Apprentice J Fawcett did not attend the meeting due to illness and is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BELL BOOTH/PLASMA BIOTEC PREMIER (1550 Metres)
BRING TO THE BLOCK (L Hemi) - Over-raced in the early to middle stages.	
PIECE OF KATE (S Rusof) - Gave ground quickly passing the 600 metres and was retired from the race before collapsing near the 300 metres. PIECE OF KATE was immediately attended to by the veterinarian and was found to be	

deceased suffering a fatal haemorrhage likely to be an aortic rupture.

ARIDITY (D Bradley) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after kicking out and making contact with a fence leaving the birdcage, being passed fit to race Held up entering the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting outwards across the heels of FATHER LENIHAN passing the 100 metres.

D Bradley (ARIDITY) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount outwards when not sufficiently clear of VIKTOR VEGAS, which was checked near the 100 metres. After hearing submissions D Bradley had his licence to ride in races suspended from the close of racing on Monday, 7 January up to and including racing on Tuesday, 15 January 2019 (5 days).

VIKTOR VEGAS (L Allpress) – Checked near 100 metres.

Race 2	VETMED PREMIER (1400 Metres)
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SIR NATE (J Riddell) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after kicking out and making contact with a fence in the birdcage, being passed fit to race.

PETRABELLA (L Innes) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the filly may have a respiratory issue. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 3	NZ REAL ESTATE PREMIER (1400 Metres)
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UGO FOSCOLO (S Rusof) – Late scratching at 1.22 pm after failing to parade to the start, the stable representative was advised that the gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of a stipendiary steward prior to racing again.

HENI (D Hirini) - Required farrier attention at the start after casting the right front plate.

VINCENT (M Singh) – Slow away then continued to lose ground in the early stages. Held up when disappointed for a run near the 150 metres.

KILLARNEY (R Elliot) – Held up rounding the final turn, then having to be steadied when disappointed for a run near the 200 metres before shifting inwards across the heels of DARSCAPE PRINCESS to gain clear running, with the gelding shifting in further than anticipated. R Elliot was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Race 4	FARMLANDS MARTON CONGRATULATES EVAN DIX ON TURNING 100 (1400 Metres)
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HOT FUSS (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ROCKONEVE (L Allpress) – Slow away.

MCPHOEBE (S McKay) – Blundered badly leaving the barriers.

GOBUYIT (D Turner) - Raced three wide without cover.

SHE'S NOT BAD (S Rusof) - Held up entering the final straight making contact with GOBUYIT when attempting to obtain clear running near the 350 metres then continuing to be held up before having to be further restrained passing the 200 metres and did not obtain clear running until near the 150 metres.

THE RIPPA (J Riddell) - Held up rounding the final turn before obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.

L Innes (IFFINDOUBT) – Charged with careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear, forcing MISS CONTESSA inwards across the heels of MCPHOEBE near the 250 metres. After initially advising that he did not admit the breach, during the course of the hearing L Innes requested to change his plea to

admit the breach, which was accepted by the judicial committee. After hearing submissions L Innes was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 5th January up to and including racing on Friday, 18 January (7 national riding days).

MISS CONTESSA (M Singh) – Forced inwards across the heels of MCPHOEBE, having to be checked near the 250 metres, with some minor contribution from MCPHOEBE, which shifted out marginally when struck with the whip, then being unable to gain clear running for the remainder of the race.

AKOYA PEARL (Z Moki) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight then being further held up when improving on to the heels of MISS CONTESSA near the 250 metres.

Race 5	CENTRAL ITM PREMIER (1200 Metres)
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CASAQUINMAN (D Turner) – Slow away.

HANGER (L Innes) - Made contact with the hind quarters of ALL IN MANA when attempting to obtain clear running near the 300 metres with ALL IN MANA being turned inwards. HANGER then raced in restricted room to the inside of ALL IN MANA for a distance before obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

ALL IN MANA (L Allpress) – Unbalanced when hind quarters contacted near the 300 metres.

PEACEFUL (R Elliot) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had never really travelled comfortably in a fast run race and in his opinion would be better suited to some easing of the ground. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 6	SPREADING RURAL BULK PREMIER (2100 Metres)
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SHARED SECRETS (L Innes) - Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious to undergo a veterinary inspection and passed fit to run. Slow away. Shifted outwards to obtain clear running hampering NITRO TED near the 150 metres.

NITRO TED (B Grylls) - Hampered 150 metres.

LEADING ROLE (J Riddell) - Restrained early after jumping from a wide barrier to obtain cover.

RED CLOUD (J Parkes) – Had to be steadied briefly shortly after the start when LADY PAINTON (S Rusof) shifted in when not clear of REAL BEACH, which in turn shifted into the line of RED CLOUD. S Rusof was issued with a warning.

LINCOLN STAR (R Hannam) - Hung outwards making the first bend awkwardly.

ABACUS (S McKay), **REAL BEACH** (D Turner), **KAMANDA LINCOLN** (S Collett), **NITRO TED** (B Grylls) and **RED CLOUD** (J Parkes) were all steadied going into and rounding the first turn due to the lack of early speed in the race.

REAL BEACH (D Turner) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

OFF WITH HER HEAD (Z Moki) – Wide for the majority of the race.

LADY PAINTON (S Rusof) - Held up approaching the 200 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (S Collett) – Held up near the 200 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

Race 7	GALLAGHER MARTON CUP (Listed Race) (2200 Metres)
<p>PORCELAIN PRINCESS (M Singh) – Slow away.</p> <p>JACKSSTAR (L Innes) – Slow away.</p> <p>PETITE EN JEU (L Hemi) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>ALINKO PRINCE (C Johnson) – Racing keenly in the middle stages. Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>DUPLICITY (R Elliot) – When attempting to improve forward approaching the 600 metres jostled with ALINKO PRINCE.</p> <p>MENTAL TELEPATHY (L Allpress) - Was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight, then having to be steadied over the concluding stages when improving on to the heels of CHINA STAR.</p> <p>SAMPSON (J Parkes) - Had to steady off heels near the 400 metres and when doing so went back on to PORCELAIN PRINCESS.</p> <p>BALHAM (B Grylls) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in her opinion the gelding may be better suited to some easing of the ground.</p>

<p>BELLA MARGARITA (R Hannam) – Slow away.</p> <p>WHATSUP (S McKay) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>ABBEY ROAD (Z Moki) - Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.</p> <p>PAINT THE TOWN (J Waddell) – Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.</p>
