RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	REILLY JOINERY/SPRAY SPECIALIST LTD 2100 (2100 Metres)
I AM A CRAFTSMAN (D Turner) – Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout.	
VACATION (A Jones) – Slow away. Made the bend near the 1800 metres awkwardly.	

SPEED CALL (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the early stages so was allowed to improve forward to lead approaching the 800 metres.

TINTINTINNIE (M Singh) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PUKEAKE STAR (D Hirini) – Hung outwards in the early stages, running wide on the track. Pulled up in the back straight when out of contention. When questioned the rider advised she had been unable to control the mare due to it's wayward tendencies. A post-race veterinary examination was clear. Connections were advised the mare must trial prior to starting next.

COG KNISH (R Elliot) - When questioned the rider advised the mare had not appreciated today's Heavy track conditions.

Race 2	NOELS BUILDING/BENCHTOP SURFACES 1550 (1550 Metres)

DOUBLE ACT (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced wide without cover throughout.

FRANCESCA KATE (C O'Beirne) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Briefly held up approaching the 600 metres then became awkwardly placed on the heels of DOUBLE ACT approaching the 400 metres, having to be steadied.

LINCOLN'S COMMAND (R Elliot) - Shifted in under pressure before being straightened near the 100 metres.

PASSING GLANCE (R Hannam) - When questioned into performance rider advised the mare may appreciate more ground.

Race 3	MARTIN BEVERIDGE LTD 1550 (1550 Metres)

SHEER ELEGANCE (M Singh) - Slow away. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Bumped 900 metres.

BAND (T Johnson) – Awkwardly away settling back. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages when wide without cover.

SWASHBUCKLER (D Hirini) – Jumped inwards at the start contacting HINEPARA before shifting out contacting KIWI PRINCESS.

KIWI PRINCESS (H Andrew) - Contacted at start then raced keenly in the early stages bumping SHEER ELEGANCE, which was also racing keenly near the 900 metres. Dictated out final stages when HINEPARA shifted out under pressure. Rider C O'Beirne was advised to straighten her mounts sooner than she did on this occasion.

FATTORE OTTO (J Parkes) – Slow away. Raced keenly for a distance near the 1200 metres. Restrained off heels near the 600 metres then disappointed for a run approaching the 400 metres to the inside of RED AURORA, having to be restrained, gaining clear running entering the home straight. When questioned J Parkes stated that he had attempted a marginal run which had closed approaching the 400 metres and after checking was unable to make any discernable ground over the final stages.

HINEPARA (C O'Beirne) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

C O'Beirne (HINEPARA) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was suspended from the close of racing on Saturday, 1 June up to and including racing on Thursday, 13 June (7 days).

Prior to the authorisation of dividends H Andrew the rider of KIWI PRINCESS viewed footage of the concluding stages but elected not to proceed with an objection.

Race 4	HEDLEY ELECTRICAL 1200 (1200 Metres)

WHITEOUT (S McKay) – Slow away.

TAVIS COURT (D Turner) - Began awkwardly bumping PAINLESS.

PAINLESS (S Collett) – Bumped start.

KING FAROUK (J Parkes) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had not appreciated today's Heavy 10 track conditions.

MY FATHER'S GUN (T Johnson) – Shifted in under pressure when racing greenly in the home straight, briefly inconveniencing PLATINUM APPEAL near the 200 metres. T Johnson was reminded to keep his mounts straight.

PLATINUM APPEAL (M Singh) – Briefly held up near the 400 metres. Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

T Johnson (MY FATHER'S GUN) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5	PRYDA 1200 (1200 Metres)

DAY DREAMER (S Collett) – Trainer P Mirabelli advised that the filly is in season but will start. Began awkwardly bumping SANCTUM. Raced wide throughout. When questioned into performance rider could offer no tangible excuse other than the filly being in season. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

SANCTUM (R Hannam) – Bumped start.

GRATUITY (R Myers) – Began awkwardly.

MAGGIE TEE (M Singh) - Tightened at the start when GRATUITY jumped inwards, settling back.

BREATH OF FIRE (A Jones) - Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip near the 200 metres inconveniencing PENNY O'CEIRIN.

PENNY O'CEIRIN (M Hudson) - Inconvenienced 200 metres.

HE'S DONE A RUNNER (J Parkes) - Lay in under pressure over the final stages.

EYES EN JEU (L Allpress) – When questioned into performance the rider advised the mare did not appreciate today's track conditions.

Race 6	PLACEMAKERS 1200 (1200 Metres)

LINCOLN'S GAL (S Collett) – Reared as the start was effected, hitting its head on the starting gates. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare had not handled today's Heavy track conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

THAT'S FUNNY (R Hannam) - Slow away.

BELLA PADOZA (A Jones) - Tightened and bumped at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

DEVINE LOVE (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained when making the bend near the 800 metres.

LAST CHANCE (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.

R Elliot (LAST CHANCE) – Was reprimanded after relaxing his ride short of the finish. Stewards were satisfied that his actions did not affect his finishing position on this occasion. Nevertheless, he was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts fully to the finish when able to do so.

BATTLE CREEK (S McKay) – Tightened when fading, after CLASSY LANE rolled in under pressure near the 400 metres.

Race 7	LAMINEX NZ 1400 (1400 Metres)

TENNESSEE ROSE (H Andrew) - Began awkwardly tightening MANOLO, then raced keenly in the early stages.

MANOLO (D Turner) - Tightened at the start getting back.

FLYING SURF (R Myers) - When questioned rider advised the filly had not appreciated today's Heavy track conditions.

Race 8	CARTERS 1550 (1500 Metres)
---------------	-----------------------------------

HE'S A FREAK (C O'Beirne) - Began awkwardly making contact with JOHNNY LINCOLN which jumped inwards settling back. Raced keenly in the early stages and when restrained shifted out dictating THE PUKETAPU LAD, which over-reacted, shifting out abruptly, contacting DEEP BLUE near the 900 metres. HE'S A FREAK continued to race keenly, shifting out to avoid heels approaching the 800 metres tightening THE PUKETAPU LAD.

JOHNNY LINCOLN (R Hannam) – Contacted start.

THE PUKETAPU LAD (D Hirini) – Dictated start then shifted out abruptly near the 900 metres. Tightened 800 metres.

ALLURE (E Wright) – Began awkwardly. Held up entering the home straight before being angled outwards across heels to improve, then disappointed for a run near the 200 metres.

DEEP BLUE (D Turner) – Hampered 900 metres. Rolled in under pressure over the final stages as TIRO improved quickly to its inside, with those runners coming together near the finish.

TIRO (C Johnson) – Bumped final stages. When questioned into his ride, C Johnson advised his instructions from connections were not to bustle the gelding in the early stages due to its prior breathing issues and had stayed wide on the track from his draw in search of better footing. C Johnson further noted the gelding had hung inwards rounding the turn but had finished the race off well despite being never comfortable in the going.
