Race 1	DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS FINANCIAL YEAR END SALE 1600
<p>JACKFROST (C Campbell) – Slow away.</p> <p>BAKELA (C Johnson) – Slow away. Blundered shortly after the start. Held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed behind a tiring runner.</p> <p>TEDDYTWINKLETOES (K Kwo) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>CRISPIN (C Barnes) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.</p>	

<p>OWEN PATRICK (D Prastiyou) – Held up for some distance rounding the turn until approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p>L Callaway (PINUP COUP) – Was spoken to advisedly about his whip action.</p>	
Race 2	DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS ON ANDY BAY ROAD 1400
<p>TRICKY MICKEY (J Fawcett) – Proved difficult to load.</p> <p>HOUNDOUR (D Prastiyou) – Slow away.</p> <p>CHOOKIE’S GIRL (J Lowry) – Slow away.</p> <p>RUBY EYED (B Murray) – Hampered leaving the barriers when JOEMAR jumped outwards.</p> <p>JOEMAR (C Barnes) – Jumped outwards leaving the barriers. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>RENOUNCE (L Callaway) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>RINGBOLT (K Mudhoo) – Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of RUBY EYED near the 700 metres.</p> <p>Following the running of this event the track was downgraded to Slow 8.</p>	
Race 3	DUNEDIN CITY FORD FINANCIAL YEAR END SALE 1200
<p>NOPELE (K Mudhoo) – Slow away. Got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 800 metres due to the lack of tempo.</p> <p>TURNCOAT (L Callaway) – Got its head up on a number of occasions in the early stages when being restrained while in the lead. Post race veterinary inspection revealed superficial lacerations to the hind legs requiring veterinary treatment.</p> <p>OPIO ROSE (A Bohorun) – Wide throughout. The rider reported that the mare had hung throughout.</p> <p>NELLIE BLY (K Chowdhoory) – Held up rounding the turn near the 400 metres before shifting inwards across the heels of TURNCOAT to obtain clear running near the 300 metres then being placed in restricted room to the inside of that runner near the 200 metres before clipping a heel of TURNCOAT (L Callaway) and blundering badly dislodging its rider near the 125 metres. K Chowdhoory was uninjured. Post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>L Callaway (TURNCOAT) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount TURNCOAT to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of NELLIE BLY which clipped a heel and blundered dislodging its rider near the 125 metres. After hearing submissions L Callaway was suspended by the JCA from completion of racing 31st May up to and including 28th June (4 weeks).</p>	
Race 4	DUNEDIN CITY MAZDA FINANCIAL YEAR END SALE 1100
<p>MIROSLAVA (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Had to shift ground outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.</p> <p>OUT OF ACES (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider dropped whip approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>BET YA WOOD (J Laking) – Raced ungenerously through the early stages.</p> <p>BELLAROSINA (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover.</p>	

DON'T BE CHEEKY (A Bohorun) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 800 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after the rider reported that the gelding had been making abnormal respiratory noises, which revealed no abnormalities.	
Race 5	DUNEDIN CITY USED CARS FINANCIAL Y/END SALE 2200
<p>FRIDAY KNIGHT (R Beeharry) – Slow away. Held up approaching the 200 metres when having to shift out across heels to obtain clear running.</p> <p>BABY MENAKA (T Comignaghi) – Over raced in the early and middle stages due to the lack of tempo. Was inclined to lay inwards throughout the final straight having to be straightened passing the 200 metres after making contact with the rail. Was unable to be ridden out fully over the concluding stages due to laying inwards.</p> <p>NATHAN DETROIT (L Callaway) – Was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>GRANT (D Bothamley) – Got its head up when being restrained passing the 1600 metres. Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres and had to be steadied momentarily.</p> <p>COUNTESS RUBY (C Johnson) – Was not afforded clear running throughout the home straight and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.</p>	
Race 6	FORD RANGER NZ NO1 VEHICLE 2200
<p>SMILING ASSASSIN (L Allpress) – Had a tendency to over race in the middle stages shifting outwards to avoid heels near the 1000 metres then racing three wide without cover.</p> <p>SHANTAV (B Murray) – Raced three wide without cover for a short distance passing the 1800 metres.</p> <p>LONDONDERRY AIR (C Campbell) – Held up rounding the final turn. Was unable to obtain clear running in the straight having to be steadied over the concluding stages.</p> <p>ABLAZE (C Johnson) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running late in the straight.</p> <p>LADY BEALEY (J Fawcett) – Placed in restricted room for a short distance passing the 1800 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of NOMEN LUDI(T Moseley)which shifted inwards.</p> <p>T Moseley (NOMEN LUDI) – Was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p>K Kwo (TILLY DUNNAGE) – Warned for whip use on runner out of contention.</p>

<p>DREAMING EASY (T Jonker) – Slow to begin (3L)</p> <p>NOWHERE MAN (K Chowdhoory) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>DARCI MAC (J Laking) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT (G Saejorhor) – Raced very wide throughout.</p> <p>KIWI IDA (R Beeharry) – Lay inwards throughout the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p>

SAINTED PEARL (J Laking) – Jumped away awkwardly. Held up near the 300 metres until near the 100 metres.	

ABBAY KAY (R Mudhoo) – Slow away.

REEVEDERCI (B Murray) – Had a tendency to over race in the early to middle stages.

REGENT STREET (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover.

LORD BEAVER (BB Hong) – Raced wide without cover.

DANZI CREEK (C Campbell) – Was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

FIRE SHOW (R Beeharry) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

EPIC DREAMER (L Callaway) – Rider reported that the mare felt indifferent in its action with a post-race veterinary inspection revealing no obvious abnormalities .Stewards will follow up with trainer in coming days.
