EAST COAST RURAL SUPPORT TRUST 1300

Stewards concluded an enquiry into the ride of T Harris (SKAABOOM) who appeared to relax his ride over the final stages and was beaten for 4th placing. When questioned T Harris advised that after being held up early in the home straight he had angled inwards and obtained a run near the rail passing the 200 metres but his mount had started to come to the end of its run near the 150 metres. T Harris further advised that his mount raced greenly over the final stages and had shifted in and away from PINCANTO which was on an inward movement over the final 50 metres, at which point T Harris relaxed his ride anticipating further inward movement from PINCANTO. T Harris was issued with a warning under Rule 636(1)(d) and advised that he must ride his mounts out fully when circumstances permit.

MEDINI (B Lammas) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, jumping erratically, losing ground before being pulled up after the fourth fence when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider advised that the mare

had jumped erratically. A post-race veterinary examination was clear. Connections were advised that MEDINI must trial satisfactorily prior to racing next.

ALL IN ROCK (L Douglas) – Got in close at the third fence.

MR INK (S Karnicnik) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

MESMERIZE (S Phelan) – Hit the last fence, then lay out under pressure over the final stages finishing wide on the track.

CLASS ABOVE (S Fannin) – Got in close at the second fence. Lost ground jumping the fence near the 1200 metres. Lay in under pressure over the final stages. When questioned into performance rider advised that the gelding had raced keenly and had run down several fences, losing ground.

Race 2 LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES OPEN HURDLE 3000 (3000 Metres)

IT'S A WONDER (S Phelan) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SUFFICE TO SAY (B Lammas) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

GUY FOX (K Veenendaal) - Put in a poor jump at the fourth fence. Hit the second to last fence.

THATZ DAVID (S Karnicnik) - Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 900 metres.

Race 3 CARPET MAINTENANCE & CLEANING OPEN STEEPLE 3800 (3800 Metres)

MAX (J Sievwright) - Ran down the fence near the 1900 metres and the second to last fence.

WHO CAN TELL (B Lammas) – Hit the fence, blundered on landing near the 600 metres. Pulled up prior to the second to last fence when out of contention. When questioned rider advised that after hitting the fence at the 600 metres the gelding had little left so he elected to pull up. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

I'VE GOT THIS (S Fannin) - Ran down a number of fences during the running.

Race 4 G BRISTOL & SONS AMATEUR RIDERS MAIDEN 2060 (2060 Metres)

LUCKY FRANK (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly.

IZTAMOUR (B Harrison) - Jumped outwards at the start contacting ROHAN.

ROHAN (J Sanders) - Contacted at the start then raced keenly in the middle stages.

KION (E Quinn) - Tightened at the start settling back.

INVIGORATE (M Northcott) - Raced very ungenerously in the early stages and when being restrained went back hampering WICKLOW near the 1700 metres.

WICKLOW (S Wenn) - Hampered near the 1700 metres.

KATWINKLE (C Roughan) - Raced wide without cover until near the 800 metres. Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres, then tightened approaching the 200 metres.

ACACIA (B Rogerson) - When questioned into performance rider advised that after being taken on in the lead the mare had little left at the finish. Rider also advised that ACACIA may not have appreciated today's Slow 9 track conditions.

Race 5 MANAWATU SOUND SERVICE MAIDEN 1200 (1200 Metres)

KING FAROUK (S McKay) - Slow away.

ALPHA KILO (R Myers) - Slow away.

RARE BREED (C O'Beirne) – Raced keenly in the early stages, making the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly. Held up behind the tiring SWISS D'MEANOUR approaching the 400 metres.

SUPER GIRL (M Singh) - Held up behind a tiring runner approaching the 400 metres.

Race 6 COMMDIVES NZ MAIDEN 1360 (1360 Metres)

CARDINAL O'CEIRIN (M Hudson) - Jumped inwards at the start contacting HINEPARA, which settled back.

KIWI PRINCESS (M Singh) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LATER ON (A Jones) – Had to shift inwards to gain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

Race 7 JOLT COFFEE HOUSE 1360 (1360 Metres)

TIPPING POINT (R Myers) - Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout.

DREAM DANCER (D Turner) - Began awkwardly contacting MR AXLE and HINGIS.

MR AXLE (S McKay) - Contacted start. Briefly held up approaching the 600 metres.

HINGIS (S Johnson) - Contacted start and briefly unbalanced at start.

MAGIC IVAN (S MacNab) - Tightened at the start settling back.

TIPPERARY MARY (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned into performance rider advised that the mare had raced keenly and would take natural improvement from the run.

BELLA PADOZA (M Singh) - Lay outwards under pressure in the home straight.

GRINNER (C O'Beirne) - Lay inwards under pressure over the final stages.

Race 8 RIVER CITY CABS MAIDEN 3YO 1600 (1600 Metres)

D Turner (MAIPE) was attended to by paramedics and stood down after becoming unwell due to dehydration. D Turner was replaced by A Jones.

JAKAMA KRYSTAL (Z Moki) - Tightened at the start.

UNIQUEBOTIQUE (D Hirini) - Tightened at the start.

RELY ON ME (S McKay) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

VIVA LA PLATINUM (R Hannam) - When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

TRULY AMAZING (T Johnson) - Gave ground quickly approaching the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear. Trainer B Lammas advised he would monitor the filly's progress and undertook to report any abnormalities.

A Jones (MAIPE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.
