**TONADILLAS** (M Cameron) – Trainer S Ramsey advised that in the days following this race the gelding underwent blood tests which revealed it to be suffering from tie up. Mr Ramsey further advised that the gelding would now be sent for a brief spell.

**SO WICKED** (S Collett) – Trainer S Marsh advised that the mare has now been sent for a spell.

**Race 2 THE HITS R72 1000M**

**DIVINE POWER** (L Allpress) – Trainer K Gray advised that the mare has now been sent for a spell.

**Race 2 VETMED PREMIER (1400 Metres)**

**PETRABELLA** (L Innes) – Trainer M Murdoch advised that in the days following this race the filly underwent a veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which revealed a throat infection, adding that PETRABELLA has since been treated for this and would be sent for a spell.

**Race 2 KAPITI SIGNS 800 (800 Metres)**

**RHAEGAR** (J Parkes) – Trainer A Forsman advised that the gelding has now been sent for spell.

**VISTOCK** (L Allpress) - Slow away. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**ROSARITO** (M Singh) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**THE FUGITIVE** (J Parkes) - Raced greenly crossing the junction onto the course proper.

**AMAZING TEAM** (R Elliot) - Briefly raced in restricted room near the 400 metres.

**PLATINUM TOUCH** (R Hannam) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in his opinion the filly was feeling the effects of its debut run and felt flat today.

Track Upgraded to Good (3) retrospective to Race 1.

**Race 2** | **WILLIMENT TRAVEL GROUP PREMIER (1200 Metres)**

**GRAND MAYSON** (J Waddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**ALL IN MANA** (L Allpress) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained in the middle stages improving onto heels approaching the 600 metres having to be further restrained and when doing so shifted outwards making contact with **PADDY BOURKE**, which was hampered and forced wider.

**PADDY BOURKE** (T Johnson) - Hampered and forced wider when bumped near the 600 metres.

**COMEBACK** (R Elliot) - Steadied when improving onto heels just short of the finish.

**MORWEKA** (M Cameron) - Lay out making the junction onto the course proper awkwardly.

**WINDSOR** (J Parkes) - Had to be restrained over the final stages to avoid the heels of **GRAND MAYSON** which shifted inwards.

**J Waddell** (**GRAND MAYSON**) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards passing the 100 metres into the line of the weakening **WINDSOR**, which had to be steadied to avoid that runners heels.

**PITCH AND SWITCH** - Lost the left front plate during the running.

**Race 3** | **VALE JOHN TANNAHILL PREMIER (1400 Metres)**

**OZIL** (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly.

**THATS AMORE** (R Hannam) - Slow away. Rider reported that the mare may be better suited to more rain-affected going.

**LITE MY CIGAR** (O Bosson) - Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

**Race 4** | **HARRISONS CARPET PREMIER (1400 Metres)**

**AWATANE** (S O'Malley) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

**MISS CONTESSA** (M Singh) - Steadied when placed in restricted room between **O'HE CAN** and **AWATANE** near the 900 metres.

**LUCYINRIO** (J Waddell) - Held up rounding the final turn. Following the race rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action on pulling with a post-race veterinary inspection finding the mare to have lost the left hind plate.

