Apprentice Rider Z Moki advised she was unable to attend today's meeting.

**RACE COMMENTS:**

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NOBBY BUSSELL MEMORIAL TWO-YEAR-OLD (800 metres)</b>
<p><b>MISS FEDERER</b> (K Williams) – The start was delayed when MISS FEDERER required farrier attention. When being remounted MISS FEDERER reared and dislodged K Williams who was attended to by ambulance staff before being declared fit to ride.</p> <p><b>KHITAN WARRIOR</b> (T Moseley) – Crowded start. Made contact with SHELBY DEVINE passing the 500 metres. Held up entering the final straight.</p> <p><b>GINNY</b> (B Murray) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>SHELBY DEVINE</b> (C Barnes) – Made contact with KHITAN WARRIOR passing the 500 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>RANGIORA NEW WORLD RATING 65 (2000 metres)</b>
<p><b>SITARIST</b> (E Wright) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages. Hampered and forced wider near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>HATRICK BOYS</b> (S Collett) – Blundered leaving the barriers losing ground. Improved forward to race outside the leader near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>METASEQUOIA</b> (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.</p> <p><b>YAMATO NADESHIKO</b> (T Jonker) – Made the crossing awkwardly near the 1800 metres unbalancing the rider. Improved onto heels approaching the 100 metres shifting out to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>BRIDGET TOWN</b> (J Fawcett) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p><b>WAGNER</b> (B Murray) – Raced wide in the early stages. Hampered and forced wider near the 800 metres. Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres by SACRED DELIGHT (J Bayliss) which shifted out when looking to obtain clear running. J Bayliss was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p><b>SEBRING DRAGON</b> (C Campbell) – Raced ungenerously approaching the 1200 metres when the pace eased.</p> <p><b>PICKUP</b> (T Moseley) – Raced ungenerously approaching the 1200 metres when the pace eased.</p> <p><b>R Mudhoo</b> (PAMIR) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards near the 800 metres when insufficiently clear WAGNER and SITARIST which were both hampered and forced wider.</p> <p><b>SACRED DELIGHT</b> (J Bayliss) – Held up in the early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>SULCIFERA</b> (G Saejorhor) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>AUTO EXPRESS WASH RATING 72 (1600 metres)</b>
<p><b>RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT</b> (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>GALWAY GARRY</b> (B Murray) – Blundered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p><b>O'KIWI</b> (T Comignaghi) – Hampered leaving the barriers.</p>	

**FORGED** (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Crowded 1100 metres and then raced in restricted room for a distance.

**L Allpress** (BULLY BOY) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards approaching the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of FORGED which was crowded and then raced in restricted room for a distance.

**FIRE LILY** (S Jamie) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Shifted out passing the 800 metres making contact with RICHARD OF YORKE and then becoming badly placed on the hindquarters of DIRECTOR which was severely hampered.

**RICHARD OF YORKE** (C Campbell) – Hampered when contacted 800 metres. Contacted over the concluding stages.

**S Jamie** (FIRE LILY) – Admitted a breach of careless riding after permitting FIRE LILY to shift outwards near the 800 metres striking the hindquarters of DIRECTOR which was severely hampered. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Jamie's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 12 October up to and including 27 October 2018, 12 national riding days. S Jamie is to receive intense training from Apprentice Jockey mentor D Walsh and her employer L Robinson.

**DIRECTOR** (J Laking) – Severely hampered near the 800 metres when galloped on before being eased down by its rider. DIRECTOR was quickly attended to by the on-course veterinarian and humanely euthanised after suffering a severed flexor tendon of the left hind limb as a result of being galloped on.

**WIDE AWAKE** (S Collett) – Become awkwardly placed when improving onto heels near the 200 metres before shifting out to obtain clear running. Steadied when crowded over the concluding stages making contact with RICHARD OF YORKE when BULLY BOY (L Allpress) shifted out slightly. L Allpress was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>INGLEWOOD STUD GUINEAS TRIAL (1400 metres)</b>
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**WILLIAM JAMES** (S Muniandy) – Slow to begin. Hampered 1350 metres. Over-raced in the middle stages when the pace steadied. S Muniandy advised that the gelding had been unsuited by the slow tempo of the race.

**ARISTOTLE** (S Collett) – Slow to begin, raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**EMILY MARGARET** (L Allpress) – Crowded and hampered 1350 metres. Over-raced in the middle stages when the pace steadied.

