GENERAL:

L Petersen (Amateur) did not attend today's race day after being injured in track work on Tuesday and was replaced on her mount, GALAPAGOS, in Race 3 by S Fannin.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 FRUITFED CUSTOMER SERVICES HURDLE (2500 Metres) EL BAYARDO (H McNeill) – Slow away. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding would appreciate more rain-affected going.

COOL HAND DUKE (A Kuru) - Ran down the first fence losing ground.

ABACUS (S Karnicnik) – Jumped the fence by the 600 metres awkwardly. Hit the second to last fence, unbalancing the rider for a short distance.

BRAKBAR (M Gillies) - Rider reported there may be something amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a superficial wound to the right hind stifle.

THE BIEBER (L Douglas) - Lay in jumping the last fence becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ZED LEPPELIN.

Race 2 ADAMA HURDLE (2500 Metres)

OOEE (Kuru) – Attempted to buck for a short distance early in the race. Connections were advised that a warning will be placed against the gelding's racing manners. Hit the last fence.

GALLANTE (E Farr) - Jumped the first fence awkwardly, losing ground.

EDDIE GILBERT (J Seivwright) - Jumped high in the early stages. Jumped inwards at the second to last fence making contact with the hind quarters of EION, which jumped outwards.

EION (B Lammas) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Jumped outwards second to last fence, contacting EDDIE GILBERT.

POROTENE MAGNUM (L Douglas) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Restrained off heels near the 1500 metres. Clipped a heel and blundered near the 700 metres when racing up onto heels. Jumped the last fence awkwardly.

ZENTANGLE (R Elliot) - Hit the second to last fence.

Race 3 BALLANCE AGRI-NUTRIENTS 2100 (2100 Metres)

WICKLOW (S Wenn) - Blundered at the start losing ground.

ROHAN (J Sanders) - Began awkwardly settling back.

GALAPAGOS (S Fannin) - Slow away.

GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (F Lazet) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 1700 metres. Inconvenienced near the 1500 metres when the THE OYSTERMAN (B Rogerson) shifted in when not the required distance clear. B Rogerson was advised to exercise greater care.

ALBARON (S MacNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RELY ON ME (E Quinn) - Disappointed for a run near the 250 metres when MASTER COURTSMAN rolled in under pressure, dictating THE ROLLING STONE.

A Wallace (MASTER COURTSMAN) – Dislocated his shoulder approaching the 200 metres and was unable to ride his mount to full advantage over the final stages. A medical clearance is required prior to riding next.

Race 4 NUFARN 2YO (1300 Metres)

LOIRE (C McNab) – Began awkwardly, settling back. Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.

REGGIEWOOD (S McKay) - Began awkwardly, settling back. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

ARATAI (V Colgan) – Tightened at the start when IDEA FROM HEAVEN jumped sideways, contacting STAR ELLIPSE simultaneously as ROCKLEY BEACH jumped inwards. Restrained off heels near the 700 metres. Held up entering the home straight, disappointed for a run near the 200 metres, gaining clear running approaching the 100 metres.

ROCKLEY BEACH (R Myers) – Jumped inwards at the start. Inconvenienced 1100 metres and again approaching the 800 metres.

CINZENTO (S Collett) - Raced very ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained, shifting out inconveniencing ARATAI and ROCKLEY BEACH near the 1100 metres, then made the bend awkwardly approaching the 800 metres, further inconveniencing ROCKLEY BEACH, before being allowed to improve forward to lead approaching the 600 metres.

Race 5SYNGENTA CROP PROTECTION 3YO (1300 Metres)DR VELOCIOUS (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly contacting INTO THE DEEP and settling back.

TALENTI (J Parkes) – Restrained from a wide draw then raced three wide without cover throughout.

KING FAROUK (S Collett) - Raced keenly when in front in the early stages.

KAPALKA (R Elliot) – Hampered near the 200 metres.

D Hirini (CHALK) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after shifting out approaching the 200 metres hampering KAPALKA. D Hirini is advised she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

A Goindasamy (INTO THE DEEP) - Was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the riding master, reprimanded, and warned under Rule 638(1)(d) for attempting a run to inside KING FAROUK near the 100 metres, which was never available.

