Race 4 - DANNEVIRKE DAIRY SUPPLIES 1400 (1400 Metres)

RHIZA (J Riddell) – Trainer M Dravitzki advised that on return to her stable the mare was showing signs of being in season, adding that it is her intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Auckland Racing Club - Saturday 20 April 2019

Race 6 - Valachi Downs Championship Stakes (2100 metres)

ELATE (R Elliot) – Co-trainer R James advised that he was satisfied with the recovery of the filly and it has now gone for a spell.

Race 8 - Farewell & Good Luck Timmy G 1600

HOLY LOCH (L Satherley) – Trainer M Falconer advised that on return to her stable a puncture wound on the geldings near fore sole became apparent, adding that HOLY LOCH has now been sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 THINK WATER CAMBRIDGE PREMIER (2400 metres)

DESERT STORM (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground, raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

NOTHING TRIVIAL (D Danis) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion that the gelding may not have backed up from its race seven days previously.

ANARCHY (L Innes) - Slow to begin. When question regarding performance, rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

HATTIE BEE (C Dell) - Began awkwardly.

SWEET TREAT (R Elliot) - Rider lost his whip near the 50 metres.

Race 2 CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL PREMIER (1200 metres)

SUPER PURSUIT (A Calder) - Began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of CATALYST then being further hampered when crowded by MONGOLIAN HEAVEN with SUPER PURSUIT losing ground as a result.

MONGOLIAN HEAVEN (M Cameron) - Contacted and unbalanced soon after leaving the barriers, rider reported that the colt never travelled well and in his opinion would benefit from a break. Co-trainer M Baker confirmed that MONGOLIAN HEAVEN would now be sent for a spell.

QUEEN OF VENLO (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover.

CATALYST (M Coleman) - When questioned regarding performance, rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the colt had been disappointing.

Race 3 WAIKATO-BAY OF PLENTY HARNESS RACING PREMIER (1600 metres)

BLANCO CANYON (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages shifting outwards passing the 1300 metres to avoid heels hampering RUSTICANA then continuing to over-race in the middle stages.

RUSTICANA (V Colgan) - Hampered 1300 metres.

OPERATOR (D Mansour) - Over-raced badly in the early stages with the saddle shifting forwards inconveniencing its rider for the remainder of the race, rider lost his whip near the 150 metres.

JUST TREASURE (S McKay) - Held up having to steady to avoid heels passing the 400 metres.

Race 4 MAARA GRANGE REHABILITATIN AND FENCING PREMIER (1600 metres)

PINMEDOWN (C Lammas) - Slow away.

NOTABADIDEA (L Allpress) - Over raced in the early to middle stages.

LINCOLN GREEN (L Innes) - Hung out rounding the bend forcing SOCIALIGHTS over extra ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer L Latta was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its racing manners.

SOCIALIGHTS (S Collett) - Forced over extra ground from the 600 metres then hampered 400 metres when LINCOLN GREEN continued to hang outwards.

SAHAR (O Bosson) - Raced wide without cover, forced over extra ground rounding the final turn.

Race 5 HUTTON CONTRACTING PREMIER (1400 metres)

ITS ALL FAKE NEWS (R Norvall) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.

PRINCIPAL DATUM (C Dell) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

JET SET (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly.

INTO THE GROOVE (J Riddell) - Hampered when weakening near the 350 metres when SIMPLY SACRED (L Innes) lay in. Rider L Innes was advised to exercise greater care.

ANHEDONIA (V Colgan) - Ducked outwards unbalancing its rider near the 250 metres when well back.

Race 6 AON INSURANCE BROKERS PREMIER (1400 metres)

ALIGNS WITH ME (D Mansour) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground.

PRETTY TO SEA (L Innes) - Jumped away awkwardly then crowded shortly after leaving the barriers, held up near the 350 metres shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

PEACOCK (C Dell) - Slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be 2/5 lame in the right foreleg with a suspected tendon strain. A veterinary certificate of fitness will now be required prior to PEACOCK racing again.

RITANI (L Allpress) - Steadied when racing in restricted room near the 1000 metres.

POWER O'HATA (M Cameron) - Over-raced when being restrained near the 1100 metres then shifted outwards across the heels of SWISSWATCH inconveniencing REMINGTON.

REMINGTON (C Burdan) - Inconvenienced passing the 1100 metres.

HASAHALO (S Spratt) - Had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of REMINGTON near the 1000 metres.

FARM BOY (D Danis) - Raced wide throughout.

SHE'S NOT BAD (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 7 TRAVIS STAKES (2000 metres)

YEARN (D Mansour) - Restrained off heels passing the 1800 metres.

SUPERA (M Coleman) - Jumped away awkwardly.

LADY PAINTON (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover around the first bend before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres, checked when crowded near the 250 metres.

HINERANGI (M Cameron) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

TANTALISING (S Collett) - Checked when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres.

JESSIEGEE (L Allpress) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

L Allpress (JESSIEGEE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she directed her mount inwards when not sufficiently clear of TANTALISING which was checked when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres, then continuing to shift inwards crowding LADY PAINTON which was checked near the 250 metres. After viewing film footage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Allpress' licence to ride at race meetings from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 4th May up to and including racing on Saturday 18th May, 10 National riding days.

Race 8 INGLIS SALES CAMBRIDGE BREEDERS STAKES (1200 metres)

T Harris - Fined \$750 by the Judicial Committee after advising on race morning that he was unable to make the weight for VIGOR WINNER.

VIGOR WINNER - D Mansour replaced T Harris. Restrained from a wide barrier, steadied to avoid the heels of SHE'S A THIEF making the 800 metre turn awkwardly running wide.

MR UNIVERSE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

HYPNOS (R Elliot) - Restrained from a wide barrier.

ESPRESSO MARTINI (M Cameron) - Restrained from a wide barrier, hampered near the 300 metres when HYPNOS shifted out under pressure.

SHEEZALLMINE (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SPEEDY MEADY (A Calder) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

J Riddell (LINCOLN FALLS) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9 MANELINE CAMBRIDGE PREMIER FASTTRACK \$5K BONUS (1200 metres)

PRINCE HAREEM (D Mansour) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MUTECHI (R Elliot) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

MONEY TRAIL (L Allpress) - Over-raced for a distance when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

TICKET TO RIDE (C Burdan) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

BARCELO (C Lammas) - Raced wide without cover.

POWER DREAM (S Collett) - Made the turn near the 800 metres awkwardly when racing keenly.