**HENREE WINKLER** (O Bosson) - Lay in early in the home straight. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

**O'HE CAN** (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding was feeling the effects of recent racing, with trainer S Marsh indicating that the gelding would now be sent for a spell. A post-race veterinary inspecting revealed **O'HE CAN** to be displaying 1/5 lameness in the right foreleg.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>HANLEY FORMULA PREMIER (2100 Metres)</b>
<p><b>TROUP ROAD</b> (D Turner) - Declared a late scratching at 3.09pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious and getting down in its barrier. Connections were advised that TROUP ROAD must barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>RED RASCAL</b> (C Johnson) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>COTTONEVA</b> (T Johnson) - Raced ungenerously after having to be steadied to avoid heels approaching the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>WAISAKE</b> (S Collett) - Held up from near the 600 metres before being angled inwards to gain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>CANDY CROSS</b> (C O'Beirne) - Was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.</p> <p><b>COLLINSTREET</b> (J Parkes) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>T Johnson</b> (COTTONEVA) - Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres being was fined the sum of \$300.</p> <p><b>SERENITY</b> (L Hemi) - Returned to the enclosure showing signs of lameness which upon veterinary examination the mare was found to have suffered a significant tendon injury to the left foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required before SERENITY races again.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BARNESWOOD FARM TRENTAM STAKES, Group III (2100 Metres)</b>
<p><b>CHANCE TO DANCE</b> (O Bosson) - Inconvenienced leaving the barriers when CONSENSUS shifted outwards.</p> <p><b>HUNTA PENCE</b> (J Parkes) - Blundered leaving the barriers then being further hampered</p> <p><b>HIGH QUALITY</b> (S O'Malley) -Raced in restricted room passing the 2000 metres to the inside of ANIMATOR which lay in away from CHANCE TO DANCE.</p> <p><b>CHANCE TO DANCE</b> (O Bosson) - Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.</p> <p><b>HANK MOODY</b> (L Allpress) - Briefly held up near the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>ANIMATOR</b> (R Myers) - Raced three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres. Hung inwards in the home straight and was unable to be ridden to full advantage.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>FUSION ELECTRICAL LEVIN CLASSIC, Group I (1600 Metres)</b>
<p><b>LINCOLN FALLS</b> (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly settling back. Tightened over the final stages when runners to either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>AUTUMN FLASH</b> (C Johnson) - Raced keenly for a distance from the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>ARROGANT</b> (J Bayliss) - Held up passing the 400 metres and continued having difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres. Received post-race veterinary treatment for a superficial wound to the left hind leg.</p> <p><b>MADISON COUNTY</b> (M Cameron) - Held up rounding the final turn and had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 300 metres.</p>	

**MORE WONDER** (L Allpress) - Slow away. Commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 1200 metres. Held up entering the home straight then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BIT LIPPY which shifted inwards slightly, resulting in MORE WONDER having to be steadied for a distance when continuing to be badly held up before being angled outwards abruptly to obtain clear running near the 200 metres. MORE WONDER was inclined to lay inwards for the remainder of the race. When questioned regarding her riding tactics, L Allpress advised that with the gelding having over-raced in its recent starts, she had ridden the gelding quietly early in an attempt to get it to settle and had then not had an opportunity to improve her position prior to entering the final straight where she had felt that a run may be about to open up towards the inner, which had failed to eventuate, then opting to shift her mount wider to obtain clear running.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>TUI - BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 ANNIVERSARY HANDICAP, Group III (1600 Metres)</b>

**KOLONEL KEV** (M Cameron) - Awkwardly away.

**BEEFEATER** (O Bosson) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 400 metres when weakening, then was not persevered with over the final 200 metres when well beaten. When questioned, rider was unable to offer any excuses. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**DOLCETTO** (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover.

**WYNDSPELLE** (J Parkes) - Held up entering the home straight having difficulty obtaining clear running until the 200 metres.

**CAMINO ROCOSO** (M Coleman) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

**UGO FOSCOLO** (R Elliot) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>BLUESTAR PREMIER (1600 Metres)</b>

**WHENHARRYMETSADDLE** (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly.

**ROLL THE GOLD** (J Bayliss) - Held up entering the home straight making contact with the weakening OHCEEDEE when angling for a run near the 300 metres. Raced in restricted room when attempting to improve into a tight run passing the 100 metres then having to be checked near the 50 metres when PORTLAND JIMMY lay in and away from SAVAPAK, which when attempting to improve to the inside of JESSIEGEE (R Myers) was taken in by that runner with rider R Myers taking corrective action.

**SAVAPAK** (J Waddell) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight then held up near the 200 metres. Inconvenienced when improving into a tight run near the 50 metres.

**PORTLAND JIMMY** (J Parkes) - Was inclined to lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.

**CHOICE ATTITUDE** (C O'Beirne) - Raced in restricted room over the final 50 metres.

**OHCEEDEE** (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse other than the gelding being better suited to more rain-affected conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
