RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 LODGE REAL ESTATE 1200

THREE SIXTY (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

SHIPSHAPE (M McNab) – Knuckled leaving the barriers.

VANILLA CHINCHILLA (D Mansour) – Slow to begin.

THE REVENANT (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

MISS BAZILI (V Colgan) – Slow to begin.

PORSHABELLE (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages when leading.

ALFA ROSSO (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages making the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres bumping MISS HEPBURN which was forced wider and lost its footing. Shifted in approaching the 600 metres making contact with VANILLA CHINCHILLA.

MISS HEPBURN (C Burdan) – Contacted and forced wider near the 800 metres losing its footing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer J Richards advised that the filly would now be sent for a spell.

MRS RUMBLE (C Grylls) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 2 WEBSITE ANGELS 1200

WIND CHIMES (J Riddell) – Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied.

NITRO (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly and then crowded.

SWEET DREAMS (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly then steadied.

SHOWCAT (D Mansour) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

WONDERING (T Thornton) – Held up until near the 250 metres.

Race 3 ALLIED SECURITY 2000

CHARRED (M Roustoby) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

KIPLING (C Dell) – Began awkwardly.

COME DANCE WITH ME (S Karnicnik) – Began awkwardly.

YES FATHER (B Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Lost contact with the body of the field passing the 1000 metres, then was not persevered with from inside the 600 metres finishing well back. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

CASTLE BLACK (A Kuru) – Slow to begin. Steadied when the pace eased approaching the 1400 metres.

KRAKADEEL (J Riddell) – Lay out entering the final straight placing MR SCALLYWAG in restricted room. Lay out approaching the 350 metres making contact with MAV, continuing to lay out for the remainder of the race.

MR SCALLYWAG (T Moki) – Raced in restricted room entering the final straight.

S O'Malley (FIGEAMEOUT) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively on FIGEAMEOUT prior to the 100 metres, and was fined the sum of \$300 by the Judicial Committee.

Race 4 SVS 1600

TOORAK TOWER (H McNeill) - Began awkwardly.

SCAGLIONI (B Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MOCCASIN (C Dell) – Began awkwardly.

POP 'N' ROCK (E Farr) – Rider dropped her whip near the 700 metres.

N Downs (NOBLE STAR) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively on NOBLE STAR prior to the 100 metres, and was fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee.

Race 5 BOOK YOUR XMAS DO @ TE RAPA EVENT CENTRE 1200

MAGNIFY (S Collett) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier.

POLLY GREY (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly, then raced in restricted room.

STARMAN (J Riddell) – Hampered when steadying away from heels when placed in restricted room approaching the 900 metres.

Race 6 FAIRVIEW MOTORS 1400

WHOSHE'S GIRL (J Fawcett) – Underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier after being kicked by another runner, and was cleared fit to race. Began awkwardly.

TROPHY (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.

CICCIOLINA (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly.

FLASHDANCE (M Coleman) – Improved on to heels near the 800 metres having to be steadied.

TINTERO (D Mansour) – Improved on to heels passing the 200 metres being hampered as a result.

CHERRY LANE (R Smyth) – Shied and shifted out shortly after the winning post forcing SHIRANUI wider with CICCIOLINA clipping a heel of that runner, dislodging rider O Bosson who was attended to by ambulance personnel and stood down from his remaining rides. O Bosson was transported to Waikato hospital for further observation suffering from concussion.

Race 7 SKYCITY HAMILTON WAIKATO CUP DEC 14 1400

PRIVATE LINE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE WINKLEPICKA (T Thornton) – Slow to begin.

SPIRIT OF GALWAY (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

J Kamaruddin (SPIRIT OF GALWAY) – Was spoken to for the manner in which he used his whip in the final straight.

Race 8 BCD GROUP 1400

MAESTRO BLU (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

PALLADINO (V Colgan) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier.

SHINING SUN (G Swann) – Restrained soon after leaving the barrier.

COLOGNE (S Collett) – Lay out rounding the final bend, and continued to lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 9 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600 Metres)

SODA (M Coleman) – Blundered leaving the barriers losing ground. Inconvenienced approaching the 400 metres.

SWEET SURPRIZE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CARIBBEAN ROSE (M Cameron) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers and hampered losing ground.

THE FIRST MOVE (N Alam) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres forcing GOCARA wider on the track. Raced greenly rounding the final bend.

GOCARA (T Thornton) – Bumped and forced wider near the 800 metres.

JAKAMA KRYSTAL (L Satherley) – Shifted out slightly approaching the 400 metres inconveniencing SOUTHERN QUEEN, LIVVY LASS and SODA.

SOUTHERN QUEEN (M McNab) – Inconvenienced approaching the 400 metres. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

LIVVY LASS (D Mansour) – Inconvenienced approaching the 400 metres.

Race 10 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 Metres)

RAGE IN THE CASTLE (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

MOIRAS TOWN (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TIA CELESTE (T Newman) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier and steadied.

YAMUNA (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

IT'S DOABLE (D Mansour) – The saddle shifted forward when being steadled approaching the 1000 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

IMPERIOUS (V Colgan) – When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality other than a minor laceration on the near hind leg.
