Race 1	BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES MAIDEN 1810M
<p>REMEDY (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>FREIGHTMAN (T Jonker) – Shifted in abruptly at the start crowding inside runners. Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>OUR BOY BAZ (B Murray) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>NATHAN DETROIT (T Moseley) - Crowded at the start and lost ground. Awkward on heels passing the 100 metres when questioned about the performance the rider reported that the gelding had failed to quicken when placed under full pressure.</p> <p>MONDORANI (D Hirini) – Hampered at the start. Lay in throughout the run home.</p> <p>RIDE THE STORM (K Chowdhooey) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p>TRANSCENDENT (D Prastiyou) – Rider warned for use of his whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 2	TOM MILNE MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1810M
<p>PAINTED ANGEL (T Comignahi) – Began awkwardly. Keen early. Hampered by fallen runner.</p> <p>PRODUCER (T Jonker) - Slow to begin. Hampered by fallen runner.</p> <p>KALIPER (D Prastiyou) – Keen early stages.</p> <p>MORENA ROC ((Z Bholah) – Lay inwards passing the 1600 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KAPIPA clipping a heel, blundering with the rider being dislodged and the rider bringing the horse down. Post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>PLUSHENKO (G Jogoo) - Hampered by fallen runner.</p> <p>TAVISTELLA (R Mudhoo) - Badly hampered by fallen runner.</p> <p>Due to the rider still being on the track and being attended to by the St Johns Paramedics the race was abandoned. Rider Z Bholah was transported to Greymouth Hospital for further observation</p>	
Race 3	VERSATILE WEST COAST 1810M
<p>The start of this event was delayed one race due to ambulance staff attending to the injured rider with all races going back one race.</p> <p>BLANCO BAY (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>QUAINTRELLE (K Chowdhooey) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>LITTLE BOSSING (G Saejorhor) – Began very awkwardly. Over raced early stages and was placed in restricted room having to be shifted outwards to avoid heels passing the 1300 metres. Raced wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>BRAKBAR (K Cowan) – Keen early.</p>	

EN SUITE (D Hirini) – Improved wide from the 700 metres.

FISHERMANS BLUES (S Jamie) – S Jamie replaced T Comignaghi due to a communication misunderstanding. Made contact with the running rail near the 400 metres becoming unbalanced and had to be steadied losing momentum.

WESTERLY – connections reported that the mare was displaying poor post race recovery. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be a bleeder. The connections were advised that a 3 month stand down plus veterinary clearance is required. Connections advised the mare would now be retired.

Trainer K Moore warned for presenting his runner late to the birdcage.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

DR PEPPER (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.

ALL ABOUT ROY (R Mudhoo) – Shifted out at the start and was crowded and buffeted between runners passing the 1100 metres.

RAFF (D Prastiyou) – Shifted inwards passing the 800 metres. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

MANHATTAN FIRE (G Jogoo) – Fractious in the barrier rearing requiring assistance. Buffeted for a short distance passing the 800 metres when crowded by RAFF.

TITANIUM JACK (K Asano) – Buffeted for a short distance passing the 800 metres when crowded by RAFF.

CAR PIE (D Hirini) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 5	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1150M

SHARP 'N' SILVER (D Prastiyou) – Fractious in the barriers rearing requiring assistance.

PUSHYALUCK (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

FRENCH CUT (T Jonker) – Keen early.

ROSIE MARIE (D Hirini) – Keen early.

JUST ANOTHER DAY (K Mudhoo) – Steadied passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed in between runners. Made contact with outside runner passing the 150 metres when shifting ground to take a tight run and then had to be steadied away from heels.

PLATINUM RAIDER (K Asano) – Lay inwards and shifted inwards passing the 700 metres placing NELLIE BLY and JUST ANOTHER DAY in restricted room. Contributing movement was outward movement from BELLAROSINA.

K Asano was warned for shifting ground.

FUNNY FACE (S Jamie) – Raced wide throughout and shifted wider on the home turn.

NELLIE BLY (K Chowdhoo) – Lay inwards early in the home straight.

BELLAROSINA (G Jogoo) - Made contact with inside runner passing the 150 metres.

Race 6	RECREATION HOTEL 1150M
<p>PRAWN STAR (S Jamie) – Declared a late scratching at 3.56pm by the order of the stewards, after escaping rider-less and galloping for a considerable distance. S Jamie was examined by the St Johns paramedics and found to be suffering from foot injury. S Jamie was instructed she must have a medical clearance prior to riding next.</p> <p>NOPELE (K Cowan) – Pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race. Began awkwardly losing ground. Got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>IT'S PANDEMONIUM (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>WAY TO EASY (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>BON SHOVI (G Saejorhor) – Gave ground from the 600 metres. Connections advised it is their intention to retire the mare as a racing proposition.</p> <p>LA ROCCETTA (T Jonker) – Improved quickly onto the heels of HAPI ELLA passing the 75 metres and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.</p> <p>Following this event the track was up graded to a Dead 5.</p>	
Race 7	ALEX HAYWARD/NOEL WAFER POW MEMORIAL 1810M
<p>LONGFORD (B Murray) – Slow to begin. Raced wide the early stages before improving to sit outside the leader at the 1200 metres. Shifted inwards 350 metres. B Murray was warned for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>EM KAY POPS (K Chowdhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide from 1000 metres. Further hampered shortly after when placed in restricted room when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>SMOKE HOUSE BAY (A Comignaghi) – Checked passing the 1450 metres when awkwardly placed between runners.</p> <p>LIL MISS SWISS (G Saejorhor) – Made the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>CHIC (D Hirini) – Improved wide from 700 metres.</p> <p>TWO THIRTY (T Moseley) – Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>GOLDEN BAY (K Cowan) – Wide throughout.</p> <p>SHE'STOOHOTTOTROT (T Jonker) - Steadied passing the 350 metres when awkwardly placed in restricted room when LONGFORD shifted inwards.</p> <p>B Murray was warned for the manner in which he shifted ground.</p>	
Race 8	VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS KUMARA GOLD NUGGETS 1810M
<p>TIMMY TYLER (K Chowdhoo) – K Chowdhoo replaced Z Bholah – injured.</p> <p>OVERTHERIVER (D Hirini) – Restrained to the rear on jumping. Improved wide from the 1000 metres. D Hirini warned for whip use prior to 100 metres.</p> <p>K Myers was reminded of his obligations when removing blinkers in the birdcage.</p> <p>FLYING SARDINE (R Mudhoo) – Was steadied passing the 1600 metres. Held up early in the run home and had to be shifted outwards across heels passing the 200 metres to find clear racing.</p>	

THE GORDONIAN (K Mudhoo) – Rider lost whip passing the 200 metres. Had to be shifted inwards at this point to find clear racing room.

Trainer J Gordon was reminded of her obligations when removing blinkers in the birdcage.

DARCI MAC (K Mudhoo) – K Mudhoo replaced B Murray due to dehydration. Medical Certificate required.

Trainers L & R Didham were reminded of their obligations when removing blinkers in the birdcage.

WHAT'S UP ALF (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Over raced in the early stages and had to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.
