RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GRAHAMSTOWN BAR & DINER 1200
SPOIL SPORT (S Spratt) – Knuckled on jumping away.	
TROUBLE (J Waddell) – Slow to begin.	

BOTHERED (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

ROCK STAR ROSIE (T Newman) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

RED MITZY (B R Jones) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

FIRODEN (R Smyth) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Had to be firmly restrained and shift in when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening RED MITZY near the 450 metres.

DAWNLIGHT (S Rusof) – Steadied after improving on to heels passing the 800 metres.

HATTIE BEE (M Cameron) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of TROUBLE which was taken out by SPOIL SPORT passing the 400 metres.

ANNE LANE (D Danis) – Became tailed off passing the 800 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight. Trainer was advised that the filly would be required to trial prior to racing next.

Race 2	KOPU ENGINEERING & KOPU MARINE 1200

CLEVERCONVERSATION (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

THE FLYING MULLET (C Lammas) – Crowded shortly after the start.

PRINCE SOLARI (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after having to be steadied.

NITRO (D Danis) – Raced keenly for a distance when being restrained approaching the 800 metres. Lay out under pressure in the final 200 metres.

CAUGHT THE EYE (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

ANOTHER CRAFTSMAN (S Spratt) – Raced greenly in the early stages becoming tailed off in the final straight finishing a distant last. The trainer was advised the gelding will be required to trial prior to racing next.

JET SET (S Rusof) – The trainer was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its barrier manners.

Race 3	NORMANS TRANSPORT – MORRINSVILLE 2200

GENERAL SHERMAN (T Harris) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

EASY WALKING (S Collett) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied to obtain cover through the early stages.

LUCKY DREAMER (L Satherley) – Briefly held up entering the final straight.

VENTURA (J Waddell) – Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 4	GOLDRIDGE MARINE FARM 1200

BELLINSKY (M Coleman) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after rearing over in its saddling stall receiving lacerations to the left side hip, hock and stifle and was declared a late scratching at 1.58 pm. BELLINSKY will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

I AM GRACIE (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly, and then was crowded shortly after. Held up for a distance when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres.

FULL OF TALENT (C Dell) – Began awkwardly shifting in making firm contact becoming briefly unbalanced losing ground.

ATHENREE ANGEL (L Innes) – Raced in restricted room for a distance shortly after the start. Lost the right front plate during the running.

EXPEDITION (T Yanagida) – Shifted out under pressure inconveniencing FULL OF GRACE passing the 100 metres.

Race 5	PAK N SAVE THAMES SPRINT
---------------	---------------------------------

ROSE BOWL (L Allpress) – Blundered badly on jumping away. Went off stride passing the 800 metres. Raced wide without cover throughout. Rider reported the mare felt indifferent in its action and was not persevered with passing the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination found the mare to be 2/5 lame in the right hind with a veterinary certificate of fitness now required prior to racing again.

PINK GRAFFITI (L Innes) – Began awkwardly. Held up for clear running until shifting out across heels near the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

DAMA ZORRO (M McNab) – Held up entering the final straight until obtaining clear running near the 300 metres. Lost the left front plate during the running.

BRAVISSIMO (J Fawcett) – Held up passing the 350 metres until shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

BEYOND DISPUTE (M Cameron) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils with a post-race veterinary inspection confirming the gelding to have bled. BEYOND DISPUTE is now subject to the mandatory two month stand down from being in training and three month stand down from trialing or racing with a veterinary clearance required prior to trialing or racing next.

Race 6	VERSATILE HOMES 1400

ACUTUS (J Bayliss) – Slow to begin.

MALLORY SQUARE (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

LOWRIDER (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

LUCIDITY (J McDonald) – Commenced to lay in under pressure passing the 300 metres with LOWRIDER shifting away from that runner taking in MALLORY SQUARE which had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ACUTUS. Rider advised that the mare would appreciate some easing of the ground and in his opinion is looking to run 1600 metres.

MALLORY SQUARE (S Collett) Steadied 300 metres.

The connections of the second placed horse ITS DESTINY'S CHILD lodged a protest alleging interference by the first placed horse MORRIE OCK near the 200 metres. After hearing all relevant evidence and viewing the videotapes the protest was dismissed and the Judge's placings stand.

Race 7	COASTWOOD HOMES LOCKWOOD THAMES CUP

VALANTE (S McKay) – Knuckled on jumping away. Improved on to the heels of TRUE ENOUGH shifting out forcing LADYNADEL to a three wide position near the 1100 metres with LADYNADEL then racing three wide without cover.

BEAUMARCHAIS (O Bosson) – Slow to begin.

MAZZURO (S Rusof) – Slow to begin. When shifting out across heels to obtain clear running made contact with **ALIGNS WITH ME** near the 150 metres.

RONDINELLA (R Elliot) – Had to shift inwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

TRUE ENOUGH (J McDonald) – Was inclined to lay out throughout the race.

Race 8	TWENTYMANS FUNERAL SERVICES 1600

JOJO ROXX (T Yanagida) – Slow to begin.

TAY TAY (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

SWITCH PITCHER (S Rusof) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied near the 1400 metres shifting in passing the 1200 metres severely hampering **FELICITY ANNE** with rider J Fawcett becoming unbalanced and losing the use of her left stirrup iron for a distance. Hampered as a result was **LOUIS LE GRAND**, **SIR AGLOVALE** and **MR SCALLYWAG**, with **SWITCH PITCHER** continuing to over-race fiercely for a distance further hampering **FELICITY ANNE** near the 900 metres which shifted out forcing **LOUIS LE GRAND** wider on the track. A warning was placed against the mare for its racing manners. Trainer advised that he would make some gear adjustments in an endeavor to improve the mare's racing manners.

SIR AGLOVALE (S Spratt) - Hampered 1200 metres.

MR SCALLYAG (L Satherley) – Hampered 1200 metres.

FELICITY ANNE (J Fawcett) – Severely hampered 1200 metres and 900 metres. Hung out around the final bend placing **MR SCALLYWAG** in restricted room. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a minor skin laceration to the medial upper left hind cannon.

LOUIS LE GRAND (J Bayliss) – Hampered 1200 metres and 900 metres.

FAZIOLI (L Innes) – Lost both hind plates during the running.

Race 9	FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1600
---------------	---------------------------------

MISSTUMUT (A Goindasamy) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Hampered losing ground passing the 400 metres between **GRANDE AMICI** and **TANTALISING** when both those runners shifted ground.

DANELYN (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

THIS IS ME (C Dell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EN SOIE (C Lamas) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 400 metres shifting out crowding **QUEEN SWEEP** on to the hind quarters of **KIWIANNA** with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.

MR WOODI (T Miles) – Held up around the final bend until approaching the 200 metres.

GRANDE AMICI (B R Jones) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres. Held up around the final bend until passing the 250 metres.

SPIRITED (L Satherley) – Held up until shifting in passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.
