RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1

TENACIOUS (R Hannam) – Gave ground passing the 800 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when well out of contention. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear. Trainer F Auret stated that the mare would no longer be considered a racing proposition from his stable.

Race 2

KING LOUIS (M Singh) - Raced wide on the pace throughout.

CASTANI (L Hemi) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight, having to be straightened near the 200 metres.

DIVINE POWER (L Allpress) – A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a small laceration to the left hind fetlock.

Race 3

RUSTY IN MELBOURNE (C Johnson) - Slow away. Held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres.

BELLISSIMO (D Turner) -Contacted at start when THE SEAGULL jumped inwards.

THE SEAGULL (S O'Malley) – Bumped start. When questioned rider reported the gelding had felt indifferent in its action in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

ESTEFANIA (C O'Beirne) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

Race 4

VIVA LA PLATINUM (M Singh) - Began awkwardly settling back.

THEWAYYOUMADEME (R Hannam) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Tightened near the 900 metres when AFTER YOU (C O'Beirne) shifted inwards. Rider C O'Beirne was advised to exercise greater care.

YEAH RIGHT (D Turner) – Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres.

FLORAL BELT (T Johnson) - Tightened having to be restrained approaching the 400 metres. After viewing footage and questioning riders it could not be conclusively established that D Turner (YEAH RIGHT) was solely responsible, nevertheless he was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Race 5

CRISTAL BUBBLE – Late scratching at 3.10pm on veterinary advice.

GO JAMES (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.

MARIETTA LANE (M Singh) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1000 metres, getting its head in the air.

SHOCKAINE (S O'Malley) – Got its head up for a short distance when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

COLORADO MISS (D Turner) - Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

Race 6

TOUT SUR MOI (D Turner) – Raced very ungenerously in the early stages, making the bend awkwardly near the 1800 metres., bounding and running wide on the track. Trainer L Latta advised that the mare would now be retired.

JAGUARY (H Durrant) - Raced ungenerously, running up on to the heels of VENETO when making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.

HYPATIA (Z Moki) - Held up behind the tiring CASINO EL JAY passing the 500 metres.

VENETO (C O'Beirne) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up for a distance rounding the home turn. Then angled outwards across heels approaching the 100 metres to improve. Stewards questioned Apprentice O'Beirne as to why she did not take a run one-off the fence in the home straight. Apprentice O'Beirne stated she had anticipated inward movement by STUNNING, which did eventuate, so angled her mount outwards in order to improve.

STUNNING (R Hannam) – Slow away. Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres.

Race 7

TENNESSEE ROSE (M Singh) – Tightened losing significant ground at the start when THATZ DAISY jumped outwards.

TIMES TICKING (J Parkes) – Lay inwards and briefly inconvenienced near the 200 metres before being angled outwards to improve, then raced greenly for a short distance.

THATZ DAISY (Z Moki) – Began awkwardly then hung throughout.

Race 8

The start of Race 8 was delayed by 2 minutes at the request of Raceday Control.

GOTTASECRET (L Hemi) – Slow away. When attempting a marginal run to the inside of PERAZZO near the 200 metres, made contact with that runner's hind quarters and shifted in, bumping BAND and unbalancing the rider for a short distance.

PUZZLAR (M Singh) - Began awkwardly, dictating RELDA outwards.

PERAZZO (C O'Beirne) – Shifted inwards near the 1400 metres tightening RELDA, WAR HERO and HEINEKEN HANK. After questioning riders and viewing footage the explanation of Apprentice C O'Beirne, that her mount had lay inwards throughout and shifted in further than she intended near the 1400 metres prior to being straightened, was accepted. When questioned into performance C O'Beirne reported that her mount lay in throughout.

RELDA (Z Moki) - Tightened 1400 metres.

WAR HERO (D Bradley) – Tightened 1400 metres. When questioned into performance, rider was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

HEINEKEN HANK (T Johnson) – Tightened 1400 metres. Rider dropped whip 200 metres.

TOP OFTHE STRAIGHT (C Johnson) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 600 metres, having to be restrained when a run to the inside of GOTTASECRET did not eventuate.

HOT PINS (R Hannam) - Raced wide without cover early then gave ground quickly from the 600 metres. When questioned rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormality.

DON'T KNOW JAKK (J Parkes) - Held up passing the 400 metres.