**SABRAGE** (J Fawcett) – Crowded and hampered 1350 metres. Over-raced in the middle stages when the pace steadied.

**MISS CURIOUS** (B Murray) – Crowded and hampered 1350 metres. Over-raced in the middle stages when the pace steadied.

**DEVIL'S STAIRCASE** (K Mudhoo) – Crowded and checked near the 1350 metres losing considerable ground.

**J Laking** (OUR FLYING ACE) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed OUR FLYING ACE to shift inwards near the 1350 metres when insufficiently clear, crowding SABRAGE, EMILY MARGARET and MISS CURIOUS onto DEVIL'S STAIRCASE which was checked losing ground. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended J Laking's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 12 October up to and including 25 October, 10 national riding days.

<b>FIRE SHOW</b> (T Comignaghi) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages with the saddle slipping forward passing the 800 metres placing Apprentice Rider T Comignaghi in difficulty for the remainder of the race. T Comignaghi was reminded that she must not steady the pace to a degree where it places riders in difficulty.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>COUPLAND'S BAKERIES MILE PRELUDE</b> (1400 metres)
<p><b>SOUTHERN SAV</b> (A Morgan) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>KEEP ON COMING</b> (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SON OF MAHER</b> (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly then raced ungenerously when being restrained.</p> <p><b>PRINCESS BROOK</b> (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>HE'S GOLD</b> (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>FLAG THE GROOM</b> (L Allpress) – Held up early in the final straight. L Allpress reported that the gelding had shortened its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary inspection could not find any obvious abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>WAIMAKARIRI BUSINESSES NORTH CANTERBURY CUP</b> (2000 metres)
<p><b>OLIGARCH</b> (T Moseley) – Slow to begin and further hampered.</p> <p><b>RAPT N RED</b> (B Murray) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>BLUE LAGOON</b> (J Bayliss) – Lay inwards passing the 300 metres and made contact with ZENTESSA.</p> <p><b>ZENTESSA</b> (S Collett) – Held up passing the 500 metres. Inconvenienced when contacted 300 metres.</p> <p><b>S Collett</b> (ZENTESSA) - Admitted a breach in that she used her whip excessively with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>PLOUGH HOTEL RATING 72</b> (1200 metres)
<p><b>KHORABELLA</b> (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>REMINGTON</b> (J Bayliss) – Shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>DEVIL MAY CARE</b> (J Laking) – Began awkwardly then hampered losing ground.</p> <p><b>PINUP COUP</b> (A Morgan) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>HEE'S OUR SECRET</b> (S Muniandy) – Hampered shortly after the start. Raced ungenerously when restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>ZAKYNTHOS</b> (J Morris) – Raced fiercely in the early stages having to be heavily restrained off heels passing the 850 metres.</p> <p><b>OUR TEDDY BOY</b> (C Barnes) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 800 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>WIN A TRIP TO DUBAI WORLD CUP HERE NOVEMBER 10<sup>TH</sup> RATING 65</b> (1400 metres)
<p><b>IN A TWINKLING</b> (J Laking) – Underwent a veterinary inspection after being fractious in its barrier and was cleared fit to race. Hampered shortly after the start. A post-race veterinary inspection could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer J Richards advised he would experiment with gear changes.</p>	

**HOT FUSS** (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly. Hampered shortly after the start. A post-race veterinary could not find any obvious abnormality.

**STROWAN** (K Asano) – Bucked shortly after leaving the barriers before shifting outwards abruptly dislodging Apprentice rider K Asano who was uninjured. The connections were advised that STROWAN must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

**BENEFICIAL** (T Moseley) – Hampered shortly after the start. Raced keenly through the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres.

**MONZA CIRCUITO** (K Mudhoo) – Shifted outwards abruptly shortly after leaving the barriers hampering AKOYA PEARL, CARDRONA, HOT FUSS and COUP DREAMWOOD.

**AKOYA PEARL** (S Collett) – Hampered shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early stages.

**CARDRONA** (C Campbell) – Hampered shortly after the start.

**COUP DREAMWOOD** (T Comignaghi) – Hampered shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early stages.

**SHINE BRIGHT** (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

**FLICKA OF GOLD** (C Barnes) – Hampered shortly after the start. Raced wide in the early stages.

**PARVINA** (J Bayliss) – Raced wide in the early stages.

**ABOLI** (S Muniandy) – Held up in the early in the final straight.
