#### **GENERAL:**

No issues to report.

#### RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HYGAIN/MITAVITE PREMIER (2000m)

LONDONDERRY AIR (J Lowry) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.

**RED RIVER ROCK** (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin, had to be steadied near the 250 metres.

**HEAD OFFICE** (K Chowdhoory) - Jumped away awkwardly when being restrained from an outside barrier.

**RED ROSE WARRIOR** (T Moseley) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1700 metres to the inside of PRINCESS EL JAY which was taken in slightly by ALBUT ME (R Hannam). R Hannam was advised to exercise greater care.

Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 300 metres when UPSCALE lay in under pressure with RED ROSE WARRIOR then being checked passing the 250 metres when TONY TWO CHIPS shifted outwards.

**TONY TWO CHIPS** (C Campbell) - Badly held up in the final straight until near the 200 metres.

**C Campbell** (TONY TWO CHIPS) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards passing the 250 metres when not sufficiently clear of RED ROSE WARRIOR which was checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended C Campbell's licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national riding days effective from the conclusion of racing today up to and including racing on Thursday 16 May.

**SMILING ASSASSIN** (L Allpress) - Held up passing the 400 metres before shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

## Race 2 BLUE STAR TAXIS PREMIER (1600m)

TICKY TU (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

**IRISH EXPRESS** (T Moseley) - Slow to begin, awkwardly placed on the heels of HEBERITE passing the 800 metres shifting out and dictating STELLACANTO wider on the track with IRISH EXPRESS then laying out passing the 700 metres making the bend awkwardly.

**HEBERITE** (J Lowry) - Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of RIDING HIGH near the 1200 metres.

GLOSS (J Morris) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RIDING HIGH (C Campbell) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.

**DEVIL'S STAIRCASE** (BB Hong) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight having to be steadied over the concluding stages.

**THOM BROWN** (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had travelled well but once placed under pressure had been quickly beaten and had been disappointing. Trainer reported that the gelding may not have seen out the 1600m distance of todays race. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

#### Race 3 EL DOUTE RISING STARS PREMIER (1200m)

**FEELIN THE LOVE** - Declared a late scratching at 11.42 am on veterinary advice after being injured enroute to the track, suffering a laceration to the left hind leg requiring veterinary treatment. A veterinary certificate of fitness is now required prior to racing again.

**ON POINT** (T Moseley) - Very fractious in the barriers then being slow to begin.

**NOWHERE MAN** (D Turner) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**VENDIMA** (D Prastiyou) - Slow to begin, held up early in the run home before obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres.

**ZAWHIP** (BB Hong) - Raced wide throughout.

CZARISTA (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover.

**ISHINKTAATLEDO** (J Laking) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear running inside the final 200 metres.

**CLARA** (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been very disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance being required prior to racing next.

### Race 4 RAE RACING - FAREWELL PROM QUEEN PREMIER (1200m)

**SHE'S GALLANT** (K Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly, held up passing the 400 metres until near the 250 metres then again held up near the 150 metres before obtaining clear running approaching the 100 metres, shifted outwards abruptly under pressure over the concluding stages.

**NELLIE BLY** (K Chowdhoory) - Hampered leaving the barriers when CABERNET began awkwardly shifting outwards.

**CABERNET** (J Lowry) - Began awkwardly.

LITTLE FLICK (R Mudhoo) - Over raced in the early to middle stages.

FEEL THE BREEZE (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover.

**SAMMI LOU** (T Moseley) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

BOYSLIGHTUP (R Hannam) - Steadied when racing in restricted room over the final 100 metres.

**FUNNY FACE** (C Campbell) - Trainer L Robinson subsequently reported that the mare became distressed post-race and would now be retired. If FUNNY FACE were to race again a veterinary clearance will be required.

## Race 5 BERKLEY STUD CHAMPAGNE STAKES (1200m)

LIGHT UP (J Parkes) - Bounded at the start and lost ground, bumped with BUCK SHELLFISH near the 350 metres.

**HE'S GOT POWER** (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

**ONESTAR** (R Hannam) - Slow to begin.

**OUR ROSETTE** (K Chowdhoory) - Got its head up when over racing through the middle stages and passing the 800 metres shifted inwards placing KITTY POWER in restricted room for several strides.

**KHITAN WARRIOR** (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final turn having to be steadied away from the heels of HOT TAP near the 600 metres continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

**BUCK SHELLFISH** (C Johnson) - Bumped with LIGHT UP near the 350 metres.

KITTY POWER (L Hemi) - Held up until near the 250 metres.

# Race 6 ANGUS MEATS GREAT AUTUMN PREMIER (2500m)

SHAKTI (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and lost ground.

**DIORISSIMO** (C Campbell) - Very slow to begin (5L), held up rounding the final turn before shifting outwards passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running. Lost the left hind plate during the running.

**SHEZATOUCHA** (T Comignaghi) - Got its head up when being restrained to avoid the heels of LADY BEALEY (C Johnson) which shifted inwards passing the 2300 metres. Rider C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.

**LIL MISS SWISS** (R Mudhoo) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

**TAXIHOME** (K Kwo) - Raced three wide without cover through the middle stages.

**RESIDENTIAL** (L Allpress) - Eased down over the concluding stages with the rider advising that the mare had shortened up in its action. L Allpress added that the mare may not have seen out the distance of today's race in combination with its big weight. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

### Race 7 DAVID EMERSON ACCOUNTANT & BUSINESS CONSULTANT PREMIER (1600m)

**HERENGAWE** (L Allpress) - Bounded at the start losing ground. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to respond once placed under pressure and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**OUR TEDDY BOY** (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**THE MAN** (J Lowry) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

FORGED (R Mudhoo) - Over raced in the early stages.

FIRE LILY (C Campbell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**HOOFBEAT** (L Hemi) - When weakening passing the 200 metres briefly steadied away from the heels of PINUP COUP (L Callaway) which shifted inwards under pressure. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care.

## Race 8 DAPHNE BANNAN MEMORIAL GREAT EASTER STAKES (1400m)

PRINCE OZ (T Moseley) - Very difficult to load.

MACY (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

## Race 9 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE PREMIER (1400m)

**SO BRAZEN** - Declared a late scratching behind the barriers at 4.18pm on veterinary advice as it was found to be lame in the right foreleg. A veterinary certificate of fitness is now required prior to racing again.

**DREAMING EASY** (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

**SWEET OAK** (D Turner) - Crowded and lost ground shortly after the start when FINAL SAY shifted inwards, over raced when being restrained near the 1100 metres, steadied when crowded near the 200 metres.

NOPELE (K Mudhoo) - Inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

OWEN PATRICK (R Hannam) - Raced wide without cover.

**KING KANE** (L Allpress) - Over-raced in the lead in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after racing too keenly had been unable to finish the race off.

**GALWAY GARRY** (K Kwo) - Held up through the middle stages of the run home.

**RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT** (T Comignaghi) - Had to be steadied away from the heels of HEE'S OUR SECRET near the 250 metres.

**K Asano** (FINAL SAY) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards under pressure crowding SWEET OAK which had to be steadied near the 200 metres. Contributing to the incident was some outward movement from TRUDEAU.

**MONZA CIRCUITO** (R Mudhoo) - Had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HEE'S OUR SECRET which lay in away from RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT passing the 150 metres, raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

**HEE'S OUR SECRET** (J Parkes) - Inclined to lay inwards when tiring over the concluding 150 metres.
