GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HYGAIN/MITAVITE MAIDEN (1200m)
JEWEL HEIGHTS (J Lowry) - Very slow to begin.	
ALL ABOUT ROY (L Callaway) - Crowded at the start when runners to either side shifted ground.	

MISS ATOMIC BOMB (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

NERO (K Mudhoo) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

JINGO (L Hemi) - Steadied near the 800 metres when crowded to the inside of NERO which lay in and away from JADORE LUMIERE which was taken in by MISS ATOMIC BOMB (S Wynne). S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care.

GRAND EXPRESS (R Hannam) - Inclined to shift ground through the home straight and near the 200 metres shifted inwards placing JADORE LUMIERE and JINGO in restricted room with GRAND EXPRESS (R Hannam) then shifting out passing the 50 metres resulting in KLUTE having to be steadied. R Hannam immediately corrected his mount which was then not persevered with over the concluding stages.

C O'Beirne (LA TURQUE) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards under pressure over the final 150 metres forcing FEEL THE BREEZE over extra ground.

FEEL THE BREEZE (L Allpress) - Forced over extra ground over the final 150 metres.

ALONZO (K Chowdhoo) - When questioned regarding performance rider reported that the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

Race 2	GAVELHOUSE.COM TWO-YEAR-OLD (1000m)

ROSARITO (S Wynne) - Began very awkwardly shifting out and crowding outside runners, steadied shortly after the start when awkwardly placed on the heels of KHITAN WARRIOR which was laying in at this point.

KHITAN WARRIOR (T Moseley) - Crowded and buffeted at the start, inclined to over race in the early stages.

CLUBCARD (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded and buffeted at the start, had to be steadied away from the heels of KHITAN WARRIOR (T Moseley) passing the 250 metres. T Moseley was advised to exercise greater care.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (J Morris) - Ducked inwards shortly after jumping away hampering EASY ON THE EYE which was forced onto the hindquarters of CLUBCARD.

EASY ON THE EYE (L Hemi) - Hampered shortly after jumping.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (J Morris) - Lay in throughout the home straight and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 3	NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE 29 APRIL RATING 72 (2000m)

TONY TWO CHIPS (J Lowry) - Shifted out on jumping crowding HEAD OFFICE and DIORISSIMO with both those runners losing ground.

HEAD OFFICE (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

DIORISSIMO (S Wynne) - Crowded at the start losing ground, held up early in the home straight before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.

TAXIHOME (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

SMILING ASSASSIN (T Moseley) - Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of TONY TWO CHIPS passing the 150 metres.

R Mudhoo (TAXIHOME) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively on a runner out of contention with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 4	HAASE MARSHALL DRAINAGE RATING 65 (1400m)

SHARP 'N' SILVER (D Turner) - Fractious in the barrier rearing on a number of occasions prior to the start.

FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards making contact with WHITNEY losing ground as a result.

WHITNEY (T Moseley) - Crowded at the start losing ground when runners to either side shifted ground.

HIGHLY UNLIKELY (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

THE GROWLER (R Hannam) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping away from the outside barrier.

VOUCH (J Lowry) - Briefly steadied passing the 1000 metres when SHARP 'N' SILVER improved forward.

CLOONEY (J Laking) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MIDSUMMER MAGIC (K Asano) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.

PICK ME UP IN RIO (L Hemi) - Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection after the rider reported the filly felt indifferent in its action which did not reveal any apparent abnormality. The Connections advised that the filly will now be retired. Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 5	NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY RATING 72 (1600m)

SATIN GURU (J Lowry) - Slow to begin.

RED ROSE WARRIOR (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly before being further hampered by RAYAS which shifted out at the start.

HERENGAWA (K Chowdhoory) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE SPARKLE (B Murray) - Rider reported that the mare had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

S Wynne (NEESON) - Admitted a charge in that she used the whip excessively with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$400.

Race 6	D REYNOLDS ELECTRICAL OPEN SPRINT (1200m)

TRUDEAU (S Wynne) - Slow to begin then further hampered when crowded. When questioned regarding performance the rider reported that the gelding had been outpaced throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

HE KIN FLY (L Callaway) - Jumped away awkwardly and shifted outwards crowding FEELING THE LOVE, KIWI IDA and DISTURBANCE which were all hampered.

FEELIN THE LOVE (T Jonker) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

KIWI IDA (R Beeharry) - Hampered leaving the barriers, held up near the 350 metres.

DISTURBANCE (D Turner) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

MORSE CODE (L Hemi) - Steadied shortly after the start.

Race 7	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK WARSEP STAKES (2000m)

SULU SEA (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

VOLVIK (D Prastiyou) - Slow to begin.

MISS CURIOUS (B Murray) - Crowded at the start losing ground, steadied to avoid the heels of the weakening THUNDER BAY passing the 600 metres. Rider reported that the filly hung throughout and proved a difficult ride.

GUILLADA (L Hemi) - Hampered at the start.

MISS VALENCIA (S Wynne) - Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runner.

TOO FERLAXED (J Lowry) - Had to be steadied when making the crossing near the 1900 metres awkwardly.

SUCCOSO SEGRETO (BB Hong) - Raced wide throughout.

SECRET ALLURE (L Allpress) - Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that she had been caught wide throughout but failed to finish the race off as expected and had been disappointing adding that in her opinion the filly may not have backed up from its win the previous week on heavy footing. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

REMEDY (C Barnes) - Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

CITY SLICKER (Z Moki) - Held up rounding the final turn behind the weakening TOO FERLAXED.

D Turner (BEYOND THE FORT) - Was spoken to regarding the commencement of a celebratory gesture just prior to passing the finish.

Race 8	COCA-COLA CANTERBURY GOLD CUP (2000m)

KOXINGA (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

TOMMY TUCKER (J Lowry) - Slow to begin.

WHO DARES WINS (S Wynne) - Over raced in the early stages getting its head up when being restrained to take a trailing position.

AUTHENTIC PADDY (R Hannam) - Rider reported that the gelding had shown signs of distress post-race. A post race veterinary inspection found the gelding to have a prolonged recovery rate demonstrating mild tie-up.

BLOODSTREAM (D Prastiyou) - A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DEE AND GEE (T Jonker) - Rider dropped her whip just prior to the finish.

S Wynne (WHO DARES WINS) - Admitted a charge in that she made a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$350.

L Allpress (RESIDENTIAL) - Admitted a charge in that she used the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$400.

D Turner (GORBACHEV) was stood down following this race suffering from dehydration.

Race 9	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (2000m)

J Laking (CINTO BAY) - Issued with a warning after striking his horse behind the barriers when it proved difficult to load.

LADY BYRON - L Callaway replaced D Turner (unwell).

PRODUCER (B Murray) - Slow to begin, over raced in the early stages.

SHANZINO (K Chowdhury) - Began awkwardly losing ground, over raced in the early stages having to shift out passing the 1600 metres to avoid heels, held up behind the weakening RUN FORREST RUN having to be steadied for a distance near the 500 metres.

AULYN STAR (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SEBRING'S DELIGHT (L Allpress) - Steadied away from the heels of MOSSY CREEK passing the 600 metres, held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the straight not being persevered with by its rider over the concluding stages.
