Race 1	CSIOTA & CATERING SOUTH CANTERBURY MAIDEN 1200M
<p>SWEET PAINTED LADY (T Moseley) – Slow to begin and further hampered having to be steadied and losing ground when SMART GARDEN shifted inwards abruptly at the start. The connections were advised that a racing manners warning would be placed against the filly's record.</p> <p>WILORAI (B Murray) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>JEPEZZ GEORGE (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SMART GARDEN (J Fawcett) – Shifted inwards abruptly at the start, lay outwards throughout the final straight.</p> <p>BELLAROSINA (J Anderson) – Knuckled shortly after the start and made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>HEART OF FAME (B Morgenrood) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>VOUCH (S Muniandy) – Raced wide in the early stages, steadied off heels passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>MISS THUNDERBIRD (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>ARISTOTLE (J Lowry) – Rider reported that the gelding was less than genuine in its efforts today.</p>

<p>CLOONEY (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly and then hampered losing ground when inside runners shifted out at the start.</p> <p>NERO (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly, raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>MISTER MOCHA (K Chowdhoo) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MR TOOL (S Toolooa) – Raced very wide throughout.</p> <p>VAN HALEN (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>VIVA LA BURGUNDY (R Beeharry) – Steadied passing the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>ALEX (G Saejorhor) – Raced greenly in the final straight.</p>

BALLYBAY (B Murray) – Made the first bend awkwardly losing ground.

DRESSED TOKILL (C Barnes) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

MR TYPHON (K Chowdhury) – When questioned regarding performance, trainer M Pitman advised that the gelding had appreciated the firm nature of today's track.

Race 4 | **J. BALLANTYNE & CO. & LJ HOOKER GROUP DASH 1200M**

BON SHOWVI (J Fawcett) – Made heavy contact with TUFF GIRL on jumping away, shifted off its rightful running passing the 140 metres when SO NATURAL (R Beeharry) shifted outwards.

R Beeharry (SO NATURAL) admitted a breach of careless riding with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 3 January up to and including 10 January.

TUFF GIRL (M Kareem) – Made heavy contact with BON SHOWVI on jumping away.

SO NATURAL (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.

VINSANITY (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the early stages.

FESTIVAL PORPER (R Mudhoo) – Was shifted wider on the track passing the 900 metres when PICK ME UP IN RIO shifted off the heels of BON SHOWVI.

STARMAKER (G Jogoo) – Inclined to lay inwards passing the 70 metres and had to be straightened.

M Kareem (TUFF GIRL) was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

K Chowdhury (SWISS EIRE) was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

BB Hong (PINSHARP) was warned for unnecessary use of the whip.

Race 5 | **LASER ELECTRICAL TIMARU & PLANTORAMA MILE 1600M**

WHITNEY (S Toolooa) – Began very awkwardly losing considerable ground.

ZAH WANTED (T Moseley) – Blundered on jumping.

ULTRA CHIC (J Morris) – Began awkwardly, raced wide through the middle stages.

THE REAL DEAL (BB Hong) – Raced ungenerously through the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions. Rider reported that the gelding had hung throughout.

FRIDAY KNIGHT (R Beeharry) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.

DIORISSIMO (G Saejorhor) – Had to be angled wider on the track passing the 250 metres to find clear racing room.

SHOWPIN (C Campbell) – When questioned regarding the improved performance, the stable representative advised that the gelding had been better suited to a more favourable run today.

THOM BROWN (C Johnson) – Rider reported that the gelding had failed to let down on the firmer nature of today's track.

Race 6 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600M**

LADY BYRON (B Murray) – Began awkwardly losing ground, steadied passing the 50 metres when awkwardly placed between runners.

QUAINTRELLE (M Kareem) – Slow to begin, improved wide from the 550 metres.

MISS DIORELLA (C Campbell) – Raced wide in the early stages.

NIGELLA JAZZ (L Callaway) – Raced wide throughout, eased down over the concluding stages. The rider reported the mare to be indifferent in its action and in his opinion was feeling the firm nature of today's track. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities other than a slow recovery. Stewards will follow up with trainer S Blair-Edie in subsequent days.

UPSCALE (J Fawcett) – Over raced for a distance passing the 1100 metres and had to be restrained off heels with the trailing TAREE also having to be restrained at this point.

TAREE (T Moseley) – Restrained passing the 1100 metres.

MOSSY CREEK (C Barnes) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle stages of the run home and was again held up passing the 75 metres, not afforded clear running over the concluding stages.

Race 7 | **THE CRAIGMORE TIMARU CUP 1600M**

KIWI IDA (C Johnson) – Restrained to the rear on jumping, held up early in the run home. Rider reported that in his opinion the mare had failed to let down on the firm nature of today's track. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer of opinion mare may not have seen out the distance of today's race.

WILD JACK (A Bohorun) – Raced wide in the early and middle stages.

EL BEE DARCI (K Mudhoo) – Over raced passing the 1400 metres and made the bend awkwardly getting its head up on a number of occasions, placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when WILD JACK (A Bohorun) shifted inwards, lay inwards passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

A Bororun (WILD JACK) was warned for shifting ground passing the 1000 metres.

ABSOLUTE GOLD (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide throughout.

BOOTS 'N' ALL (J Lowry) shifted inwards passing the 200 metres and made contact with KOLONEL KEV.

GALLANT BOY (C Campbell) – Placed in restricted room in the final 50 metres when KOLONEL KEV was taken in by BOOTS 'N' ALL (J Lowry).

J Lowry (BOOTS 'N' ALL) was issued with a warning for shifting ground over the concluding stages.

Race 8 | **DOMINATOR DOORS & ONCEUPONATIME MAIDEN 1600 1600M**

There was a delay to the start of this race when BALANTO and MAH GIRL had to be resaddled and their riders were required to reweigh.

Trainer **M Daly** (BALANTO/MAH GIRL) admitted a breach in that he had been negligent in saddling, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

CEE SHARP (K Chowdhoo) – Began awkwardly throwing its head in the air and losing considerable ground.

WE BE JAMMIN (L Callaway) – Steadied shortly after the start. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding's right hind leg to have been galloped on.

SHAZ THE BANK (S Toolooa) – Raced greenly in the early stages.

SHOW 'N'GO (T Jonker) Shifted inwards shortly after the start.

T Jonker (SHOW 'N' GO) was warned for shifting ground

STIRLING LADY (C Campbell) – Clipped a heel and blundered passing the 1300 metres when **WE BE JAMMIN** (L Callaway) shifted in, badly unbalancing the rider who lost the use of the inside iron for some distance.

L Callaway (WE BE JAMMIN) defended a breach of careless riding passing the 1300 metres. After hearing evidence and submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the charge and suspended L Callaway's licence to ride at race meetings for 10 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 3 January up to and including 17 January.

BALANTO (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout.

PER FORM (B Murray) – Raced wide through the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance of this favoured runner, the rider advised that the mare may not have backed up from its previous start and had not let down on the firmer track today.

MAH GIRL (R Beeharry) – Held up in the early stages of the run home.

CANTERBURY LONG RUN ROOFING STAYERS 2100M

HEAD OFFICE (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly and got its head up when over racing through the early stages, continued to over race through the early to middle stages due to the lack of tempo.

FEROCIOUS (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide from the 1100 metres.
