RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HOLDEM CONTRACTING MDN 1400M

TARABEEBEE (L Allpress) – Jumped inwards abruptly at the start making heavy contact with EN ZED FOXY which settled back.

EN ZED FOXY (S McKay) – Contacted at start settling back.

MASTER BLACK JACK (T Johnson) – Slow away. Held up rounding the turn, then disappointed for a run to the inside of EXPLOSIVE ROCK near the 300 metres, having to be angled back towards the rail, held up again passing the 100 metres going to the finish not fully tested.

GREAT NORTH ROAD (M Singh) – Scrambled at the start.

JOSHUA ONE NINE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly bumping EXPLOSIVE ROCK.

HEAT SEEKER (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

NOD (M Cameron) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned into performance rider was of the opinion the filly may be better suited ridden further off the pace. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

MR JIMMY POCKET (R Myers) – Held up before entering the final straight before gaining clear running approaching the 100 metres.

EXPLOSIVE ROC (C Johnson) – Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

SHEBRINGSMERUBIES (J Parkes) – Lay inwards making contact with TUBTHUMPING near the 200 metres, then continued to lay inwards for the remainder.

TUBTHUMPING (S O’Malley) – Restrained near the 800 metres when doing so shifted out becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of EXPLOSIVE ROC going back on to CREDIT MANAGER which was steadied. Contacted near the 200 metres.

S O’Malley (TUBTHUMPING) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after shifting in near the 100 metres when not sufficiently clear of TARABEEBEE which had to be steadied.

OFA ORSOME (H Schofer) – Jumped inwards abruptly simultaneously as CHARTWELL jumped outwards tightening MISS THE MESS which settled back. Lay outwards in the home straight having to be straightened, briefly inconveniencing BOJANGLES near the 150 metres.

MISS THE MESS (L Allpress) – Tightened at start settling back.

DEUCE COUPE (M Singh) – Began awkwardly settling back.

BEAUTIFUL MAN (C Johnson) – Slow away.

BOJANGLES (M Cameron) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Briefly inconvenienced near 150 metres.

COVER DRIVE (R Myers) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

DEEJAY MAC (A Goindasamy) – Hung outwards rounding the final bend making contact with MIKJENE and CHE GUEVARA

MIKJENE (J Riddell) – Bumped 300 metres.

CHE GUEVARA (J Parkes) - Bumped 300 metres.

Race 3 | **ELTHAM VETERINARY SERVICES 1400M**

ROCKONEVE (J Parkes) – Slow away.

DEVI (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.

QUANTUM (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly settling back.

BELLE TEM (R Schofer) – Restrained from a wide draw.

TOPOFTHESTRAIGHT (C Johnson) – Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground. Clipped a heel and blundered near the 900 metres. After questioning riders and viewing footage it was established that WHOZTHEBOSS over reacted when steadied as the pace eased and went back abruptly on to IVAN KANE which when over racing, shifted in to avoid the heels of WHOZTHEBOSS resulting in TOPOFTHESTRAIGHT clipping heels and blundering. Also inconvenienced was BRAMARAMA which had to take evasive action.

HAPPY TAV (H Andrew) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

WHOZTHEBOSS (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 900 metres.

IVAN KANE (S O'Malley) – Raced keenly near the 900 metres and when being restrained shifted inwards.

BRAMARAMA (T Johnson) – Hampered 900 metres.

Race 4 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1200M**

ZAREEBA (J Parkes) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off heels near the 1000 metres. When questioned into performance rider advised the filly had raced greenly throughout.

RARE BREED (C O'Beirne) – Jumped outwards at the start dictating TRENDY BELT and BELLE OF GEORGIA.

TRENDY BELT (H Andrew) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Hung outwards approaching 400 metres.

CATE BLANCO (R Schofer) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

LITTLE SHIRLEY (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Hung outwards rounding the turn. Lay inwards in the home straight.

BOBBY DAWN (S McKay) – Hung outwards rounding the turn, continued to race greenly throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. Connections were advised the filly must trial prior to racing next.

SAVANAH BELLE (L Allpress) – Restrained off heels near the 900 metres getting its head in the air making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

Race 5 | **SILVER FERN FARMS MDN 3YO 1600M**

AMUSEDANDCONFUSED (T Johnson) – Slow away. Gave ground from the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider advised something may be amiss. Subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the filly to have pulled up in a distressed state with an elevated respiratory rate and slow recovery, will require veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

BRIAN BORU (C Johnson) – Slow away. Lay out in the home straight.

WEST COAST (M Singh) – Restrained off heels near the 1400 metres.

Race 6 | **NZB INSURANCE PERL SERIES 1600M**

PUNTA MITA (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly, raced keenly early to middle stages.

ENTREAT (C O’Beirne) – Slow away. Returned to the enclosure with a cut to a foreleg requiring veterinary attention.

MIZZENA (S McNab) – Tightened at the start when SABATICA began awkwardly dictating XMAS WONDER and CHASING THE CROWN.

CHASING THE CROWN (D Danis) – Tightened at start settling back.

XMAS WONDER (T Thornton) – Tightened at start settling back.

SIDEBAR (S Collett) – Raced very wide without cover throughout and was not persevered with when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider advised the filly had hung throughout. Connections were advised the filly must trial before racing next.

Race 7 | **UHLENBERG HAULAGE LTD 1600M**

FOILING (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover.

PYTHAGORUS (M Singh) – Slow away.

MR GERONIMO (S McKay) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

QIAN GUA (J Parkes) – Held up approaching the 600 metres. When questioned into the performance of QIAN GUA rider could offer no excuse other than after getting back early, he had received an interrupted run and was unable to improve.

Race 8 | **RICH HILL STUD 2100M**

ALL IN STITCHES (H Andrew) – Began awkwardly contacting CHARLI ROSE and the GREAT GURU tightening HIGHLY LIKELY which settled back.

CHARLI ROSE (M Cameron) – Contacted at start settling back.

HIGHLY LIKELY (S O’Malley) – Tightened at start and settled back.

LADY STYLE (H Schofer) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE GREAT GURU (R Hannam) – Tightened at start settling back, raced keenly in the middle stages.

WHOPPER’S (S MacNab) – Held up from the 600 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running. entering the home straight.

S O'Malley (HIGHLY LIKELY) – Was spoken to with regard to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

KIRKENES (J Parkes) – When questioned into performance rider advised that after travelling well the gelding had been disappointing in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.