INTO THE DEEP (A Goindasamy) – Held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres. Held up approaching the 100 metres, going to the line not fully tested.

Race 6 AGRITRADE VALAGRO 1200 (1200 Metres)

VEUVE CLICQUOT (L Hemi) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

WHOWOULDKNOW (D Hirini) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in early in the home straight before being straightened.

BLUE ARROW (R Myers) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when over-racing, shifting out briefly inconveniencing HONFLEUR. Held up passing the 200 metres, then raced in restricted room for the remainder.

AUTHENTIC CHARM (Z Moki) - Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

DEFIBRILLATE (S Collett) –Checked approaching the 200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HONFLEUR (McNab), which shifted in. When assessing the interference, stewards took into account outward movement from WHOWOULDKNOW, which shifted out when being corrected. M McNab was shown footage and advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

HONFLEUR (M McNab) – Shifted in 200 metres.

Z Moki (AUTHENTIC CHARM) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) with regards to her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 CORTEVA AGRISCIENCE 1400 (1400 Metres)

LE GRAZIE (J Riddell) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Hampered and shifted out near the 800 metres.

FACEPAINT (A Goindasamny) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

POLIZZI (C O'Beirne) – Raced keenly when wide without cover throughout.

MATT CAIN (V Colgan) – Restrained off heels making the bend approaching the 800 metres awkwardly, going back on to LE GRAZIE, which had to be restrained, and when doing so shifted out hampering UNIDENTIFIED, which was forced wide on the track. Continued to race keenly for a short distance.

ZEALAND (R Elliot) - Held up rounding the turn having to be angled outwards across heels early in the home straight to improve. Had to be angled inwards to gain clear running hear the 100 metres. Shifted in abruptly under pressure near the 50 metres, having to be straightened.

SO SUE ME (D Hirini) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight then held up approaching the 200 metres, shifting in making contact with the hind quarters of SWAGGER, then shifted out briefly inconveniencing POLIZZI which shifted out and away from SO SUE ME.

SWAGGER (L Allpress) - Bumped and briefly unbalanced near the 200 metres.

L Hemi (EISENHOWER) – Was dislodged after the finish of the race and was stood down for her remaining ride by St John paramedics. L Hemi will require a clearance prior to racing next.

UNIDENTIFIED (M McNab) – Hampered and dictated wide on the track 800 metres. When questioned into performance rider advised the filly had raced greenly. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 8 YARA FERTILISER 1300 (1300 Metres)

BANGLES (C Burdan) - Broke through the gates prior to the start and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start.

ACE ROYALE (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Shifted out and away from TUSCAN WHISTLER, which improved into a narrow run to its inside near the 250 metres, then continued to shift out and away from that runner and in doing so shifted into the line of TRIPLE DIAMOND simultaneously as CAMEAHOTFRIDAY shifted in when struck with the whip, with TRIPLE DIAMOND becoming briefly unbalanced near the 200 metres. ACE ROYALE then continued to lay out under pressure over the final stages.

CAMEAHOTFRIDAY (A Goindasamy) - Shifted in when struck with the whip bumping TRIPLE DIAMOND near the 200 metres.

TRIPLE DIAMOND (M Cameron) – Hampered and contacted, becoming briefly unbalanced near the 200 metres.

WILLPOWER (R Myers) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had a tendency to lay outwards throughout the running. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

Race 9 FRUITFED SUPPLIES 1300 (1300 Metres)

YOSSARIAN – R Myers replaced L Hemi (injured). Dictated start. Shifted in under pressure over the final stages having to be straightened.

RED SENNA (L Allpress) - Jumped outwards at the start, dictating YOSSARIAN which tightened TONADILLAS.

TONADILLAS (M Cameron) – Tightened start.

ELETTRA (S McKay) - Slow away

AERO DE PARIS (C Grylls) - Raced ungenerously for a distance in the back straight when attempting to obtain cover, making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

TOODALOO (Z Moki) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.
