RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MATT SMITH CONSTRUCTION LTD (2200m)
RAISE YOUR SIGHTS (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin, had to be angled wider on the track passing the 300 metres to find clear racing room and was inclined to lay inwards passing the 200 metres having to be straightened.	
BEAUDEN BEE (L Hemi) – Got its head up when over racing through the early to middle stages, raced erratically throughout. The connections were advised that a racing manners warning would be placed on the gelding's racing record.	
DONNATINA (T Moseley) – Began to over race passing the 1800 metres and was allowed to stride forward and lead from the 1400 metres.	

BAHHGOOFY (L Callaway) – Steadied passing the 1450 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of BEAUDEN BEE which had continued to lay inwards and race erratically.	
STEELE CANYON (B Murray) – The rider dismounted on pulling up with the gelding being attended to by the on-course veterinarian. Rider was excused from weighing in. A post race veterinary inspection revealed an injury to the left front flexor tendon. Trainer D Crozier advised that the gelding would be retired from their stable as a racing proposition.	
Race 2	RD PETROLEUM (2200m)
RED ROSE WARRIOR (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing some ground, over raced in the early stages due to the lack of tempo.	
Race 3	IDEAL RACING MISSES FRANK BURROWS MEMORIAL (1600m)
SMART GARDEN (T Moseley) – Began very awkwardly losing ground.	
HILLERSDEN (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.	
DIVINEXCUSE (C Johnson) -Blundered badly at the start dislodging the rider who was uninjured.	
PUSHYALUCK (S Collett) – Heavily contacted by DIVINEXCUSE at the start, raced wide from the 1000 metres	
ROULETTE (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover throughout, lay in under pressure passing the 200 metres.	
GEE TEE ELEANOR (K Mudhoo) – Held up momentarily on entering the home straight, shifted ground inwards passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.	
VOWS YOU MADE (K Williams) – Inclined to lay outwards throughout the final straight.	
LOVE ME TENDER (R Hannam) – Crowded for room passing the 200 metres when VOWS YOU MADE which was laying out shifted out and ROULETTE which shifted in under pressure.	
Race 4	QUIGLEY CONTRACTING LTD (1600m)
FEEL THE BREEZE (S Collett) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection after the rider reported that the mare had felt sore on the off foreleg enroute to the barriers being subsequently late scratched on veterinary advice at 2.06 pm. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.	
BOJANGLES (M McNab) – Bounded at the start, held up early in the run home and had to shift ground inwards passing the 300 metres inconveniencing KNUTQUACKER	
RELIABLE GLOW (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.	
OPIHI RANGER (C Johnson) – Slow to begin, was inclined to lay inwards throughout.	
ROTHACKER (T Moseley) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.	
HEAVEN KNOWS (L Callaway) – Raced wide from the 700 metres	
LINCOLN ZEPHYR (K Williams) -Got its head up when being steadied away from heels of the runner in front passing the 500 metres.	
Race 5	SUPPORT US ON DAFFODIL DAY MID CANTERBURY (1250m)
LEONARDO (J Laking) – Slow to begin.	

INTHELINEOFFIRE (S Weatherley) – Shifted in abruptly at the start making firm contact with LA TINKLA which was taken inwards onto HILDA FOX, ATHENE and MISS DAZZLER which were all buffeted and crowded losing ground, raced wide without cover throughout.

HILDA FOX (S Toolooa) – Buffeted and crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

ATHENE (K Kwo) – Buffeted and crowded shortly after the start losing ground, hampered passing the 800 metres.

MISS DAZZLER (C Johnson) – Buffeted and crowded shortly after the start losing ground, raced fiercely passing the 1000 metres getting its head up on a number of occasions, shifted ground outwards passing the 900 metres when over racing and hampered ATHENE as a result.

ALL OR NOTHING (L Callaway) – Steadied when briefly crowded by STRATTON (J Fawcett) shortly after the start, heavily restrained for some distance passing the 900 metres after becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

HE'S IRISH (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 6	BARNESWOOD FARM STAKES DAY 19TH OCTOBER (1250m)

TOUCHABEEL (B Murray)- Began awkwardly and further hampered losing ground when BELLA EVE shifted out at the start.

SAMANTHA (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly, shifted outwards abruptly passing the 700 metres hampering TAKE A RISK which was unbalanced as a result.

SANCTIFY (D Prastiyoo) – Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

GLOBAL STAR (R Beeharry) – Raced wide without cover throughout, raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

GLORY CHANCE (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

LETHAL (M McNab) – Steadied away from heels when making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised in his opinion the colt would benefit from a roomier track and greater distance.

TAKE A RISK (T Moseley) – Hampered and unbalanced passing the 700 metres.

XPLOSION (S Weatherley) – Lay out passing the 250 metres shifting wider on the track.

SORCERESS (K Asano) – Inconvenienced passing the 250 metres.

Race 7	RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT ASHBURTON LTD (1250m)

LADY DAVONE (T Moseley) which was fractious and reared in its barrier dislodging the rider who was uninjured, underwent a pre race veterinary inspection and was subsequently declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 3.54 pm. The connections were advised that the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

ARNAGE (K Asano) - Shifted outwards at the start making firm contact with PUBLICIST.

VICE MARSHALL (S Toolooa) – Crowded shortly after the start and had to be restrained and raced in restricted room for a distance when awkwardly placed inside heels after over racing.

ROSARITO (B Murray) – Raced ungenerously for some distance becoming awkwardly placed inside heels of HEART OF FAME near the 1100 metres.

DECISION KEPT (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Rider reported that the mare had hung throughout.

PURE CLASS (R Beeharry) – Lay out over the concluding stages shifting wider on the track.

PUBLICIST (M McNab) – When questioned regarding the apparent disappointing performance, stable foreman Mr P Richards advised Stewards that in his opinion the gelding needs more ground.	
Race 8	RURAL TRANSPORT LTD (1400m)
<p>The start of this race was officially delayed 3 minutes at the request of the TAB.</p> <p>IFFIDA (J Fawcett) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>CINTO BAY (C Johnson) – Over raced through the early stages.</p> <p>GIFTED (K Williams) – Held up on entering the home straight before shifting inwards to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 9	DAVE THOMSON AT HARCOURTS (2200m)
<p>BET SHE IS – Rider S Toolooa replaced B Murray who was unable to make the contracted weight. B Murray was issued with a warning under Rule 330(3)(c).</p> <p>BET SHE IS (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>O'KIWI (C Johnson) – Restrained to the rear on jumping, had to be restrained off heels passing the 600 metres, had to be steadied passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of SPIDER LILY when laying outwards after making the bend awkwardly.</p> <p>REDESDALE (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover through the early stages.</p> <p>IWO JIMA (D Prastiyau) – Made the bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly shifting wider on the track briefly.</p>
