Race 5 ROGER GILL AGRICULTURE 1600
COURAGEOUS BEAU (B R Jones) – Trainer D Saxton advised that on return to her stable the gelding underwent a veterinary examination which revealed a strained ligament in the left fetlock.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	The Baker's Son 1600
<p>The start of this race was delayed approximately 5 minutes when MEESKA MOOSKA (D Danis) dislodged a near front plate in its preliminary requiring farrier attention.</p> <p>INSCRIPTION (A Goindasamy) - Ran wide rounding the final turn and lay out under pressure in the straight.</p> <p>O Bosson - Suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 1 June 2019 until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 13 June 2019 (6 national riding days) after admitting a charge in that he had used the whip excessively on his mount BEE TEE JUNIOR prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 2	Race Images 1400
<p>THE FAME GAME (M Cameron) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1200 metres then being allowed to improve forward wide around the bend to sit outside the leader near the 600 metres.</p> <p>MERLINI (V Colgan) - Jumped away awkwardly. Got its head up and raced ungenerously near the 1100 metres and continued to do so into the middle stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils being confirmed as having bled following a veterinary inspection. MERLINI is now unable to be in training for 2 months and unable to race or trial for 3 months with a veterinary clearance required prior to doing so.</p> <p>VEINE D'OR (D Danis) - Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages on a moderate tempo.</p> <p>JOY ANNA (D Mansour) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>CAMPARI (C Grylls) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight dictating COME BACK TIGER inwards near the 250 metres and continuing to lay in placing COME BACK TIGER in restricted room approaching the 200 metres with COME BACK TIGER then having to be checked passing the 200 metres. Following an inquiry CAMPARI was relegated to second placing. Lost the off front plate during the running.</p> <p>COME BACK TIGER (T Newman) - Dictated inwards near the 250 metres then being placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres before being checked passing the 200 metres. Contributing to this interference was some outward movement from O'ANGEL which when endeavouring to improve to the outside of JOY ANNA was taken out slightly by that runner making contact with COME BACK TIGER.</p> <p>Following the race an objection was lodged by the Stipendiary Stewards on behalf of the connections of the 2nd placed horse COME BACK TIGER alleging interference by the 1st placed horse CAMPARI near the 200 metres. After viewing all available film footage and hearing relevant evidence and submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the protest relegating CAMPARI with the final placings now reading: 10 COME BACK TIGER 1st, 5 CAMPARI 2nd, 8 VEINE D'OR 3rd, 9 O'ANGEL 4th.</p> <p>C Grylls - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount CAMPARI to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of COME BACK TIGER which was checked near the 200 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a suspension from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 1 June 2019 until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 13 June 2019 (6 national riding days).</p>	
Race 3	Shamrock Group 2200
<p>LETMEBY (D Danis) - Slow away.</p> <p>BATTLE ROYAL (J Fawcett) - Over-raced in the lead in the early stages before being restrained to trail.</p>	

COSSACK WARRIOR (D Mansour) - Made the final turn awkwardly when shifting out to obtain clear running inconveniencing MARK TWO and was then inclined to shift ground under pressure in the final straight.

MARK TWO (C Grylls) - Inconvenienced rounding the bend near the 400 metres.

Race 4 | **White Refrigeration 1600**

COPPER FOX (C Lammas) - Crowded shortly after the start clipping a heel and blundering.

PRINCE HAREEM (T Harris) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1200 metres getting its head up and shifting inwards abruptly hampering REDCAYENNE with rider T Harris taking immediate corrective action. PRINCE HAREEM continuing to race ungenerously for a distance.

REDCAYENNE (A Goindasamy) - Hampered when crowded near the 1200 metres. Held up near the 250 metres before obtaining clear running near the 150 metres.

L'ESCALIER ROSE (D Mansour) - Raced wide without cover.

THE KIPLING GIRL (K McCulloch) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

DREAM ON (M Coleman) - A post-race veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination showed some evidence of a respiratory infection with the trainer to seek further treatment from his veterinarian.

Race 5 | **Piazza D'oro Auckland Futurity Stakes (1400 metres)**

CUSTOM CRUISER (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly then being further hampered by AVADANE which jumped outwards.

QUIZ KID (K McCulloch) - Jumped away awkwardly.

HAPPINESS FOREVER (R Norvall) - Hampered shortly after jumping away. Raced ungenerously going into the bend near the 1100 metres and raced greenly throughout.

JENNIFER ECCLES (D Mansour) - Inconvenienced near the 600 metres when SHERWOOD FOREST (T Harris) shifted outwards. T Harris was advised to exercise greater care.

SELENELION (C Grylls) - Steadied near the 50 metres when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of SHERWOOD FOREST.

Race 6 | **Tuakau Cossie Racing Section 1200**

BATTLE TIME (A Goindasamy) - Jumped away awkwardly.

BEVAN STREET (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (O Bosson) - Had to be firmly restrained when over-racing near the 700 metres.

KILLARNEY (V Colgan) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had hung outwards and failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 7 | **Scott Electrical 1200**

STAR TREASURE (O Bosson) - Jumped away awkwardly crowding WILD SEAS onto BRAAVOS and SPLENDIDO. Got its head up when being steadied after being placed in restricted room to the inside of BRAAVOS going into the bend near the 1100 metres.

J Fawcett - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount BRAAVOS to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of STAR TREASURE near the 1100 metres.

WILD SEAS (C Grylls) - Hampered and crowded when leaving the barriers. Held up rounding the final turn and into the straight before shifting out across heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres. Shifted away from STAR TREASURE when that runner shifted outwards under pressure near the 50 metres with WILD SEAS making contact with AIR CENTRE resulting in both runners becoming unbalanced. Relegated from 4th placing following an inquiry.

BRAAVOS (J Fawcett) - Hampered and bumped when leaving the barriers.

SPLENDIDO (R Scott) - Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers.

JUSTACANTA (V Colgan) - Slow away.

AIR CENTRE (C Dell) - Unbalanced when bumped by WILD SEAS near the 50 metres and shifted outwards. Promoted from 5th placing following an inquiry.

Following the race an objection was lodged by the connections of the 5th placed horse AIR CENTRE against the 4th placed horse WILD SEAS alleging interference in the final 50 metres. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the protest with the final placings now reading: 2 BRAAVOS 1st, 10 TIME TO FLY 2nd, 8 STAR TREASURE 3rd, 12 AIR CENTRE 4th, 11 WILD SEAS 5th.

Race 8

Barfoot & Thompson 1400

THE FAITH (V Colgan) - Slow away. Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

LOOKS LIKE (E McCall) - Blundered when making contact with the running rail near the 1100 metres.

PLAYBOY PRINCE (D Danis) - Over-raced in the middle stages racing wide without cover from near the 800 metres.

DAM RELIABLE (J Riddell) - Held up until near the 150 metres.

HENRY HUDSON (C Lammas) - Badly held up early in the final straight then clipping a heel near the 250 metres and continued to be unable to obtain clear running going to the line untested.

MUSSOLINI (A Calder) - Held up near the 300 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race, not being persevered with over the concluding stages.

CHADSDALE (O Bosson) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight before having to be steadied near the 150 metres when LOOKS LIKE shifted outwards. CHADSDALE was then not persevered with for the remainder of the race.

E McCall - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards near the 150 metres placing CHADSDALE in restricted room.

STILTON (L Satherley) - Had to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.

I SEE RED (D Mansour) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 75 metres.

THE ICE KNIGHT (M McNab) - Lost the left hind plate during the running.
