RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BECOME A MEMBER OF RACING TE AROHA HURDLE (3100 Metres)
<p>ARTIFACT (L Douglas) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Pulled up prior to jumping the last four fences. Rider reported that the gelding felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a suspensory injury to the left foreleg. Trainer E Shattock was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.</p> <p>FORT STREET DANCER (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence losing ground. Jumped indifferently throughout. Fell after jumping the fence near the 1100 metres and dislodged its rider who was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a nasal laceration.</p> <p>MAGNANIMOUS MAN (M Cropp) – Hit the fence near the 1100 metres. Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>FREEWHEELER (H McNeill) – Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>TRISHA LEA (C Studd) – Hit the fence near the 400 metres.</p> <p>BIG 'N' RICH (G Walsh) – Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.</p> <p>MAGIC CANNON (M Gillies) – Put in a poor jump at the final fence.</p> <p>IN A MINUTE (S Phelan) – Hit the final fence losing momentum.</p> <p>R Cole (PRESS MY BUTTONS) – Was reminded of his obligations in regard to pulling his mounts up when out of contention.</p> <p>SUMMER WARRIOR (E Farr) – Rider reported that the gelding had felt flat throughout, and in her opinion had failed to back up from racing the previous Saturday.</p>	
Race 2	THE GRAND TAVERN OPEN HURDLE (3100 Metres)
<p>B Thomas-Rantall (SO KEEP EM) – Failed to claim his full allowance with rider B Thomas-Rantall's explanation being accepted by Stewards on this occasion. Spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention also being advised that he should retire his mount once out of contention.</p> <p>HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) – Jumped the first fence poorly. Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>SO KEEP EM (B Thomas-Rantall) – Restrained soon after leaving the barrier. Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>DANCINGINTHESTORM (C Studd) – Was retired from the race near the 1000 metres with the rider reporting that the mare had held its breath. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>BAY ROCKER (S Phelan) – Ran down the final fence.</p> <p>NOTABADROOSTER (E Farr) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.</p> <p>SENASSY (M Roustoby) – Hit the fence near the 1100 metres. Hit the final fence.</p>	
Race 3	THE SPRAY RIG 2200

SIR MAGGIO (D Mansour) – Began awkwardly making contact and losing ground.

OUR MILO (D Danis) – Contacted leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced.

BANKS ROAD (A Calder) – Slow to begin. Inconvenienced near the 400 metres.

CASSIO (V Colgan) – Raced ungenerously getting its head up in the early and middle stages.

ZEDCREST (A Goindasamy) – Inconvenienced near the 400 metres.

GINGEE (L Satherley) – Hampered near the 400 metres.

GUNSANDROSES (T Thornton) – Shifted out passing the 400 metres hampering GINGEE. Also inconvenienced were BANKS ROAD and ZEDCREST. T Thornton was advised to exercise care.

KIPLING (S Collett) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out over the concluding stages when having to be corrected.

MITJAVILE (C Grylls) – Raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres having to be steadied by its rider. When returning to the enclosure following the race collapsed on the track, immediately being attended to by the on-course veterinarian and was found to be deceased having suffered a suspected heart attack.

VINCENTIUS (C Grylls) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.

CRITICS CHOICE (C Dell) – Slow to begin.

HEAR MY VOICE (S McKay) – Crowded and hampered soon after leaving the barrier losing ground.

T Thornton (I'MA SHYGIRL) – Issued with a warning for her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 5	GRAHAM LEMON, MURRAY DARROCH, OPTIMISM STEEPLE (3500 Metres)

EL CORBY (A Kuru) – Jumped the first fence poorly losing ground. Misjudged the final fence. Lost the left hind plate during the running.

CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (R Cole) – Jumped the second fence poorly. Knuckled after jumping the second to last fence losing momentum.

SHE SAID YES (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1500 metres hampering KOKANEE GOLD which was forced wider. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

KOKANEE GOLD (M Cropp) – Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1500 metres being forced wider.

WILLARE (T Moki) – Misjudged the second to last fence.

Race 6	TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES OPEN STEEPLE (4200 Metres)

LACUSTRE (A Kuru) – Badly misjudged the fence near the 1200 metres losing ground.

JUST GOT HOME (E Farr) – Ducked in after jumping the second to last fence making contact with the hind quarters of RAISAFUASHO which turned that horse outwards. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration on the off hind sole.

RAISAFUASHO (S Fannin) – Hampered having to shift out abruptly to make the entrance of the chute to the third to last fence. Contacted after jumping the second to last fence.

CABALLO NOIR (T Moki) – When attempting to improve into a marginal run to the inside of JUST GOT HOME was hampered when that runner ducked inwards forcing CABALLO NOIR on to RAISAFUASHO which was hampered, then having to shift out abruptly to make the entrance of the chute leading into the third last fence with CABALLO NOIR further being hampered and losing ground.

Race 7 | **PIAKO MITSUBISHI AMATEURS 1600**

NUNCHUCKS (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

AONGATETE EXPRESS (L Phelan) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

ASCOMANNI (M Northcott) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

J McIlroy (BARB DWYER) – Issued with a charge in that she used her whip excessively on a horse that was out of contention with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$250.

S Wenn (KEEPELLA HEIGHTS) – Issued with a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres when riding KEEPELLA HEIGHTS with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$250.

Race 8 | **TE AROHA GRAINS & STOCK FEEDS 1200**

THISTLE DO (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

Race 9 | **RACING TE AROHA SUPPORTERS CLUB 1200**

G Cooksley (MOOD) – Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after being unable to make the contracted weight for MOOD.

BOUFFANT (L Satherley) – Slow to begin (3L). Steadied after improving on to heels passing the 200 metres, then shifted out to obtain clear running.

JUTANUGARN (A Goindasamy) – Contacted leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced.

FAST MOVER (S McKay) – Contacted leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced.

WHY WONDER (D Danis) – Began awkwardly making contact.

IHU (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly.

EGO FAST (M Hashizume) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres making contact with MOOD.

MOOD (M Coleman) – Contacted and forced wider passing the 350 metres.
