Race 8 THANK YOU TO OUR VOLUNTEERS (1200 METRES)

RED DYNAMO (S McKay) - Co-trainer C Gibbs reported that RED DYNAMO had appeared to get its tongue over the bit causing a laceration which had more than likely contributed to the gelding's racing manners.

Race 1	DUNSTAN FEEDS 2100
<p>GABRIEL (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded and checked near the 1800 metres. Checked approaching the 350 metres. Rider dropped her whip near the 100 metres.</p> <p>GIOVANNI CANALETTO (T Harris) – Held up until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>AMORATA (R Elliot) – Held up entering the final straight before shifting in approaching the 350 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>T Harris (GIOVANNI CANALETTO) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of GABRIEL which was checked near the 1800 metres. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended T Harris's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 25 May up to and including racing on 1 June, 5 national days.</p> <p>R Elliot (AMORATA) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of GABRIEL which was checked near the 350 metres. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended R Elliot's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 23 May up to and including racing on 29 May, 4 national days.</p> <p>JOCHEN RINDT (S Spratt) – Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection, including an endoscopic examination, which could find no abnormality.</p>	
Race 2	GARRARDS HORSE & HOUND HURDLES
<p>LACUSTRE (W Gordon) – Jumped the first fence poorly losing ground.</p> <p>COMMANDER (A Kuru) – Jumped the first fence poorly. Hit the second to last fence.</p> <p>MCHALE (S Karnicnik) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>CAPE CEILIDH (H McNeill) – Jumped the final three fences indifferently.</p> <p>CURIOUS GEORGE (N Downs) – Raced in restricted room approaching the second to last fence.</p>	
Race 3	FAIRVIEW MOTORS WAIKATO HURDLES
<p>WILIJONMCBRIDE (R Elliot) – Steadied when hampered near the 3000 metres by TOMMYRA (S Phelan) which shifted in when marginally clear. S Phelan was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>IT'S A WONDER (W Gordon) – Became awkwardly placed on heels after jumping the second fence shifting in making contact with WILIJONMCBRIDE for a distance.</p> <p>YARDARM (M Gillies) – Raced three wide without cover throughout, and did not jump the final three fences being pulled up.</p> <p>NO CHANGE (A Kuru) – Misjudged the fence near the 1900 metres and blundered on landing.</p>	

HENRY TUDOR (J Seivwright) – Hit the third to last fence.

HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) – Hit the third to last fence losing momentum.

NOTHING TRIVIAL (B Lammas) – Hit the final fence and blundered on landing unbalancing its rider.

Race 4

WEALLEANS 1200

PLUTON (R Elliot) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after racing keenly in the early and middle stages the gelding had failed to run on.

BOLT FROM THE BLUE (M McNab) – BOLT FROM THE BLUE which was laying out became awkwardly placed inside the heels of GLORIOUS OCEAN which shifted in and away from QJI EXPRESS passing the 300 metres with BOLT FROM THE BLUE then being held up for a distance. Inconvenienced over the concluding stages after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of GLORIOUS OCEAN which shifted in and away from PINULTIMATE (T Harris). T Harris was advised to exercise care.

PINULTIMATE (T Harris) – Held up rounding the final bend, then had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

SHE'S A GODDESS (C Lammas) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions.

D Danis (LOCK IT IN) – Admitted a charge of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$500 by the Judicial Committee.

Race 5

TE RAPA EVENT CENTRE STEEPLECHASE

SUFFICE TO SAY (A Kuru) – Raced keenly when being steadied in the early stages. Misjudged the fifth fence. Knuckled on landing after jumping the fence near the 1400 metres. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

NAPOLEON (S Fannin) – Lost its footing making the bend crossing the junction into the centre of the steeplechase course.

BIG MEADSY (B Lammas) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the sixth fence. Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

STORMING THE TOWER (N Downs) – Misjudged the fence near the 1400 metres.

MR ENTHUSIASTIC (S Karnicnik) – Hit the final fence and fell on landing dislodging its rider. S Karnicnik was attended to by on course medical personnel and found to be uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which found a cut in the left nostril. Lost the off fore plate during the running.

JUSTNAMETHEPRICE (L Douglas) – Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection and was found to be lame in the left foreleg having pulled the deep digital flexor beneath the fetlock. The connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to the gelding racing next.

Race 6

SIGNATURE HOMES WAIKATO STEEPLECHASE

JUST GOT HOME (H McNeill) – Jumped the first fence poorly losing ground, and then jumped indifferently throughout.

SHAMAL (B Lammas) – Jumped the second fence poorly unbalancing its rider and losing ground.

GAGARIN (M Gillies) – Lost its footing when racing ungenerously approaching the third last fence.

YIPSON (S Fannin) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

JOKING (G Walsh) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

MAGIC WONDER (S Jackson) – Knuckled on landing after jumping the final fence. Shifted in just prior to the winning post making contact with MAX.

MAX (I Lupton) – Bumped just prior to the winning post.

M Gillies (GAGARIN) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7	HAPPY 60TH BRUCE DARBY 1400
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PIERIAN SPRING (S Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

KONSTANTINA (C Grylls) – Crowded leaving the barrier.

AILEEN GRACE (L Satherley) – Crowded soon after leaving the barrier.

MONEY TRAIL (J Fawcett) – Crowded soon after leaving the barrier. Raced keenly in the early stages.

SILK (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly.

SO WICKED (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly then steadied from a wide barrier. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in his opinion the mare would be better suited to more rain affected footing.

WOODEN EDGE (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly then steadied from a wide barrier.

GOBONIEGO (A Calder) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BRIDAL VEIL (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 8	WAIKATO STUD 1600
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ALIGNS WITH ME (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

GO NICHOLAS (G Cooksley) – Crowded and hampered soon after leaving the barriers losing ground.

SPIDER (C Burdan) – Over-raced in the early stages having to steady away from heels passing the 1200 metres, and then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

LIGHT SHADOW (R Smyth) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

PAISLEY PARK (S Collett) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 200 metres making contact with SPIDER.

ROC DE BANK (R Scott) – Raced in restricted room passing the 350 metres.

POP STAR PRINCESS (L Satherley) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in her opinion the mare had been feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer F Cornege confirmed to Stewards that the mare would now be sent for a spell.

IGNORED (C Grylls) – Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had raced flat throughout and failed to quicken when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 9 | KERR & LADBROOK CATERERS @ TE RAPA 1600

KYA KHOOB LAGTI HO (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SKAABOOM (M McNab) – Crowded soon after leaving the barrier. Held up early in the final straight before shifting out near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

ASCOMANNI (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

LUEN YAT MIRACLE (T Harris) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

WILLIAM SCOTT (C Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HELLO SAILOR (T Newman) – Steadied passing the 250 metres when weakening.

DON'T DOUBT ME (C Lammas) – Crowded and checked near the 300 metres.

YATIMA (S Spratt) – Held up entering the final straight, then shifted out making firm contact with **DON'T DOUBT ME** which was checked with **YATIMA** becoming unbalanced near the 300 metres.

S Spratt (**YATIMA**) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she directed her mount outwards when not sufficiently clear of **DON'T DOUBT ME** which was checked near the 300 metres. After hearing all relevant evidence the Judicial Committee suspended S Spratt's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 18 May up to and including racing on Thursday 30 May, 7 national riding days.

GLENDALOUGH (M Coleman) – Held up rounding the final bend then continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

M Coleman (**GLENDALOUGH**) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of **HELLO SAILOR** which had to be steadied near the 250 metres.
