# **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1ASSURE SUNDOWNER MOTEL MAIDEN 1000MCOUNTTHECASH(T Moseley) - Rider reported that the gelding had made abnormal respiratory noises during the<br/>running with a post race veterinary inspection revealing no obvious abnormalities.

**CHANCEUX** (C Campbell) - Made the bend passing the 600 metres awkwardly laying outwards. Raced greenly through the final straight.

**MONTREUX MISS** (K Asano) - Lay out rounding the home turn.

AQUATTACK (C Johnson) - Slow to being.

**MORE THAN ENOUGH** (R Elliott) - Began awkwardly and got back.

## Race 2 BURKHART FISHERIES 1000M

**SCAPOLO** (K Asano) - Slow through the early stages.

**PIPIANA** (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider reported that the mare had made abnormal respiratory noises during the running with a post race veterinary inspection revealing no obvious abnormalities.

## Race 3 TRADITIONAL COUNTRY PRESERVES MAIDEN 1400M

HOMBRE –(R Hannam) - Fractious in the barriers.

BATOUTAHELL (C Johnson) - Slow to begin. Held up momentarily approaching the 400 metres.

**BILLY MAV** (R Myers) - Became fractious in the barrier during the loading process being removed and undergoing a veterinary inspection and subsequently scratched on veterinary advice at 1.22pm. The connections were advised that the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next.

**VAN WOLF** (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Gave ground from the 500 metres finishing in last placing. Post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

**CAILIN** (L Allpress) - When queried about the improved performance rider L Allpress reported that the mare had appreciated being ridden with cover and adding CAILIN had settled better than on the first day.

**ARNAGE** (T Moseley) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1100 metres getting its head up on a number of occasions. Raced keenly for some distance thereafter.

## Race 4 GROVE TAVERN MAIDEN 1400M

HUTSEEGUA(T Comignaghi). Lay out throughout the final straight and raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres.

WHALE SONG (K Chowdhoory) - Held up and heavily restrained passing the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels, having to shift ground outwards across heels passing the 50 metres to obtain clear running. Stewards questioned rider K Chowdhoory as to why he chose to improve to the inside of runners passing the 200 metres. Mr Chowdhoory stated he was under instructions not to improve wide on the turn and he had attempted to improve into a marginal run he believed would open. He agreed with Stewards that he had erred in shifting inside into a run that had not fully developed and in hindsight he would have been better to improve to the outside of runners. Stewards reprimanded Mr Chowdhoory and instructed him not leave his rides open to query.

**ORLEANS ROCK** (R Myers) - Restrained to the rear on jumping to obtain cover.

SHOW CLOUD (C Campbell) - Was inclined to lay outwards over the concluding stages.

**ELVA** (D Prastiyou) - Lay inwards in the home straight having to be straightened passing the 250 metres and again passing the 200 metres after brushing with RITA AURA.

**RITA AURA** (L Callaway) - Commenced to over race passing the 1250 metres getting its head up continually for some distance. Brushed passing the 200 metres.

## Race 5 WOODBOURNE TAVERN 1400M

FLY TO THE SKY (C Campbell) - Slow to begin and then raced wide without cover throughout.

**DUTCH COURAGE** (I Callaway) - Got its head up passing the 1200 metres and raced ungenerously for a distance. Lay out throughout the final straight and becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 50 metres

**VALENTIA** (B Morgenrood) - Became awkwardly placed between runners when held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

**COVER DRIVE** (R Myers) Got head up on a number of occasions when being restrained to obtain cover passing the 1100 metres.

MIROSLAVA (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide in the early stages

**ZAYZAY** (D Prastiyou) - When questioned about the improved performance trainer M Tapper advised the mare had taken improvement from the first day's run with the additional blinkers helping today. Rider reported that the mare had appreciated the improved track conditions today.

## Race 6 ARBOUR RESTAURANT 1400M

**MIDDAGURD** (L Allpress) - Broke through the barriers during the loading process but was quickly restrained and underwent a veterinary inspection and was cleared to start. Got its head up when over racing through the middle stages. Steadied passing the 600 metres when making the bend awkwardly becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SHADOW KING which shifted inwards to avoid the heels of LEULUAI which was steadied to avoid the heels of YAMATO NADESHIKO(T Jonker). T Jonker was advised to exercise care. Rider of MIDDAGURD advised the gelding would be more suited to a track with more moisture.

JIN LU (T Moseley) - Shifted ground inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

YAMATO NADESHIKO (T Jonker) - Very slow to begin. Improved wide from the 800 metres.

LEULUAI (K Chowdhoory) Steadied near the 600 metres

## Race 7 WATERFRONT BAR AND GRILL MAIDEN 1950M

**ALBARON** (S MaNab) - Placed in restricted room shortly after the start and was buffeted when KING OF THE DANCE shifted outwards. Raced keenly early and middle stages. Rider reported the gelding had hung throughout.

**KING OF THE DANCE** (K Chowdhoory) Shifted outwards after the start hampering outside runners .K Chowdhoory was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

**MACKTAVISH** (B Morgenrood)- Buffeted between runners shortly after the start. Held up for a short distance passing the 350 metres.

**PAINTED ANGEL** (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly, got its head up and checked when awkwardly placed on the heels of FINE AND DANDEE when forced outwards due to inside pressure. Raced wide in the early stages.

**RIPCORD** (R Elliott) - Placed in restricted room shortly after the start becoming unbalanced. Held up passing the 350 metres when awkwardly placed between runners.

**HARD BUT FAIR** (C Campbell) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected losing considerable ground. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to racing.

FINE AND DANDEE (L Callaway) - Had to be restrained off heels when racing keenly passing the 1600 metres.

**BARZELLAR** (T Moseley) - Contacted from the inside by GRANT passing the 75 metres.

MADONNA (R Hannam) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

## Race 8 KAM TRANSPORT MARLBOROUGH CUP 1950M

**CAMINO ROCOSO** (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early to middle stages. Rider C Johnson was reminded of his obligations in respect to making contact prior to weigh in.

CHIC (R Elliott) - Lost a left front plate passing the 150 metres.

**KOXINGA** (T Jonker) - Got its head up in the early stages when being restrained.

Race 9 100 YEARS IN 2020 OF RACING 1950MT

SHANZINO (K Chowdhoory) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**KATIEM MARIE** (S MacNab) - Fractious in its barrier prior to the start and was slow to begin.

SEEBRING DRAGON (D Hirini) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards.

R Elliott (CAPELLANI) was warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

T Jonker (VEE TWELVE) warned for unnecessary use of the whip on a horse clearly winning.

T Jonker was reminded of her obligations in respect to making contact prior to weigh in.
