## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>COREY N EMMA FAREWELL TO AUS (2200m)</b>
NATHAN DETROIT (B Morgenrood) – Slow to begin.	
RAISE YOUR SIGHTS (K Mudhoo) – Inconvenienced shortly after the start losing ground.	

<p><b>RIPINHET</b> (T Jonker) – Made the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion.</p> <p><b>ELIZA LONG</b> (D Prastiyou) – Over raced in the early stages having to be heavily restrained off the heels of STEELE CANYON (L Hemi) passing the 1700 metres. L Hemi was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground. Continued to over race for some distance.</p> <p><b>BAHHGOOFY</b> (L Callaway) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages before obtaining cover near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>HOKITIKA SUNSET</b> (R Mudhoo) – Gave ground passing the 600 metres. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to stewards satisfaction and be more competitive prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>L Hemi</b> (STEELE CANYON) admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>PHAT DUCK BREW BAR AND KITCHEN (2200m)</b>
<p><b>KEYBOARD WARRIOR</b> (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered between runners rounding the first turn.</p> <p><b>TICKY TU</b> (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, made the first bend awkwardly shifting out placing KEYBOARD WARRIOR in restricted room for a distance and also hampering DOWRY DUTY which was forced wider.</p> <p><b>ADDITUP</b> (R Beeharry) – Raced wide in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>BABAN</b> (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider reported that the gelding was under pressure a long way from home and in his opinion was not entirely comfortable in the prevailing track conditions. Stewards ordered a post race veterinary inspection which revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600m)</b>
<p><b>ICEBREAKER</b> (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>JINGO</b> (D Turner) – Crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground.</p> <p><b>SHOW CLOUD</b> (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly losing its footing behind.</p> <p><b>POP DIVA</b> (S Collett) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p><b>NIFTY</b> (T Jonker) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>ROCKWITHME</b> (K Mudhoo ) – Checked and had to steady passing the 300 metres when KANUMISS (C Johnson) shifted inwards.</p> <p><b>C Johnson</b> (KANUMISS) admitted a breach of careless riding in that he shifted inwards passing the 300 metres when insufficiently clear. After hearing evidence the Judicial Committee suspended C Johnson’s licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 12 May up to and including 22 May.</p> <p>The track was downgraded to Slow (7) following this race.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MATT SMITH CONSTRUCTION (1600m)</b>
<p><b>YAMATO NADESHIKO</b> (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>AMOUR LA VIE</b> (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>FINAL SAY</b> (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>PALAMOUNTAINS ANIMAL NUTRITION (1200m)</b>

**STORMBOY** (BB Hong) – Slow to begin.

**HEARTOHEART** (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**THE TRAVELLER** (J Lowry) – Over raced and got its head up early when being restrained and then placed in restricted room shortly thereafter when NERO shifted inwards.

**K Mudhoo** (NERO) was warned for shifting ground in the early stages.

**NERO** (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres when in restricted room.

**EXCLAIM** (T Moseley) – Made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly getting its head up on a number of occasions.

**OPHELIA ROSE** (K Williams) – Raced wide throughout.

**CASTLEREIGH** (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover throughout. A post race veterinary inspection revealed poor post race recovery. Stewards will follow up with connections in coming days.

**HE'S IRISH** (R Mudhoo) – Made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly shifting wider on the track.

**KNOWN TO FLIRT** (J Laking) – Held up passing the 500 metres only obtaining clear running inside the final 250 metres.

**WHITNEY** (D Prastiyau) – Slow to begin (3L).

**MIROSLAVA** (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly losing ground, made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly

**BENEFICIAL** (T Moseley) – Shifted in shortly after jumping away placing MISS BRAHMOS in restricted room for a short distance, became awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres shifting outwards as a result, lay in and made contact with MISS BRAHMOS passing the 100 metres.

**JULIETTE** (C Johnson) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 900 metres.

**BORN A ROYAL** (K Kwo) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

**MISS BRAHMOS** (S Collett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MARK MCCORMICK CAMMERAY R.U.F.U. SUPPORTERS (1400m)</b>

Trainer **D Crozier** (DANNY GREEN) was warned for presenting his runner late in the birdcage.

**DANNY GREEN** (R Mudhoo) – Began very awkwardly shifting in abruptly losing ground.

**CHORISTER** (B Morgenrood) – Shifted in on jumping away.

**HEY MICKEY** (D Turner) – Crowded and steadied on jumping away.

**JADORE LUMIERE** (J Laking) – Contacted shortly after jumping being dictated inwards, raced wide in the early stages.

**I GOT A ROCK** (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**RAFF** (BB Hong) – Lay inwards across heels approaching the 200 metres having to be steadied then shifted outwards abruptly hampering BELLISSIMA BELLE, became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 50 metres having to be steadied.

<b>BB Hong</b> (RAFF) was warned for the manner in which he shifted ground approaching the 200 metres.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>GARY MCCORMICK BIN HIRE (1400m)</b>
<p><b>SHE’S GALLANT</b> (K Mudhoo) escaped riderless from the start and after being recaptured returned to undergo a veterinary inspection and was cleared to start. When attempting reloading, the mare again escaped riderless and after recapture was late scratched by Stewards at 4.18 pm. The start of the race was subsequently delayed approximately 9 minutes.</p> <p><b>ADMIRAL ROUS</b> (BB Hong) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>DEVIOUS</b> (D Turner) – Tended to get its head up in the early stages when over racing.</p> <p><b>LONDARO</b> (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>ELANA ROSE</b> (T Moseley) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of a tiring runner near the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>FIRE SHOW</b> (R Beeharry) – Lay in under pressure passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p><b>K Williams</b> (QUEEN JETSUN) was warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>
