Race 1	WAIREPO HEREFORD STUD HURDLE 2750m
<p>JACKFROST (J Lowry) – Made a poor leap at the first fence with the rider losing the use of both his irons for a short distance. Hit the last fence hard.</p> <p>BANBURY LAD (S Higgins) – Steadied away from the heels of a tiring runner passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>BOYSWAY (S Karnicnik) – Put in a poor leap at the fence by the 600 metres.</p> <p>SHEEZOFF (T Moki) – Put in a poor leap at the second last fence.</p> <p>THE ENERGIZER (J Seivwright) – Put in a poor leap and fell at the last fence dislodging its rider. Rider was cleared by the on course paramedic with the gelding undergoing a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed it was lame in the right foreleg with the connections being advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.</p>	

Race 2	WAIREPO HEREFORD STUD STP 3200m
<p>ADEQUACY (S Karnicnik) – Poor leap at the fence near the 2000 metres.</p> <p>IRISH DUDE (T Moki) – Poor leap at the fence near the 2000 metres. Lost its footing and fell on entering the back straight dislodging its rider.</p> <p>GO GO GONZO (G Walsh) – Poor leap at the fence near the 2000 metres.</p> <p>PADDY OWEN (S Higgins) – Poor leap at the fence near the 2000 metres. Lost its footing and fell on entering the back straight dislodging its rider.</p> <p>REGALO REAAL (M Gillies) – Poor leap at the fence near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>DELACROIX (J Seivwright) – Poor leap at the last fence.</p> <p>Prior to authorisation of placings Stewards reviewed footage of the flag start and were satisfied that ADEQUACY had not gained an unfair advantage at the start.</p>	
Race 3	SOUTHERN WIDE REALTY 1100m
<p>SHELBY DEVINE (C Campbell) – Was fractious in the barriers and began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>KITTY POWER (K Chowdhoo) – Got its head up when being restrained passing the 900 metres due to the lack of tempo in the race.</p>	
Race 4	DIAMOND SYNDICATE MAIDEN 2200m
<p>SOUTHERN ISOLATION (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Gave ground passing the 800 metres finishing in a distant last position. The connections were informed the mare must be more competitive in future starts.</p> <p>MACPAC (T Jonker) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously for a short distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SHOCK AND AWE (R Beeharry) – Raced keenly early stages.</p> <p>POWER PUNCH (K Kwo) – Raced wide early before being taken wide to the lead.</p> <p>STEELE CANYON (B Murray) – Shifted outwards approaching the 300 metres making firm contact with CHOOKIE’S GIRL.</p> <p>CHOOKIE’S GIRL (J Lowry) – Bumped passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>BB Hong (PEGGY STEWART) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the JCA suspending his licence from the conclusion of racing on 3 June up to and including 15 June (7 days).</p>	
Race 5	DUNEDIN PRINT 2200m
<p>IT’S PANDEMONIUM (G Saejorhor) – Got its head up on a number of occasions when racing keenly and wide in the early stages. Taken forward to assume the lead passing the 900 metres. When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance of this runner trainer S Tyler advised the Stewards he had made a change to the mare’s training regime.</p> <p>RIDING HIGH (C Barnes) – Over raced for a distance passing the 1600 metres and had to be steadied away from heels and in doing so forced SIR ED wider on the track for a short distance.</p> <p>SLAMMER (J Lowry) – When spoken to regarding the performance rider advised that he got too far back from a wide draw with the gelding having battled on fairly.</p> <p>BABY MENAKA (T Comignaghi) – When spoken to regarding performance rider advised the mare failed to handle today’s testing track conditions.</p>	
Race 6	MAKE A SPLASH AT WINGATUI CHARITY MAIDEN 1200m
<p>D Crozier – Fined \$50 for presenting BATTLE MAN without notified gear – side winkers.</p> <p>BATTLE MAN (B Murray) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was declared fit to start.</p>	

FAUX PAS (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and lost ground.

MAKS LEGEND (C Johnson) – Shifted in at the start crowding inside runners.

LADY DAVONE (J Fawcett) – Shifted out at the start crowding outside runners.

STOP MAKING SENSE (R Beeharry) – Crowded at the start and got back.

NOAH (J Laking) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

DOUGH BOY (T Jonker) – Placed in restricted room and bumped from the inside by STOP MAKING SENSE who shifted out looking for clear racing room.

DUNDEE FLAG (T Comignaghi) – Bumped from the inside passing the 350 metres and then lay in for a short distance in the run home.

HERMANO ROSE (K Mudhoo) – Hampered between runners shortly after the start and over raced for a short distance.

HIGHLAND LADY (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly through the early stages and wide without cover throughout.

MYLUCKYMAY (K Kwo) – Steadied momentarily passing the 850 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of UBETIAM.

Race 8	WHITE ROBE LODGE 1400m

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin. Bumped with OUT OF ACES passing the 600 metres.

AMOUR LA VIE (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Held up throughout the run home having to shift ground outwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

OUT OF ACES (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly. Bumped with WHISKEY IN THE JAR passing the 600 metres.

OUR BOY BAZ (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

MONSERRAT (J Lowry) – Held up early in the home straight having to change ground to find clear racing room.

STIRLING LADY (C Campbell) – Held up early in the home straight and not persevered with over the concluding stages. Rider reported that the filly had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities and stewards will follow up with the connections in the following days.

DOUBLE DOWN (K Mudhoo) – Rider reported that the mare was not entirely comfortable in today's heavy 11 track conditions.
