S O'Malley did not attend today's meeting after a fall at trackwork on Tuesday.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MURRAY CONTRACTORS 2200 (2200 Metres)

GOLD FLAKE (R Hannam) - Slow away.

HOUBOUCHOUX (L Hemi) – Slow away.

DANGERMAN (R Elliot) - Made the bend awkwardly approaching the 1600 metres, running wide on the track.

HEZA BIG HOPE (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages, before being allowed to improve passing the 1400 metres to sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres. Contacted 250 metres.

UNIQUEBOTIQUE (S McKay) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BELLA NERO (C O'Beirne) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres. Held up passing the 400 metres, having to be restrained when disappointed for a run to the inside of DANGERMAN passing the 300 metres, and when doing so shifted outwards contacting HEZA BIG HOPE near the 250 metres.

MEANT TO BE (S Collett) – When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 2 MARTY AND DI'S CATERING 2200 (2200 Metres)

TABOO (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly.

ALFIE DEE (A Kuru) - Awkwardly away, dictated inwards when QUAFF (S Karnicnik) shifted in shortly after the start. S Karnicnik was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised that he is expected to exercise greater care. Raced three wide without cover from the 1400 metres.

NAPOLEON (K Veenendaal) – Awkwardly away.

ALTIUS (C Dell) - Raced keenly in the early stages having to be angled away from the rail to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.

BEAU GESTE (D Turner) – Raced keenly when in front in the early and middle stages.

PRIOR ENGAGEMENT (E Farr) – Slow away. Made the bend near the 1600 metres awkwardly.

QUAFF (S Karnicnik) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

LINCOLN'S SECRET (S Phelan) - Gave ground from the 800 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding was making a respiratory noise during the race. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have suffered a cardiac arrhythmia and will require a veterinary clearance prior to starting next.

Race 3 JOHN AND NATALIE MABEY 2600 (2600 Metres)

WEE BISKIT (C Dell) Began awkwardly.

KIRKENES (S Karnicnik) - Raced keenly in the early stages, with the saddle slipping forward placing the rider at a disadvantage.

CLASS ABOVE (S Fannin) - Raced three wide without cover in the early stages.

NO TIP (A Kuru) - Lay inwards in the home straight having to be straightened.

GUY FOX (S MacNab) – Briefly held up near the 350 metres. Returned to the enclose with blood present in its mouth. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the gelding had knocked a tooth.

K Veenendaal (ZENTANGLE) - Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.

Race 4

MERRYLEES HOTEL 1200 (1200 Metres)

THEWAYYOUMADEME (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly settling back.

CHOUXMAKA (R Elliot) – Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

PAINLESS (M Hudson) – Began awkwardly, with the rider losing the use of her off-side iron for a short distance. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RED PEPPER (S McKay) – Slow away. Raced greenly under pressure in the home straight. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

DIVINE WINE (M Singh) - When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 5

PROPERTY BROKERS 1200 (1200 Metres)

RUFUS RUFFCUT (J Parkes) -Slow away.

OFA ORESOME (D Turner) - Blundered at the start, losing ground.

LINCOLN'S GAL (C Johnson) - Began awkwardly settling back.

WHAT A SMASHER (H Andrew) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

PACIFIC COAST (J Kamaruddin) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MISS OAHU (S Collett) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 200 metres, hampering IVAN KANE. When questioned rider S Collett advised that after drawing wide the mare was unable to improve its position due to the fast tempo of today's race. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have mild muscle stiffness (tied up).

IVAN KANE (S McKay) – Held up early in the home straight, then hampered near the 200 metres, having to be angled wide on the track to improve. Lay in under pressure over the remainder.

ALL IN MANA (R Elliot) - Disappointed for a run over the final stages between DEERFIELD and STAND TALL, which shifted in.

STAND TALL (D Hirini) – Lay in under pressure over the final stages.

Race 6

DAVID AND ELLEN OLIVER 1400 (1400 Metres)

THAT'S INCRANIBULL (J Parkes) - Awkwardly away.

ARIDITY (L Hemi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

STAR QUALITY (M Singh) - Held up approaching the 500 metres, gaining clear running entering the home straight.

LADY RUDOLPH (S Collett) - Held up entering the home straight before being angled outwards across heels to gain clear running near the 200 metres. Lay in under pressure over the final stages briefly inconveniencing MARQUITA MISS before being straightened.

MARQUITA MISS (C O'Beirne) - Briefly inconvenienced final stages.

CHARLIE ZULU (A Jones) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse.

R Patterson (ARIDITY) – Issued with a warning under Rule 616(2)(a) after presenting the mare without the notified pre-race ear covers.

Race 7 WENHAM GRAIN 1400 (1400 Metres)

HALFASIXPENCE – Late scratching at 2.00pm after becoming fractious in the tie-up stalls.

SCREAMING MIMI (S McKay) - Awkwardly away, settling back.

CREDIT MANAGER (H Andrew) – Blundered at the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MOZZIE (T Johnson) - Raced greenly throughout.

EISENHOWER (L Hemi) - Steadied near the 1200 metres.

SWEET ALIBHAI (D Turner) - When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. Restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres.

Z Moki (SEMPER MAGICO) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

H Andrew (CREDIT MANAGER) - Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

C Johnson (PER PERSEVERANCE) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount to shift in near the 1200 metres, tightening EISENHOWER, which had to be steadied.

Race 8 MITRE 10 DANNEVIRKE 1600 (1600 Metres)

PARIS COUTURE (D Turner) – Began awkwardly settling back.

CARPE DIEM (C Johnson) - Slow away.

RUSTY IN RONGOTEA (R Elliot) - Restrained from a wide draw.

LINCOLN LANE (R Hannam) - Raced three wide throughout.

ROCK WITH CHOUX (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

WAR OF WORDS (M Singh) - Raced three wide in the early stages improving to lead near the 1000 metres.

HINEPARA (C O'Beirne) – Held up for a short distance behind the tiring WAR OF WORDS passing the 400 metres.

Race 9 SANDFLY AND LORRAINE BROWN 1600 (1600 Metres)

AMUSEDANDCONFUSED (T Johnson) - Slow away.

BRIAN BORU (D Turner) - Tightened at the start settling back when KAHU ROCK jumped inwards dictating MAIPE.

MAIPE (S McKay) - Dictated at start settling back.

FLORENCE O'REILLY (M Singh) - Raced keenly in the early stages when in the lead.

KELTIC ROCKSTAR (A Jones) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

WEARE ROCKING (Z Moki) - Briefly inconvenienced behind the tiring THE FOT near the 300 metres.
