Race 1	MCLEAY JEWELLER & MARQUEE & PARTY HIRE (2147M)
MACPAC (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.	
THE MARLBORO MA'AM (C Campbell) – Became unbalanced when tiring and making contact with POWER PUNCH passing the 600 metres. Rider reported the mare had hung inwards throughout.	

MOLLY POLLY (K Chowdhooey) – Lay inwards throughout the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.	
Race 2	MONKEY BAY ESTATE & RICKI EGERTON DAGGING (2147M)
MIDNIGHT KAOS (T Moseley) – Late scratching on veterinary advice at 11.47am.	
SWEET TIME (T Jonker) – Raced wide in the early stages.	
EAGER BEVER (K Chowdhooey) – Improved wide from the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner rider reported that the mare had failed to handle the prevailing Heavy track conditions.	
BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (R Mudhoo) – Lay outwards in the run home and had to be straightened.	
COLOUR ME RED (D Bothamley) – When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner rider reported that in his opinion the gelding had failed to back from its previous start on Sunday 12 th May.	
Race 3	DONALD WHITE HEDGECUTTING GREAT WESTERN HURDLE (2500M)
DOCTOR EDEN (G Walsh) – Inclined to over race through the middle stages and got its head up on a number of occasions.	
BOYSWAY (S Karnicnik) – Made a poor jump at the third last fence.	
GOGO GONZO (S Fannin) – Weakened from the 600 metres.	
BANBURY LAD (S Higgins) – Inclined to lay inwards throughout the run home having to be straightened passing the 50 metres.	
Race 4	BRENDON SHEARING CONTRACTING & HAZLETT CONTRACTING (1200M)
LOCK 'N' TAP (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly, unbalancing the rider momentarily and got back. Weakened from the 400 metres finishing in a distant last placing.	
TOBILICIOUS (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly. Inclined to lay outwards throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.	
SHE'LL CAT CHOUX (B Murray) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.	
Race 5	D T KINGS TRANSPORT LTD 112th GREAT WESTERN STEEPLECHASE (3900M)
PADDY OWEN (G Walsh) – Made a poor leap at the fence by the 3200 metres. Again made a poor leap at the fence by the 2500 metres. Pulled up at the fence near the 1800 metres.	
ADEQUACY (S Karnicnik) – Made a poor leap at the fence by the 1400 metres.	
REGALO REAAL (S Fannin) – Pulled up after jumping the fence by the 900 metres.	
DELACROIX (J Seivwright) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed an injury to the inside of the left front coronet consistent with the gelding over reaching.	
Race 6	RIVERTON SUPERVALUE & BEACH HOUSE CAFE (1600M)
HE AIN'T HEAVY A Bohorun) – Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout. When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner rider advised the gelding had failed to handle the testing nature of today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.	

VALENTINA VITTORIA (K Chowdhoo) – Over raced passing the 1200 metres.	
THE CZAR (T Moseley)- Inclined to lay outwards rounding the final bend.	
Race 7	COREY & TIM WHITE & HARCOURTS REAL ESTATE (1400M)
PESHAWAR (C Barnes) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, getting its head up on a number of occasions.	
ROSIE GLOW (K Chowdhoo) – Raced wide throughout. Lay outwards and had to be straightened over the concluding stages.	
THE FLAGON (K Mudhoo) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres and had to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running.	
Race 8	TONY ROY BUILDING & WAYNE’S WORLD & WRENS (1400M)
ALL THE DRAMA (B Murray) – Raced wide throughout. Weakened on the final bend and was not persevered with thereafter, finishing in last placing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities .Stewards will follow up with the trainer in coming days.	
TAPILIZE (R Mudhoo) – Lay inwards passing the 100 metres having to be straightened. Lay inwards over the concluding stages and made contact with DON’T BE CHEEKY near the 30 metres.	
KARM ‘N’ EASY (T Moseley) – rider reported that the gelding was less than comfortable in today’s track conditions.
