards rounding the home turn inconveniencing ELEVENTHOUR near the 350 metres, then continued to hang badly in the home straight running wide on the track hampering and dictating PELETON. Could not be ridden to advantage throughout the home straight. Connections were advised that a warning with regard to the filly's racing manners is placed. A subsequent veterinary did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

PELETON (T Harris) – Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 450 metres having to be angled wide on the track, making contact with ELEVENTHOUR which shifted out near the 400 metres. Hampered and dictated wide from the 150 metres.

Race 3	CICIL CONTRACTORS NEW ZEALAND 2500 (2500 Metres)

ANARCHY (D Mansour) - Slow away.

AMORATA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early and middles stages.

RED CLOUD (J Parkes) - Was not persevered with over the final stages when out of contention. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 4	WR DYER LIVESTOCK 1300 (1300 Metres)

OFA ORSOME (S Collett) Slow away, raced ungenerously in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

WHAT A SMASHER (M Singh) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 5	NZB FINANCE SPRINT (1200 Metres)

HUGO THE BOSS (C Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PRINCESS KERERU (C Lammas) - tighten at start when ROCK 'N' AFFAIR began awkwardly, settling back.

SPRING HEAT (J Bayliss) - Slow away.

ENDLESS DRAMA (T Harris) - Held up approaching the 500 metres before being angled outwards across heels entering the home straight to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

CAVALLO VELOCE (S McKay) -Tightened near the 550 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

SASSO CORBARO (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare may not have handled

today's track conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

VOLKS LIGHTING (R Elliot) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare may appreciate a firmer track. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a slow post-race recovery.

RIKKI TIKKI TAVI was a late scratching at 2.12pm on veterinary advice after an examination revealed the mare to be lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised a clearance is required.

Race 6	BAYLEYS RURAL (1400 Metres)

L LATTA – Was fined \$50 under [Rule 616 (4)] after presenting HENREE WINKLER without the notified blinkers.

MAGIC OF THE SUN (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly.

STRADIVARIUS (D Hirini) – Began awkwardly, raced keenly when three wide without cover, shifted out under pressure approaching 200 metres hampering GRIFFIN which shifted out contacting LANGKAWI.

GRIFFIN (C Burdan) – Tightened shortly after the start when MAGIC OF THE SUN began awkwardly dictating LA MIA STELLA which contacted GRIFFIN, then raced keenly in the early stages, dictated outwards and contacted near 200, continued to shift out under pressure placing LANGKAWI in restricted room over the final stages. Apprentice Burdan spoken to in the presence of the riding master N Harris.

HENREE WINKLER (C Grylls) - Restrained off heels approaching the 900 metres.

LA MIA STELLA (C Lammas) – Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip approaching the 200 metres hampering LANGKAWI prior to being straightened, continued to lay in over the final stages.

LANGKAWI (S McKay) - Hampered approaching 200 metres then contacted and dictated inside the 200 metres, raced in restricted room over the final stages.

Race 7	ROYSTON HOSPITAL HAWKE'S BAY CUP (2200 Metres)

JACKSSTAR (C Johnson) – Slow away, raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

TIPTRONIC (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly, raced keenly in the early and middle stages, when questioned into performance rider reported that after racing keenly the gelding had little left at the finish.

COLLINSTREET (L Innes) – Slow away.

GALWAY BRO (S McKay) – Slow away, raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

THE COSSACK (T Thornton) - Raced keenly in the early stages when in front.

WHATSUP (H Andrew) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LINCOLN FURY (C Grylls) – When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse other than the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.
